#### **OAKLAND NOTES**

- The Oakland Athletics had their season-high four-game winning streak snapped...have been shut out six times this season...are 7-24 when scoring
  fewer than four runs and 20-4 when scoring four or more...have an eight-game losing streak against New York, which matches the Oakland record for
  consecutive losses to the Yankees (fourth time; last: June 12, 2008-July 24, 2009)...are 3-1 on this six-game homestand against Baltimore (3-0) and New
  York (0-1).
- Trevor Cahill is 0-3 with a 3.51 ERA (10 er in 25.2 ip) over his last four starts after going 6-0 with a 1.72 ERA over his first eight starts...the losing streak is one away from his career high of four (July 27-Aug. 11, 2009)...allowed a season-high-tying five walks for his second consecutive start...now has 10 walks in 12.2 innings (7.10 walks per nine innings) over his past two starts after allowing 20 walks in 65.1 innings (2.76 walks per nine innings) in his first 10 starts...is 0-3 with a 9.72 ERA (18 er in 16.2 ip) in three career starts against the Yankees.
- Daric Barton (0 for 4) is 3 for 24 (.125) over his past seven games.
- Kevin Kouzmanoff (1 for 3) has hit safely in his past three games (5 for 10, .500) after missing six games due to a strained groin.
- Cliff Pennington (1 for 3) has hit safely in a career and A's season-high nine consecutive games (14 for 34, .412) to raise his average to a season-high .260 (45 for 173).

### **NEW YORK NOTES**

- The New York Yankees have won nine of their past 13 games after a season-high six-game losing streak...had their first shutout of the season...are 13-3 in day games this season, which is the best record in the majors...have won their last eight games against the A's and are 22-4 against the team since the start of the 2008 season...are 2-2 on this nine-game road trip through Seattle (1-2), Oakland (1-0) and Los Angeles (three games).
- Bartolo Colon pitched his ninth career shutout and first since July 5, 2006 at Seattle...it was his 32<sup>nd</sup> career complete game...is 2-1 with a 2.52 ERA (11 er in 39.1 ip) in six games, five starts, on the road and 1-2 with a 4.33 ERA (13 er in 27.0 ip) in five games, three starts, at home...has not walked any of the 69 batters he has faced to lead off an inning this year...no other American League pitcher has started more than 30.0 innings without walking a leadoff hitter...is 7-5 with a 3.36 ERA (39 er in 104.1 ip) in 17 career appearances, 16 starts, against the A's.
- Brett Gardner (1 for 3) snapped an 0 for 13 streak with a bunt single in the ninth inning.
- Derek Jeter (1 for 3) extended his hitting streak to five games with a single in the first inning (6 for 19, .316)...has reached base safely to start the first inning in 20 of 41 games he has started in the leadoff spot (.488 OBP).
- Jorge Posada (0 for 4) is 0 for 10 on the road trip and is on a 1 for 17 (.059) streak overall.
- Alex Rodriguez (0 for 3) had his season-high nine-game hitting streak snapped...batted .359 (14 for 39) during the streak.
- Mark Teixeira (1 for 4) extended his hitting streak to a season-high-tying seven games with a home run in the first inning (9 for 29, .310)...has now hit four home runs in his past five games and seven in his past 11 games.
- Russell Martin was scratched from the starting lineup due to a sore left big toe.
