OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics are on a season-high four-game winning streak (previous: 3 games, three times; last: April 16-19)...have recorded 10 or more hits in each of those four games and are batting .312 (43 for 138) with 20 runs scored over that span...with today's win, recorded their first three-game sweep of the season (swept a two-game series from Los Angeles, May 16-17)...have won 20 of their last 24 games against the Orioles, including 12 of the last 13 in Oakland...are 75-31 (.708) against the Orioles since the start of the 1999 season, which is the best winning percentage against Baltimore by an American League team over that span...are 3-0 on this six-game homestand against Baltimore (3-0) and New York (three games).
- Guillermo Moscoso** is 2-0 with a 3.27 ERA (4 er in 11.0 ip) in two starts since he was recalled from Triple-A Sacramento May 24.
- Andrew Bailey** made his season debut after being reinstated from the disabled list today...it was his first appearance since September 17 of last season at Minnesota.
- Cliff Pennington** (1 for 3) extended his hitting streak to a career-high eight games (13 for 31, .419), which is the longest hitting streak by an Athletic this season (previous: 7 games, Sweeney)...is a .345 (19 for 55) career hitter against the Orioles, his best mark against any American League team.
- Josh Willingham** (2 for 4) is 12 for 41 (.293) three home runs and 13 RBI over his last 12 games...is a .400 (22 for 55) career hitter against the Orioles with four home runs and 12 RBI in 16 games.
- Steve Tolleson** was traded to the San Diego Padres in exchange for cash considerations, the team announced today.

- The Baltimore Orioles have lost their past three games following their season-high five-game winning streak...are 9-13 on the road compared to 15-14 at home...are 0-3 on this on this six-game road trip through Oakland (0-3) and Seattle (three games).
- Zach Britton** allowed a career-high six runs (previous: 5, April 15, 2011 at CLE) on a career-high 10 hits (previous: 9, May 24 vs. KC)...is 2-2 with a 4.94 ERA (13 er in 23.2 ip) in four starts on the road and 3-1 with a 1.91 ERA (10 er in 47.0 ip) in seven starts at home.
- Vladimir Guerrero** (1 for 4) is on a 14-game hitting streak (22 for 61, .361), which is the longest hitting streak by an Oriole this season...has now hit safely in 17 of his past 18 games (27 for 76, .355).
- J.J. Hardy** (2 for 4) has hit safely in five of his past six games (7 for 21, .333).
- Adam Jones** (0 for 2) left the game in the fourth inning with a sore right shoulder.
