OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have lost six of the last eight games...went 9-17 (.346) in the month of June, finishing with a losing record in the month for the third consecutive season...it is their worst June since going 7-22 (.241) in 1986...are now 6-9 in interleague play...hit two home runs to snap their 32-game streak in which they hit one home run or fewer, which was the longest such streak in Oakland history...are 1-2 on this nine-game homestand against Florida (1-2), Arizona (three games) and Seattle (three games).
- Trevor Cahill is 2-4 with a 5.49 ERA (25 er in 41.0 ip) over his past seven starts...had his five-game winning streak in interleague play dating back to May 21, 2010 snapped and now has a 2.41 ERA (14 er in 52.1 ip) in his past eight interleague starts.
- Coco Crisp (1 for 3) hit a home run in the eighth inning...has batted third in each of his last 10 starts and is 12 for 37 (.324) over that span...is batting .314 (38 for 121) at home and .314 (32 for 102) during the day.
- David DeJesus (2 for 3) snapped his 0 for 14 streak with a single in the fifth inning...batted .148 (8 for 54) in June, which is the lowest single-month batting average of his career (previous: .193, September 2007).
- The A's raised over \$29,000 at today's 12th annual A's MUG Root Beer Float Day with all proceeds benefiting the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation...since 2003, the A's have raised over \$329,000 for the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation through Root Beer Float Day.

Kurt Suzuki (6) FLORIDA NOTES

- The Florida Marlins have won three of the past five games after losing 13 of the previous 14 games...improve to 6-9 in interleague play...snapped their streak of 14 consecutive losses in one-run games...are 19-19 on the road compared to 17-26 at home...are 24-18 when scoring first compared to 12-27 when their opponents score first...are 3-3 on this nine-game road trip through Seattle (1-2), Oakland (2-1) and Texas (three games).
- Chris Volstad tossed a season-high-tying seven innings (fourth time, last: June 19 at TB)...did not strike out a batter, his fourth career start in which he did not record a strikeout (last: May 2, 2011 at STL)...is 1-0 with a 0.64 ERA (1 er in 14.0 ip) during the day compared to 3-7 with a 5.79 ERA (51 er in 79.1 ip) at night...is 4-2 with a 4.00 ERA (24 er in 54.0 ip) in nine career interleague starts.
- Jose Lopez (0 for 4) is 3 for 28 (.107) in 11 games, seven starts, since joining the Marlins.
- Logan Morrison (2 for 4) is batting .290 (36 for 124) on the road compared to .235 (23 for 98) at home.
- Hanley Ramirez (2 for 4) is 11 for 32 (.344) over his last nine games after going 2 for 18 (.111) in his first six games back from the disabled list.
- Mike Stanton (1 for 3) is 9 for 30 (.300) over his past seven games.
