OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics are 10-7 over the past 17 games...hit two home runs in the sixth inning, the first time they have hit multiple home runs in an inning this season...are 22-19 at home compared to 16-28 on the road...finish interleague play at 8-10...are 13-11 all-time against Arizona...are 3-3 on this nine-game homestand against Florida (1-2), Arizona (2-1) and Seattle (three games).
- Gio Gonzalez** was named to the American League All-Star team prior to today's game...it is his first career All-Star selection...threw a career-high 119 pitches (previous: 118, Sept. 30, 2010 at SEA)...is 3-0 with a 1.29 ERA (4 er in 28.0 ip) over his last four starts...is 6-2 with a 2.08 ERA (15 er in 65.0 ip) in 10 starts at home this season...went 2-0 with a 0.94 ERA (3 er in 28.2 ip) in four interleague starts.
- Andrew Bailey** has not allowed a run over his past nine appearances (9.1 ip) and in 11 of 12 outings this season (1 er in 12.1 ip, 0.73 ERA).
- Coco Crisp** (1 for 3) extended his hitting streak to eight games (10 for 28, .357) and has now hit safely in 18 of the last 19 games in which he has an at-bat (23 for 76, .303).
- David DeJesus** (1 for 3) had a two-run double in the fourth inning and is now 5 for 12 (.400) over his last four games after going 1 for 25 (.040) over his previous 12 contests...is a .354 (17 for 48) career hitter against Arizona.
- Conor Jackson** (1 for 4) hit a two-run home run in the sixth inning, which snapped a 49-game homerless streak (last: April 26 at LAA)...both of his home runs this year have come as a first baseman, the only home runs by an A's first baseman this season.
- Scott Sizemore** (3 for 4) had a season-high-tying three hits (third time, last: June 10 at CWS) and has now recorded multiple hits in each of his past three games (7 for 12, .583).
- Jemile Weeks** (1 for 3) has hit safely in a season-high six consecutive games (8 for 25, .320).

ARIZONA NOTES

- The Arizona Diamondbacks have lost six of the last nine games...finish interleague play with a 10-8 record...are 11-14 during the day compared to 34-26 at night...are 1-2 on this 10-game road trip through Oakland (1-2), Milwaukee (three games) and St. Louis (four games).
- Ian Kennedy** allowed a season-high 10 hits (previous: 8, three times; last: June 27 vs. CLE)...was charged with his first road loss of the season and is now 5-1 with a 3.23 ERA (19 er in 53.0 ip) on the road...went 2-1 with a 5.27 ERA (16 er in 27.1 ip) in four interleague starts.
- Kelly Johnson** (0 for 5) is 6 for 48 (.125) over his last 12 road games after a seven-game road hitting streak (11 for 28, .393).
- Xavier Nady** (1 for 3) had a RBI single in the fourth inning and has now hit safely in 16 of his last 19 road games (19 for 67, .284).
- Ryan Roberts** (0 for 3) is 7 for 40 (.175) in his last 11 games and 6 for 30 (.200) in his last eight road games.
- Chris Young** (1 for 3) has reached base safely in each of his past 14 games and is batting .308 (16 for 52) over that span...is batting .333 (34 for 102) over his past 28 road games after hitting .109 in his first 15 road games.
