OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have lost seven of the last 10 games...are 7-10 in interleague play with one game remaining...will finish with a losing record against the National League for the third consecutive season...are 2-3 on this nine-game homestand against Florida (1-2), Arizona (1-1) and Seattle (three games).
- Josh Outman** is 0-2 with a 5.25 ERA (7 er in 12.0 ip) over his past two starts after going 2-0 with a 0.69 ERA in his previous two starts...went 1-2 with a 4.00 ERA (8 er in 18.0 ip) in three interleague starts this year.
- Chris Carter** (2 for 4) had his first multiple-hit game of the season and the fourth of his career (last: Oct. 3, 2010 vs. SEA).
- Coco Crisp** (1 for 4) has batted third in each of his last 12 starts and is 14 for 45 (.311) over that span.
- Hideki Matsui** (1 for 4) had an RBI single in the eighth inning...has started 20 of the A's past 21 games and is 16 for 66 (.242) with 15 walks and 13 RBI over that span.
- Adam Rosales** (0 for 3) is 4 for 27 (.148) in nine games since being reinstated from the disabled list June 6.
- Kurt Suzuki** (0 for 4) is 6 for 55 (.109) over his last 15 games...is batting .098 (5 for 51) in interleague play...entered the season with a .315 (57 for 181) career average against the National League.

- The Arizona Diamondbacks are now 10-7 in interleague play with one game remaining...will finish with a winning record against the American League for the fourth time in 14 seasons...are 30-18 since May 13...are 35-16 when scoring four or more runs and 10-23 when scoring three runs or less...are 1-1 on this 10-game road trip through Oakland (1-1), Milwaukee (three games) and St. Louis (four games).
- Joe Saunders** is 4-2 with a 2.95 ERA (20 er in 61.0 ip) in his past nine starts...has tossed six or more innings in 12 consecutive starts...is 4-1 with a 2.09 ERA (10 er in 43.0 ip) when pitching seven or more innings and 1-6 with a 5.34 ERA (38 er in 64.0 ip) when tossing less than seven innings...went 2-0 with a 2.14 ERA (5 er in 21.0 ip) in three interleague starts...is 12-4 with a 3.44 ERA (42 er in 110.0 ip) in 18 career starts against the A's.
- Xavier Nady** (1 for 4) has hit safely in 15 of his last 18 road games (18 for 64, .281).
- Chris Young** (3 for 4) recorded a season-high-tying three hits (fifth time, last: May 13 at LAD) and season-high-tying four RBI (second time, also: April 10 vs. CIN)...has hit safely in eight of his past nine games (12 for 35, .343) and 15 of his last 20 (24 for 73, .329)...is batting .333 (33 for 99) over his past 27 road games after hitting .109 in his first 15 road games.
