OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have lost three straight and 13 of the last 14 games to fall to a season-high 12 games under .500...those are the A's most games under .500 since they were also 12 games under when finishing the 2009 season (75-87)...have committed at least one error in each of the last five games (seven total) and now have 52 for the season, which is tied for the American League lead...are 0-1 on this six-game homestand against Kansas City (0-1) and San Francisco (three games).
- Trevor Cahill is 0-5 with a 5.67 ERA (25 er in 39.2 ip) over his last seven starts after going 6-0 with a 1.72 ERA over his first eight starts...the losing streak is the longest of his career and comes on the heels of a career-high-tying seven-game winning streak as he won his final start of 2010...allowed a career-high seven walks (previous: 6, Sept. 4, 2010 vs. LAA)...did not record a strikeout, his fourth career start in which he did not record a strikeout (last: July 23, 2010 vs. CWS)... threw two wild pitches and has now thrown nine wild pitches this season, which is third most in the American League.
- A's starting pitchers are 0-11 with a 7.30 ERA (60 er in 74.0 ip) over the past 14 games...the 11-game losing streak is the second longest by starting pitchers in Oakland history...the record is 13 games from July 29-Aug. 12, 1977.
- Hideki Matsui (2 for 5) hit his 498th home run as a professional...that includes 166 in the Major Leagues and 332 in the Japanese Leagues.
- Scott Sizemore (2 for 3) is 8 for 19 (.421) with five RBI in six games since being recalled from Triple-A Sacramento June 6.
- Jemile Weeks (1 for 4) is 8 for 25 (.320) with three triples in seven games since he was selected from Triple-A Sacramento a week ago today.

KANSAS CITY NOTES

- The Kansas City Royals have won four of their past five games...are 17-7 when scoring first and 13-30 when their opponents score first...are 22-13 when scoring more than three runs and 8-24 when scoring three runs or less...are 3-1 on this nine-game road trip through Los Angeles (2-1), Oakland (1-0) and St. Louis (three games).
- Danny Duffy earned his first career Major League win and is now 1-2 with a 5.04 ERA (17 er in 30.1 ip) in six starts this season.
- Billy Butler (1 for 4) extended his hitting streak to seven games (9 for 26, .346)...has now hit safely in a franchise record 129 consecutive series, which is the second longest such streak in the majors (Markakis, BAL, 160).
- Alcides Escobar (3 for 5) has recorded four consecutive multiple-hit games for the first time in his career...is on a season-high seven-game hitting streak (13 for 26, 500).
- Jeff Francoeur (0 for 2) threw out Jackson at home plate in the second inning...has now recorded 88 outfield assists since making his Major League debut in 2005, which is 21 more than any other player over that span (Soriano, CHC, 67).
- Eric Hosmer (2 for 4) snapped an 0 for 16 streak with a single in the sixth inning.
