OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have won four straight, which matches their longest winning streak of the season (May 26 to 29)...are 18-16 at home and 14-24 on the road...have won their past two games against the Giants after losing their previous six in a row, which was the longest losing streak in Oakland history against San Francisco...have a five-game winning streak against the Giants in Oakland...are now 25-17 all-time against the Giants in Oakland compared to 19-24 in San Francisco...are 4-1 on this six-game homestand against Kansas City (2-1) and San Francisco (2-0).
- Guillermo Moscoso** is 0-2 with a 3.45 ERA (6 er in 15.2 ip) over his past three starts...has a 1.00 ERA (2 er in 18.0 ip) in four games at night and a 6.75 ERA (9 er in 12.0 ip) in three games during the day.
- Coco Crisp** (1 for 3) started in the number three spot for the first time since July 20, 2005 against Kansas City...is 5 for 16 (.313) on the homestand and is now batting .306 (33 for 108) in Oakland compared to .227 (32 for 141) on the road.
- Conor Jackson** (1 for 3) is 12 for 37 (.324) over his last 12 games after going 6 for 38 (.158) over his previous six contests...is 5 for 17 (.294) against the Giants this year and is a .300 (61 for 203) career hitter against San Francisco.
- Hideki Matsui** (2 for 4) has started each of the last nine games at designated hitter and is 9 for 28 (.321) with nine RBI over that span...is a .308 (120 for 390) career hitter in interleague play.
- Adam Rosales** (0 for 2) made his fourth career start and sixth appearance in the outfield, all of which have come in left field...it was his first start in left field since July 23 of last season against Chicago...is 2 for 13 (.154) in four games since being reinstated from the disabled list June 6.
- Mark Ellis** made a rehab appearance with Triple-A Sacramento and went 0 for 3.

SAN FRANCISCO NOTES

- The San Francisco Giants have lost their past three games...it is their first three-game losing streak since being swept by Florida May 24-26...are 20-20 on the road compared to 19-12 at home...are 16-26 when scoring less than four runs compared to 23-6 when scoring four or more...are 2-3 on this six-game road trip through Arizona (2-1) and Oakland (0-2).
- Jonathan Sanchez** has a 4.11 ERA (21 er in 46.0 ip) on the road and a 4.20 ERA (21 er in 45.0 ip) at night...has allowed 19 walks in his last 21.0 innings (8.14 per nine innings) and has now allowed 53 walks in 85.0 innings this season (5.61 per nine innings)...is 1-3 with a 3.47 ERA (14 er in 36.1 ip) in 10 career appearances, five starts, against the A's.
- Aubrey Huff** (1 for 3) has hit safely in 10 of his last 12 games (15 for 46, .326)...is batting .308 (20 for 65) in 17 games in June.
- Nate Schierholtz** (2 for 4) has hit safely in eight of his last 11 games (9 for 33, .273).
- Andres Torres** (0 for 4) is 8 for 41 (.195) over his last 14 games.
