### **OAKLAND NOTES**

- The Oakland Athletics have lost nine of the last 13 games since winning a season-high six in a row...are now eight games out of first place, which matches their season high (last: June 14)...fall to 5-10 in extra-inning games, which is the worst mark in the American League...are 36-49 (.424) against Seattle since 2007, which is the lowest winning percentage by any American League team against the Mariners over that span...are 3-5 on this nine-game homestand against Florida (1-2), Arizona (2-1) and Seattle (0-2).
- Trevor Cahill is 2-2 with a 1.67 ERA (7 er in 37.2 ip) in six starts against the AL West this year and 5-5 with a 3.86 ERA (35 er in 81.2 ip) in 13 starts against everyone else...is 2-3 despite a 2.42 ERA (13 er in 48.1 ip) in seven career starts against Seattle.
- Conor Jackson (0 for 4) is 7 for 38 (.184) over his last 11 games.
- Cliff Pennington (0 for 3) is 5 for 44 (.114) over his last 12 games.
- Kurt Suzuki (2 for 4) hit a home run in the eighth inning...is 9 for 26 (.346) against the Mariners this year and is batting .320 (24 for 75) against AL West competition compared to .186 against everyone else.

#### **SEATTLE NOTES**

- The Seattle Mariners have won three straight and four of the past five games after losing seven of the previous nine...are 32-29 at night and 11-14 during the day...are 2-0 on this seven-game road trip through Oakland (2-0) and Los Angeles (four games).
- Felix Hernandez recorded 10 strikeouts, the fifth time this season he has had 10 or more strikeouts...did not walk a batter for the third time this season...has tossed seven or more innings in nine of his past 10 starts and is 4-4 with a 3.11 ERA (26 er in 75.1 ip) over that span...is 2-0 with a 1.09 ERA (3 er in 24.2 ip) in three starts against the A's this year and 11-4 with a 2.53 ERA (39 er in 139.0 ip) in 20 career starts.
- Brandon League allowed a run in the ninth inning and was charged with a blown save...had converted his past 14 save opportunities and had not allowed an earned run over his previous 20 appearances (20.2 ip).
- Jamey Wright made his 500<sup>th</sup> career appearance and recorded his first save.
- Dustin Ackley (2 for 3) homered to start the seventh inning and has now hit safely in seven of his past eight games (10 for 29, .345)...has reached base safely in 14 of 15 games since joining the Mariners.
- Carlos Peguero (0 for 3) is 5 for 37 (.135) over his past 12 games.
- Franklin Guiterrez (1 for 4) snapped a 0 for 15 streak with a single in the 10<sup>th</sup> inning.
- Ichiro Suzuki (2 for 4) is batting .348 (32 for 92) since June 11...is a .369 (148 for 401) career hitter in Oakland, which ranks first among active players...has a 10-game hitting streak at Oakland (17 for 40, .425).
