OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have lost eight of the last 12 games since winning a season-high six in a row...are now 12-19 (.387) in one-run games, which is the worst record in the majors...are 36-48 (.429) against Seattle since 2007, which is the lowest winning percentage by any American League team against the Mariners over that span...are 3-4 on this nine-game homestand against Florida (1-2), Arizona (2-1) and Seattle (0-1).
- Brandon McCarthy** is on a career-high five-game losing streak over his past seven starts despite posting a 3.72 ERA (20 er in 48.1 ip) during that span...allowed a home run to Bard in the sixth inning, which was only the second home run he has allowed in 70.1 innings this season...the other home run came April 21 at Seattle, a solo shot by Kennedy...is 1-4 with a 5.02 ERA (24 er in 43.0 ip) in nine career appearances, seven starts, against Seattle.
- Coco Crisp** (0 for 3) had his eight-game hitting streak snapped...went 10 for 28 (.357) during the streak.
- Conor Jackson** (0 for 3) is 7 for 34 (.206) over his last 10 games.
- Jemile Weeks** (0 for 4) had his six-game hitting streak snapped...went 8 for 25 (.320) during the streak...has started each of the last 15 games in the leadoff spot...is 16 for 65 (.246) in 16 games batting first and 13 for 32 (.406) in nine games batting ninth.

SEATTLE NOTES

- The Seattle Mariners have won three of the past four games after losing seven of the previous nine...have won five straight on the Fourth of July and are 16-17 all-time...are 1-0 on this seven-game road trip through Oakland (1-0) and Los Angeles (four games).
- Michael Pineda** is 3-0 with a 1.41 ERA (5 er in 32.0 ip) in five starts during the day this season...is 4-3 with a 2.72 ERA (17 er in 56.1 ip) in nine starts on the road...is 2-2 with a 2.88 ERA (8 er in 25.0 ip) in four starts against the American League West.
- Brandon League** has converted his past 14 save opportunities and has not allowed an earned run over his last 20 appearances (19.2 ip).
- David Pauley** has not allowed a run in 13 appearances during day games this season (21.2 ip).
- Dustin Ackley** (0 for 4) had his six-game hitting streak snapped...went 8 for 22 (.364) during the streak...did not reach base for the first time in 14 games with the Mariners.
- Jack Cust** (0 for 3) is 4 for 30 (.133) over his last 12 games...is 2 for 21 (.095) against the A's this year.
- Carlos Peguero** (0 for 2) is 5 for 34 (.147) over his past 11 games.
- Justin Smoak** (2 for 3) recorded his first multiple-hit game since June 23 at Washington...is now 3 for his last 32 (.094).
- Ichiro Suzuki** (2 for 4) is a .368 (146 for 397) career hitter in Oakland, which ranks first among active players...is 14 for 32 (.438) against the A's this year...is batting .341 (30 for 88) since June 11.
