#### OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics recorded their fifth shutout of the season...are 13-12 against the AL West and 26-37 against everyone else...are 28-13 when scoring first and 11-36 when their opponents score first...are 23-21 at home compared to 16-28 on the road...went 4-5 on this nine-game homestand against Florida (1-2), Arizona (2-1) and Seattle (1-2)...begin a four-game road trip against Texas tomorrow, which takes the A's into the All-Star Break.
- Guillermo Moscoso** snapped his career-high four-game losing streak and is now 1-4 despite a 1.96 ERA (8 er in 36.2 ip) over his last seven games, six starts...has allowed one earned run or fewer in five of his eight starts, including four starts in which he has not allowed an earned run.
- Coco Crisp** (1 for 4) is 13 for 41 (.317) against Seattle this year and is now batting .365 (23 for 63) in 16 games against the Mariners in his two seasons with the A's.
- Conor Jackson** (0 for 3 is 7 for 41 (.171) over his last 12 games.
- Scott Sizemore** (2 for 4) homered in the first inning and is now 9 for 22 (.409) over his last six games...is batting .325 (26 for 80) in 24 games with the A's overall...is 9 for 28 (.321) on the homestand and is batting .342 (25 for 73) in his home ballparks compared to .214 (15 for 70) on the road.
- Jemile Weeks** (1 for 4) is 14 for 46 (.304) over his past 11 games.

- The Seattle Mariners had their three-game winning streak snapped...are 18-21 on the road and 25-23 at home...are 11-15 during the day and 32-29 at night...committed a season-high-tying three errors (third time, last: May 16 vs. MIN)...are 2-1 on this seven-game road trip through Oakland (2-1) and Los Angeles (four games).
- Jason Vargas** pitched his fourth complete game of the season...is 5-4 with a 2.70 ERA (26 er in 86.2 ip) over his last 12 starts after going 1-2 with a 5.45 ERA over his first six starts...is 2-3 with a 3.27 ERA (15 er in 41.1 ip) in six starts against the AL West this season...is 2-3 with a 4.15 ERA (16 er in 34.2 ip) in seven career starts against the A's.
- Dustin Ackley** (1 for 3) has hit safely in eight of his past nine games (11 for 32, .344) and has now reached base safely in 15 of 16 games since joining the Mariners.
- Chone Figgins** (0 for 2) is 1 for 25 (.040) over his past 10 games.
- Carlos Peguero** (0 for 3) is 5 for 40 (.125) over his past 13 games.
- Ichiro Suzuki** (0 for 4) had his 10-game hitting streak in Oakland snapped...batted .425 (17 for 40) during the streak.
