**TONIGHT'S GAME**...San Francisco Giants visit Oakland A's in 1st game of this 3-game series...Giants right-hander **Tim Lincecum (5-5, 3.41)** will face A's right-hander **Graham Godfrey (0-0, 10.38)**...

**THE GIANTS**...lost 3-2 decision in 10 innings last night at Arizona as Justin Upton hit walk-off solo home run off RHP Santiago Casilla to give AZ victory...

- **have still won 10 of their last 15 games and 12 of last 20...**

**WINNING WAYS**...Giants are tied for 3rd-best winning pct. (.667, 10-5) in month of June among Major League teams...beginning May 6, SF's .632 (24-14) win pct. is 3rd-best in Majors, behind Boston (.730, 27-10) and Milwaukee (.667, 26-13)...

**SERIES SPEAKING**...Giants have won 14 of their 23 series played this season, going 14-6-3 (win-loss-split)...SF has not lost series since losing 2 of 3 to Milwaukee (May 27-29)...club has gone 4-0-1 over their last 5 series...

**STRAIGHT A'S**...RHP Tim Lincecum is **5-0 with 1.17 ERA (6er, 46.1ip) and 3 complete games in 6 career starts against Oakland...over his last 5 starts vs. A's, he's 5-0 with 0.64 ERA (3er, 42.0ip) and 3 complete games...**

- however, since his complete game vs. A's this season on May 21, Lincecum has gone 1-1 with 7.66 ERA (19er, 22.1ip) and .318 avg. against over his last 4 starts...

**ACCORDING TO ELIAS**...only other player, active or not, other than **Tim Lincecum**, to go at least 5-0 against an Interleague opponent was Aaron Sele, who was 6-0 against Dodgers...Sele ended his career by going perfect 7-0 against LA in 8 games (7 starts)...

**LAST LINCECUM NOTE**...prior to Lincecum, last pitcher to go 8+ innings in 4+ consecutive starts against A's was Scott Erickson (4, Aug. 16, 1996-July 21, 1998)...last pitcher to accomplish this in 5+ straight starts was Kevin Brown, who did it in 6-straight from June 27, 1993-June 2, 1995 (thanks to STATS, Inc. for help with this note)...

**BAY BRIDGE SERIES**...Giants are 41-42 all-time in Bay Bridge series since Interleague began in 1997...however, SF has been on winning end lately, going 13-4 against Oakland since June 28, 2008...SF has won each of last 6 meetings, including 3-game sweep last month at AT&T Park...Giants have not been at .500 mark against A's since June 24, 2005 (24-24)...

**INTERLEAGUE**...starting tonight, San Francisco will play their next 9 games and 12 of their next 15 against American League opponents...Giants will host Twins and Indians next week and then will travel to Detroit July 1-3...SF went 7-8 in Interleague last year...

**USING THE DH**...for 1st time this season Giants get to use designated hitter...SF hitters didn't fare too well last season in DH role, hitting .091 (2-for-22) with HR and 2 RBI...SF's .091 clip as DH in 2010 was 2nd-lowest mark in big leagues, behind Milwaukee (.043, 1-for-23)...Giants also struggled in 2009, hitting ML-low .174...

**CLOSE CALLS**...**57 of SF's 1st 69 games (82.6%) this season have been decided by 3 runs-or-fewer, most such games by any team in Majors this year...**

- SF has had 29 games decided by 1 run, with club going 19-10 (.655) in those games (best record in Majors)...Giants have 12 games decided by 2 runs and 16 by 3 runs...


**CALL TO THE 'PEN**...San Francisco's relief corps has yielded just 6 runs (5er) in 38.2 innings (1.16 ERA) over their last 12 games...Giants' bullpen has been impressive over their last 4 contests, allowing just 1 run in their last 11.2 innings...

**SCORELESS STREAKING**...RHP **Brian Wilson** is currently riding 3rd-longest scoreless inning streak in NL with 14.1-scoreless frames...Wilson hasn't allowed run since May 18 at Los Angeles...

**REHAB NEWS**...LHP **Barry Zito** (right mid-foot sprain) made his 3rd rehab start last night, his 1st with triple-A Fresno...Zito tossed 6.0 innings, allowing 4 runs on 5 hits and earned victory over Tacoma...in 3 rehab starts, southpaw has gone 3-0 with 3.20 ERA (7er, 19.2ip) for San Jose (A) and Fresno (AAA)...OF **Darren Ford** (left ankle sprain) played 5.0 innings in CF and went hitless in 3 at-bats in his 1st rehab game for Fresno Grizzlies last night...

**QUICK TRIP**...Giants are currently on 6-game road trip, going 2-1 at Arizona and then beginning 3-game set tonight in Oakland...SF is in midst of playing 19 of 22 games in Bay Area (16 games at AT&T Park; 3 here at Overstock.com Coliseum)...

**LINCECUM AT A GLANCE**...2-time NL Cy Young winner (2008, 2009) and 3-time NL All-Star (2008-10) takes hill for his 15th start of 2011 season...has gone 5-5 with 3.41 ERA (35er, 92.1ip) and .233 avg. against (79-for-339) over his 1st 14 starts...

**ON THE LEADERBOARD**...ranks 7th in NL in strikeouts per 9.0 innings (9.16) and 5th with 94 strikeouts...

**LAST TIME OUT**...was on end of losing decision to Reds in his most recent outing last Saturday...tied his career-high by allowing 7 earned runs on 7 hits in just 4.0 frames with career-low one strikeout...

**LAST 4 OUT**...since throwing his complete game shutout vs. Oakland on May 21, Lincecum has gone 1-1 with 7.66 ERA (19er, 22.1ip) with 7 walks and 19 punchouts...

**1,000 K PLATEAU**...became 8th pitcher in modern era (since 1900) with 1,000 strikeouts in his 1st 5 seasons...7 pitchers who have reached this milestone are: Tom Seaver (1,155), Bert Blyleven (1,094), Dwight Gooden (1,067), Kerry Wood (1,065), Grover Cleveland Alexander (1,036), Hideo Nomo (1,031) and Mark Langston (1,018)...

**JUNE SWOON**...has allowed 16 earned runs in 15.1ip (9.39 ERA) in his 3 starts this month...worth noting that Giants have scored only 4 runs of support for Lincecum during those outings (2.35 RSA)...

- marks his worst ERA since he had 7.82 mark (22er, 25.1ip) in 5 games pitched in August of 2010...

**QUALITY YOU CAN COUNT ON**...8 of his 14 outings are quality starts this season...8 of his 1st 10 outings were quality starts...

**SCORELESS STREAKING**...had season-high 21-inning scoreless streak (2nd-longest of his career) snapped in his start on May 16 at Colorado...

**SO CLOSE**...has twice taken no-hitter through 5.1 innings this season (April 18 at COL, 6.1; May 10 vs. AZ, 5.1)...

**FEW RUNS**...has allowed 1 run-or-fewer in 6 of his 14 starts and 3 runs-or-fewer in 9 games...has yet to allow run in 1st inning this season...

**K-MASTER**...has fanned at least 10-or-more in 3 of 14 games with season-high 13 on April 6 at San Diego...

- has 29 career games with at least 10 strikeouts, most such games in Giants franchise history since 1900...is 19-1 with 1.45 ERA (34er, 211.0ip) when registering double-digit Ks in game...

**AT THE PLATE**...owns lifetime .124 avg. (34-for-275) with 19 runs, 3 2Bs, 3B, 13 RBI and 43 sacrifices...has just 2 hits in 29 at-bats (.069) this season, but does have 5 sac hits...

**CAREER NOTES**...owns 6th-highest winning pct. in Majors since 2008 (54-27, .667)...

- is 49-4 (.925) with 2.77 ERA (165er, 536.0ip) when Giants score at least 3 runs of support for him (79 starts)...SF is 58-21 (.734) in those contests...
- since he entered Majors in 2007, has 20 starts in which he has not allowed run while throwing at least 7.0 innings, which is 5th-highest such total for any pitcher in Majors over that span...
- dating back to 2009, opponents have gone 56-for-their-last-71 in stolen base attempts off Lincecum, including 36-for-46 since 2010...
- has taken no-hitter through 6.0 innings twice in his career: July 9, 2009 vs. SD (6.0ip) and April 18, 2011 at COL (6.1ip)...
- his 1,001 strikeouts rank as 11th-most on Giants all-time franchise list and 4th-most in San Francisco history...
