Baltimore Orioles (24-26) vs. Oakland Athletics (26-27)

LH Zach Britton (5-2, 2.35) vs. RH Guillermo Moscoso (0-0, 1.29)

TODAY'S GAME: The Orioles and Athletics meet in the finale of their three-game set and the third game of a six-game road trip...The Orioles head to Seattle following today's game...The O's are in search of their 25th win of 2011, after not winning their 25th game in 2010 until July 4th...The Orioles are looking for their 10th road win after not picking up their 10th road win of 2010 until July 8th...The Orioles have won five of their last seven games...The Orioles will get their first look at **RH Guillermo Moscoso** as a starter today after seeing him once in each of the last two years as a reliever...**LH Zach Britton** will face the Athletics for the first time.

VS. OAKLAND: The Athletics lead the season series, 2-0...Orioles lost the season series 3-7 in 2010 as they went 2-4 in Baltimore and 1-3 in Oakland...The Orioles trail in the all-time series 237-241, going 113-122 in Baltimore and 124-119 in Oakland...The Orioles have not won a season series with the A's since going 8-3 in 1998 (they split eight games in 2007).

HOUSE OF HORRORS: Since the 2008 season, the Orioles are just 1-11 in Oakland...The Birds have been outscored 60-32 in those 12 games and have scored two or fewer runs in eight of the 12 contests.

IN NEED OF SOME ASSISTANCE: The Orioles have scored just two runs while **Zach Britton** was in the game in his last four starts, and were held scoreless for a stretch of 26.1 innings over his last four starts...The Birds scored two runs in his last inning of his last start, Tuesday against Kansas City.

JOIN THE CLUB: **Zach Britton** will attempt to join **Jake Arrieta** for the team lead with six wins this afternoon...The Orioles did not have a pitcher win his sixth game in 2010 until August 8 (**Jeremy Guthrie**)...If Britton records the win today, he and Arrieta will be the first pair of Orioles starters to have six wins by the end of May since 1997, when **Jimmy Key** had nine, **Scott Erickson** had eight wins and **Mike Mussina** had seven.

ROSTER MOVE: Following last night's game, the Orioles optioned **RH Brad Bergesen** to Triple-A Norfolk...Bergesen was 1-6 with a 5.36 ERA (50.1IP, 30ER) in 10 games (nine starts)...A corresponding roster move is expected to be made prior to today's game.

SERIES FINALES: The Orioles are 6-11 in series finales this season, including a 2-5 mark in road series finales...The O's snapped a streak of nine consecutive losses in series finales with their May 12 win over Seattle.

STREAKER: **Vladimir Guerrero** has hit in 13 straight games set a team season-high...Guerrero is 21-for-57 (.368) with five doubles, a homer, seven runs scored and eight RBI during his streak and his average has gone from .275 to .302 during the streak which contained a career-high seven straight multi-hit games...Guerrero has hit in 16 of his last 17 games, going 26-for-72 (.361).

STREAK SNAPPED: **Nick Markakis** had his 12-game hitting streak snapped Saturday night...Markakis was 18-for-50 (.360) with a double, a homer, 10 runs scored and two RBI during his streak.

HEATING UP: **Adam Jones** (9th-.343); **Vladimir Guerrero** (11th-.337) and **Nick Markakis** (24th-.301) are all among the American League leaders in batting average in May.

JONESIN': In his 24 games since May 2, **Adam Jones** has batted .343 (35-102) with 15 RBI...He has multiple hits in 10 of those 24 contests...He has hit .342 (25-73) with eight extra-base hits in his last 17 games...With runners in scoring position, he is batting .372 (16-43) with two doubles, a triple, three homers and 26 RBI.

IN A PINCH: The Orioles lead the majors with a .500 batting average (6-for-12) and a .917 slugging percentage in pinch-hit situations as they have two doubles, a home run and three RBI...In 2010, the Orioles went 8-for-61 (.131) with two doubles, two home runs and seven RBI in pinch-hit situations.

THE ERASER: **Matt Wieters** leads all MLB catchers in caught stealing percentage (46.7 percent, 14-30) and runners thrown out (14)...Wieters is three ahead of San Francisco's **Buster Posey** (11 of 38).

BULLPEN BULLIES: The Birds have gone to the bullpen in 48 of the 50 games this year and the bullpen has surrendered at least one earned run in 38 of those games, including 22 of the last 27 games.

DEALING: In his last 11 games (15.0 IP), **Jim Johnson** has allowed just two earned runs, lowering his ERA from 5.14 on May 4th, to 3.10...After allowing two home runs in his first four appearances, Johnson has allowed one in his last 19 outings.

EATING HIS WIET-IES: **Matt Wieters** is 19-for-36 (.528) with five doubles, three homers and 25 RBI when batting with runners in scoring position...With two outs and RISP, he is 10-for-20 (.500) with three doubles, a homer and 14 RBI...Wieters began the year 7-for-7 with RISP.

MAKE YOUR MOVE: The O's are in the midst of a 30-game stretch (from May 20-June 22) where they will play just three games (Tampa Bay at home June 10-12) against teams that reached the post-season in 2010...The Birds are 5-3 so far during that stretch.

STRONG START: In 107 games with **Buck Showalter** as manager, the Orioles have made 63 Quality Starts and the starters have a 3.55 ERA (648.2IP, 256ER).

MR. CONSISTENCY: **Nick Markakis** has recorded a base hit in 157 consecutive series, the longest such streak in the majors since Ichiro Suzuki hit in 160 straight series from June 2000 to June 2004...Markakis has had a hit in each series since being held hitless in a three-game series (he played in two of the games) by Tampa Bay May 23-25, 2008.

THE HERO: According to Elias, **Vladimir Guerrero's** walk-off hit Thursday was his 14th game-winning hit which moves him into a tie with **Orlando Cabrera** for fourth-most among active players behind **David Ortiz** (18), **Andruw Jones** (17) and **Miguel Tejada** (15).

PRETTY GOOD COMPANY: **Nolan Reimold** set career highs with two homers, four hits and four RBI in Thursday's win over Kansas City...According to Elias, the only other O's to homer twice as part of a 4-for-4 or better game were **Rafael Palmeiro** (1995), **Roberto Alomar** (1997) and **Albert Belle** (1999)...Reimold's multi-homer game was the first by an Oriole since **Josh Bell** took **Cliff Lee** deep twice in Baltimore August 21, 2010.

TOMORROW'S STARTER: **RH Jake Arrieta** makes his 12th start of the year and fifth road start...In his four road starts, Arrieta is 3-0 with a 3.38 ERA (24.0IP, 9ER)...The O's are 7-4 when Arrieta starts and eight of his 11 starts have been Quality Starts...In his only start against Seattle, May 10, 2011, Arrieta did not factor in the decision despite working six innings and allowing just two runs on four hits and three walks...The Orioles won that game in 12 innings.

QUICK HITS: Zachary Grant Britton...Made his major league debut April 3 at Tampa Bay and picked up the win (6.0IP, 1ER) in front of nearly 30 family members and friends who were in attendance...Was rated the #28 prospect in baseball by *Baseball America* entering 2011...Was named the #2 prospect in the Orioles organization (behind SS **Manny Machado**) by *Baseball America*...Won the Jim Palmer Prize as the 2010 Orioles Minor League Pitcher of the Year...Older brother, Buck, is an infielder at Class-AA Bowie.

LIFETIME vs. OAKLAND: Britton has never faced the Athletics.

ON THE ROAD: In his three road starts, Britton is 2-1 with a 3.50 ERA (18.0IP, 7ER)...Two of his three road starts have been Quality Starts.

LAST OUTING: Allowed a career-high nine hits but surrendered just three runs over six innings May 24 against Kansas City...Left the game trailing 3-2 but did not factor in the decision after **Adam Jones** hit a two-run walk-off homer off **Joakim Soria**...The Orioles scored two runs in the sixth inning, the first two runs they scored while Britton was in the game in his last four starts.

STINGY: Britton had a stretch from May 5-24 (over four starts) where he allowed just one earned run over 19.2 innings.

HELP!: The Orioles have scored just two runs while Britton was in the game in his last four starts, and were held scoreless for 26.1 innings over his last four starts (scored two runs in his last inning of his last start).

JUST DO IT: Britton is going for his sixth win of the season tonight which would tie him with **Jake Arrieta** for the team lead...The Orioles did not have a pitcher record his sixth win of 2010 until August 8 (**Jeremy Guthrie**).

YOUNG GUNS: Britton and **Jake Arrieta** are the first pair of Oriole starters to both have five wins by May 20th since **Erik Bedard** (5) and **Kris Benson** (6) in 2006.

AN OLD FASHIONED PITCHERS DUEL: Britton and Seattle's **Jason Vargas** each worked nine scoreless innings May 12...The last time the Orioles played a game in which both pitchers went nine innings was July 11, 2003 (Baltimore's **Rodrigo Lopez** and Oakland's **Tim Lincecum**)...The game also marked the first time two major league pitchers went nine innings or more each and were both non-decisioned since July 10, 2010 (Philadelphia's **Roy Halladay** and Cincinnati's **Travis Wood**)...The game was the third such occurrence in the bigs since 2000...The last Oriole starter to throw nine shutout innings and not factor in the decision was **Mike Morgan** on April 16, 1988 against Cleveland.

SELECT COMPANY: Britton became just the fifth rookie starter in AL history to record four wins by the end of April, joining **Gustavo Chacin** (2005 with Toronto), **Jason Dickson** (1997 with Anaheim), **Jerry Garvin** (1977 with Toronto) and **Monte Ward** (1932 with Washington).

RECORD SETTER: Britton picked up his fourth win April 26th to set the franchise record for wins in April by an Oriole rookie starter...The previous mark of three was set by **Carl Weilman** of the 1913 St. Louis Browns, **Jack Ogden** of the 1928 St. Louis Browns and **Willis Roberts** of the 2001 Orioles...He was the only Oriole rookie starter ever to have three wins before April 21.

IMPRESSIVE START: Britton allowed one earned run over his first two major league appearances (13.2 IP)...According to *Elias*, since the O's moved to Baltimore from St. Louis in 1954, only **Tom Phoebus** won his first two major league games, both as a starting pitcher, allowing no more than one run combined...He shut out the California Angels September 15, 1966 and the Kansas City Athletics on September 20, 1966.

EARLY SUCCESS: Prior to Britton, the last O's pitcher to allow one-or-fewer runs in the *first 13.2 innings of his career* was **Kurt Birkins** in May 2006 (he allowed exactly one run)...Birkins pitched all of his innings in relief...The last O's pitcher to allow a total of one-or-fewer runs in his *first two career starts* was **Chuck McElroy** in September of 2000 (11.0IP, 1ER)...McElroy had made 603 relief appearances in the big leagues before his first two starts in 2000.

WELCOME TO THE SHOW: Britton allowed one run or fewer in each of his first two starts for the Birds...The last Oriole to do that was **Jeremy Guthrie**, who set a franchise record by allowing one run or fewer in his first four starts in an Orioles jersey (April 24-May 19, 2007).

SMASHING DEBUT: Made his major league debut April 3 at Tampa Bay after **Brian Matusz** was placed on the 15-day disabled list earlier that day...Picked up the win as he allowed one earned run over 6.0 innings on three hits and three walks...He struck out six, including **Elliot Johnson** in the first inning for his first major league strikeout.

QUITE A RUN: Britton became the seventh of eight Orioles starters to win their major league debut since the start of the 2009 season, joining **Koji Uehara**, **Brad Bergesen**, **Jason Berken**, **David Hernandez**, **Brian Matusz** and **Jake Arrieta**...**Chris Tillman** was the only starter not to win his debut in the last three seasons (the Orioles won that game).

SPRING TRAINING REPORT: Went 3-0 with a 1.35 ERA in five games (four starts)...Tied **Jake Arrieta** for the team lead in wins and allowed just three earned runs in 20.0 innings.

AWARD WINNER: Was named to the 2010 Eastern League All-Star team and EL Pitcher of the Week for June 21-27...Was named the Orioles Organizational Pitcher of the Month for June, 2010, when he went 3-0 with a 0.66 ERA in four starts...Was named the 2009 Carolina League Pitcher of the Year...Was named to the 2009 Carolina League All-Star Team and the 2009 Carolina League Post-Season All-Star Team...

MISCELLANEOUS: Graduated from Weatherford (TX) HS. Was raised in California, but moved to Texas at age 15 prior to his sophomore year.

BIRD BITS & COMMUNITY NEWS

MAKEUP DATES: The Yankees have announced that their postponed game from April 12 against the Orioles will be played at 7:05 p.m. on Saturday, July 30 as part of a day-night doubleheader in the Bronx...The Orioles' April 22 postponed game against the Yankees at Camden Yards will be made up at 1:05 p.m. on Saturday, August 27 as part of a day-night doubleheader at Oriole Park.

ORIOLES HALL OF FAME: On March 19, the Orioles announced that **MIKE BORDICK** has been elected to the Orioles Hall of Fame, with induction set for pre-game on Saturday, August 13 against the Detroit Tigers...Head Athletic Trainer **RICHIE BANCELLS** was named this year's Herb Armstrong Award winner.

THANK YOU FANS IN SARASOTA: The Orioles announced that the club set an Ed Smith Stadium record with a total spring attendance of 115,506 (10 sellouts and an average of 7,219 per game). The previous attendance record at Ed Smith was 115,382 in 1994, when the White Sox and **Michael Jordan** spent the spring in Sarasota...This year's attendance number surpasses the 102,219 drawn in 2010, the first year at Ed Smith for the Birds.

BIRD BATS

The O's have 13 position players on the active roster, 8 right-handers, 3 left-handed hitters and 2 switch hitters...Orioles batters were 8th in the AL with a .259 average & 11th with a .702 OPS last season...They were 12th in the league with a .661 OPS with RISP...O's DHs ranked 2nd in OPS (.865), average (.278), HR (31) and 5th in RBI (85)...Baltimore PHs batted .131 (8-61) with a .459 OPS in 2010.
