OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics snapped their three-game losing streak...however, have lost 13 of their last 15 games...improved to 9-15 in one-run games this season...have committed at least one error in each of the last six games (eight total) and now have 53 for the season, which is the most in the American League...12 of the errors have been committed by pitchers, which is the most in the majors...have now recorded a Major League leading 14 pickoffs this season...are 15-7 against the Royals since the start of the 2009 season...have won seven of the 10 games in Oakland over that stretch...are 1-1 on this six-game homestand against Kansas City (1-1) and San Francisco (three games).
- Josh Outman** earned the win, snapping a 11-game losing streak by A's starting pitchers over the past 14 games...the 11-game losing streak was the second longest by starting pitchers in Oakland history...the 14 consecutive games without a win by starting pitchers matched the fifth-longest streak in Oakland history...it was the longest since July 24-Aug. 12, 1997 when A's starters went an Oakland record 18 consecutive games without a win.
- David DeJesus** (0 for 4) is 2 for 24 (.083) over his last nine games.
- Hideki Matsui** (0 for 1) walked twice and has now recorded 500 walks in his Major League career.
- Cliff Pennington** (1 for 4) has batted second in each of his last six games and is 7 for 22 (.318) over that span...is batting .313 (35 for 112) over his past 32 contests (since May 10) after hitting .217 in his first 35 games.
- Landon Powell** (1 for 3) is batting .304 (7 for 23) at home compared to .129 (4 for 31) on the road.
- Jemile Weeks** (1 for 3) is 9 for 28 (.321) in eight games since he was selected from Triple-A Sacramento June 7.

KANSAS CITY NOTES

- The Kansas City Royals are 9-18 on the road compared to 21-20 at home...are 13-31 when their opponents score first this season and 17-7 when scoring first...are 8-25 when scoring three runs or less and are 22-13 when scoring more than three runs...are 3-2 on this nine-game road trip through Los Angeles (2-1), Oakland (1-1) and St. Louis (three games).
- Luke Hochevar** did not record a strikeout, his third career start in which he did not strikeout a batter (last: July 26, 2008 vs. TB)...is 1-3 with a 5.91 ERA (21 er in 32.0 ip) over his past five starts...is 0-6 with a 6.39 ERA (27 er in 38.0 ip) in seven career starts against the A's.
- Billy Butler** (0 for 3) had his seven-game hitting streak snapped...batted .346 (9 for 26) during the streak.
- Alcides Escobar** (3 for 3) extended his hitting streak to a career-high-tying eight games (also Sept. 22-Oct. 2, 2009) and is batting .552 (16 for 29) over that span...has also recorded five consecutive multiple-hit games for the first time in his career (12 for 19, .632)...recorded his 10th stolen base of the season, which ties his career high.
