HAPPY FATHERS DAY!...Giants lost 4-2 decision to A's last night and have now lost 3-straight games for 1st time since being swept by Florida at home, May 24-26...SF hasn't dropped 4 in row since April 20-24, which is their season-high losing streak...

- have still won 10 of their last 17 games and hold 1st place in NL West, 0.5 game ahead of Arizona...Giants have held top spot in division for last 2 weeks...

ON THE HILL...RHP Matt Cain enters today's game riding 3-game winning streak...he's posted 2.78 ERA (7er, 22.2ip) over his last 3 starts after going 0-2 with 5.59 figure (12er, 19.1ip) in his previous 3 outings...following Giants loss, Cain has gone 2-0 with 2.29 ERA (9er, 35.1ip) in 5 starts this season...

WINNING WAYS...Giants have been most successful this season when Cain is on hill, going 10-4 in his outings...

NOT SO CLUTCH...Giants batters have gone hitless in 15 at-bats with runners in scoring position in this series and are 0-for-22 in such situations over their last 3 games, club's longest stretch this season without hit with RISP...C Eli Whiteside's run-scoring 3B in 9th inning of Wednesday's game at Arizona is last Giants hit with RISP...

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE...leading up to All-Star break just 2 of Giants' next 7 opponents (including A's) are sitting at .500 or better...only .500+ teams SF will face leading up to break are 1st-place Cleveland (.551) and 2nd-place Detroit (.535)...teams Giants will face that are below .500 are Oakland (.444), Minnesota (.435), Chicago-NL (.414), San Diego (.417) and New York-NL (.493)...

- Giants are 21-15 against opponents below .500 and 18-17 vs. teams above .500...

RAISING AWARENESS...throughout Major League Baseball today all on-field personnel, including players, coaches, trainers, umpires and groundskeepers will wear blue wristbands and blue ribbon uniform decals symbolizing prostate cancer awareness...blue ribbon logo will also appear on official dugout lineup cards...

NOT MANY RUNS...Giants have scored 2nd-fewest amount of runs in Majors this season with 247 (San Diego, 238)...SF has scored 4 runs-or-fewer in 48 of their 71 games (67.6%)...club has plated 7-or-more runs in game just 8 times and have pair of double-digit run contests...

BAY BRIDGE SERIES...Giants are 41-44 all-time in Bay Bridge series...SF has won 13 of last 19 meetings...since last season Giants have swept A's at AT&T Park and A's have returned favor by brooming SF here...Giants haven't won game in this facility since June 24, 2009...A's haven't won at AT&T since June 15, 2008...

INTERLEAGUE PLAY...Giants are 116-113 all-time in Interleague play...SF is 46-62 (.426) against American League on road and 70-51 (.579) at home...Giants have lost 7 of their last 8 road games to AL opponents, dating back to last season...

USING THE DH...Giants designated hitters have gone 1-for-8 this year (Huff 0x4; Rowand 1x4)...SF hitters didn't fare too well last season in DH role, hitting .091 (2-for-22) with HR and 2 RBI...SF's .091 clip as DH in 2010 was 2nd-lowest mark in big leagues, behind Milwaukee (.043, 1-for-23)...Giants also struggled in 2009, hitting ML-low .174...

CLOSE CALLS...59 of SF's 1st 71 games (83.1%) this season have been decided by 3 runs-or-fewer, most such games by any team in Majors this year...

- SF has had 29 games decided by 1 run, with club going 19-10 (.655) in those games (best record in Majors)...Giants have 13 games decided by 2 runs and 17 by 3 runs...

SCORELESS STREAKING...RHP Brian Wilson is currently riding 2nd-longest scoreless inning streak in NL with 14.1-scoreless frames...Wilson hasn't allowed run since May 18 at Los Angeles...

REHAB NEWS...LHP Barry Zito (right mid-foot sprain) has made 3 rehab starts, going 3-0 with 3.20 ERA (7er, 19.2ip) for San Jose (A) and Fresno (AAA)...OF Darren Ford (left ankle sprain) has played 19.0 innings in CF in 2 rehab games with Fresno and has gone 2-for-11 with 4 strikeouts...

THE INJURY BUG...Giants have had 12 different players land on DL this season...SF has had 9 position players and 3 pitchers go on DL in 2011...last year, Giants had total of 13 players go on disabled list...

THIS DATE IN GIANTS HISTORY

June 19, 2006 - Matt Cain came within 4 outs of obtaining 1st Giants no-hitter in nearly 30 years...Cain pitched no-hit ball for 7.2 innings (8.0 innings overall) while fanning 10 Angels and taking win in Giants' 2-1 victory...
