OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics are on a season-high five-game winning streak...the winning streak is their longest since they also won five straight from July 10-18 of last season...are 19-16 at home and 14-24 on the road...have a Major League leading 15 pickoffs this season...have a 26-21 record on Father's Day...have a six-game winning streak against the Giants in Oakland...are now 26-17 all-time against the Giants in Oakland compared to 19-24 in San Francisco...went 5-1 on this six-game homestand against Kansas City (2-1) and San Francisco (3-0)...it was their best homestand since going 8-1 against Texas, Tampa Bay and Seattle from August 7-16, 2006...begin a six-game road trip Tuesday through New York-NL (three games) and Philadelphia (three games).
- Trevor Cahill snapped his five-game losing streak...was 0-5 with a 5.67 ERA (25 er in 39.2 ip) in seven starts over that span...is 6-2 with a 2.70 ERA (19 er in 63.1 ip) in 10 career interleague starts...is 3-0 with a 1.30 ERA (4 er in 27.2 ip) in four career starts against the Giants.
- Coco Crisp (1 for 3) extended his hitting streak to eight games (10 for 34, .294)...went 6 for 19 (.316) on the homestand and is now batting .306 (34 for 111) in Oakland compared to .227 (32 for 141) on the road.
- Cliff Pennington (0 for 4) went 3 for 23 (.130) on the homestand and is now batting .207 (24 for 116) at home compared to .305 (36 for 118) on the road.
- Landon Powell (1 for 3) hit a home run in the eighth inning...it was his first home run since September 18, 2010 at Minnesota, snapping a 21-game homerless streak...is batting .308 (8 for 26) in Oakland compared to .129 (4 for 31) on the road.
- Jemile Weeks (3 for 4) is batting .364 (16 for 44) in 12 games since he was selected from Triple-A Sacramento June 7.

SAN FRANCISCO NOTES

- The San Francisco Giants are on a season-high-tying four-game losing streak (also April 20-24)...are 20-21 on the road compared to 19-12 at home...are 16-27 when scoring less than four runs compared to 23-6 when scoring four or more...went 2-4 on this six-game road trip through Arizona (2-1) and Oakland (0-3)...begin a six-game homestand Tuesday against Minnesota (three games) and Cleveland (three games).
- Matt Cain did not factor in the decision...is 3-0 with a 2.43 ERA (8 er in 29.2 ip) over his last four starts after going 0-2 with a 5.59 ERA in his previous three starts...has a 2.13 ERA (10 er in 42.1 ip) in six starts following a Giants loss this season...is 3-5 with a 2.19 ERA (16 er in 65.2 ip) in nine career starts against the A's.
- Brandon Crawford (0 for 3) is 7 for 47 (.149) over his last 14 contests after batting .292 in his first eight games.
- Aubrey Huff (1 for 4) is batting .304 (21 for 69) in 18 games in June.
- Cody Ross (1 for 4) is batting .317 (20 for 63) in 18 games in June.
- Andres Torres (0 for 4) is 8 for 45 (.178) over his last 15 games.
