OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have lost five of their past seven games...have been shutout nine times this season, which is tied for the most in the American League...are now 6-8 in interleague play...are 9-16 in the month of June...have now hit one home run or fewer in each of the last 32 games, which is the longest such streak in Oakland history...had their season-high six-game home winning streak snapped...are 1-1 on this nine-game homestand against Florida (1-1), Arizona (three games) and Seattle (three games).
- Guillermo Moscoso** recorded a career-high eight strikeouts (previous: 3, twice; last: June 2, 2011 at BOS)...is 0-1 despite a 0.51 ERA (1 er in 17.2 ip) over his past three starts, all interleague games...has a 0.87 ERA (3 er in 31.0 ip) in six night games compared to a 6.75 ERA (9 er in 12.0 ip) in three day games.
- David DeJesus** (0 for 2) is 0 for his last 13 and is batting .118 (6 for 51) in June...the lowest single-month batting average of his career is .193 in September, 2007.
- Cliff Pennington** (1 for 4) snapped his 0 for 23 streak with a single in the first inning...the hitless streak was four away from matching his career-long of 27 (May 22-June 1, 2010).
- Kurt Suzuki** (0 for 3) is 4 for 43 (.093) over his last 12 games and is now batting .136 (9 for 66) in June...has hit under .200 in a month just once in his career (.185 in August, 2010).
- Jemile Weeks** (1 for 4) has started each of the last 10 games in the leadoff spot...is 10 for 44 (.227) in 11 games batting first and 13 for 32 (.406) in nine games batting ninth.

FLORIDA NOTES

- The Florida Marlins recorded their sixth shutout of the season...improved to 5-9 in interleague play...are 18-19 on the road compared to 17-26 at home...are 23-18 when scoring first compared to 12-27 when their opponents score first...are 2-3 on this nine-game road trip through Seattle (1-2), Oakland (1-1) and Texas (three games).
- Ricky Nolasco** tossed his second career shutout (also Aug. 19, 2008 at SF) and fifth career complete game (last: April 17, 2010 at PHI)...snapped his career-high-tying four-game losing streak (also Aug. 18-Sept. 28, 2006) and now has a 5.74 ERA (27 er in 42.1 ip) over his past seven starts...has a 3.57 ERA (39 er in 98.1 ip) at night and an 8.25 ERA (11 er in 12.0 ip) during the day...is 1-0 with a 1.69 ERA (3 er in 16.0 ip) in two career starts against Oakland.
- Greg Dobbs** (0 for 2) is 0 for 10 on the road trip.
- Logan Morrison** (1 for 4) hit a two-run home run in the fourth inning...is now batting .283 (34 for 120) on the road compared to .235 (23 for 98) at home.
- Hanley Ramirez** (1 for 3) homered in the first inning...is now 9 for 28 (.321) over his last eight games after going 2 for 18 (.111) in his first six games back from the disabled list.
