Jamey Wright recorded his first career save in his 500th career appearance (246 starts) last night vs. OAK...it is the second longest number of appearances before recording career save #1, behind only Frank Tanana, who recorded his first and only save in his 530th career appearance...only six pitcher in Major League history have appeared in more than 336 games before recording their first save:

HE'S TOUGH LATE

10 of **Dustin Ackley's** 15 hits this season have come in the 7th inning or later... Ackley is batting .556 (10x18) with 7 runs scored, 1 double, 1 triple, 2 home runs and 4 RBI after the 6th inning...he is also batting .467 (7x15) vs. relievers, compared to .167 (6x36) vs. starters.

GUTI IN THE FIELD

Franklin Gutierrez leads the team and T10th in the AL with 5 outfield assists despite playing in only 40 G (35 GS) in center field...**has not made an error in 233 consecutive games (226 GS) dating back to 8/21/09, a string of 650 consecutive errorless chances.**

ON THE AIR

Mariners are using rotation of announcers this season, all former partners of HOF announcer Dave Niehaus...**Rick Rizzs, Dave Sims** and **Mike Blowers** will work nearly all the games, while **Ron Fairly, Ken Levine, Ken Wilson, Dave Valle, Dave Henderson, Jay Buhner** and **Dan Wilson** will mix in...Rizzs and Ken Wilson will be in the radio booth today, with Sims and Blowers calling the action on TV.

THIS DATE IN 2001

On this date in 2001, **Freddy Garcia** tossed 9.0-inning complete game 4-hit shutout in Mariners 13-0 win at Texas...**Ichiro, Al Martin** and **David Bell** each homered as the Mariners recorded 17 hits...Seattle sent 10 men to the plate in their 6-run 8th inning...the Mariners will celebrate the 2001 team on July 16; see full release in back of the press box.



TODAY'S TILT...the Mariners continue a pivotal 2-team, 7-game roadtrip vs. AL West opponents the Oakland Athletics (2-0) and Los Angeles Angels (4 games)...went 4-5 on just completed 9-game homestand vs. Florida (2-1), Atlanta (0-3) & San Deigo (2-1)...currently in 3rd place in the AL West, 2.5 games behind division leaders Los Angeles & Texas...today's game will be televised in the Northwest on **ROOT SPORTS** in HD & broadcast on **710 ESPN Seattle** and the Mariners Radio Network.

ODDS AND ENDS...have won 3 in a row...are 9-9 in last 18 and 12-13 in last 25...have still won 27 of last 47... 35-28 over last 63 games, including season-high 6G winning streak (May 18-23) & 5G win streak (April 26-30)...are 25-23 in games played at Safeco Field, 18-20 on the road...are 32-29 in night games, 11-14 during the day (won 9 of last 14 day games)...went 9-9 during Interleague play.

- **Close Games** -- 47 of 86 games have been decided by 2 or fewer runs (16-16 in 1-run, 7-8 in 2-run).
- The Mariners have used 78 different batting lineups in 86 games (65 different defensive lineups).
- **Comeback Wins** -- recorded 20 comeback wins this season, 2nd in the AL (TOR - 21).
- **Shutouts** -- 2nd in AL w/9 ShO (DET-10)...held opponents to 2 or less runs MLB high 39 times.
- **Dustin Ackley** -- batting .300 (15x50) with 6 walks in 15 games...is 7-for-10 (.700) vs. LHP.
- **Ichiro** currently ranks 2nd in the American League with 36 multi-hit games and T8th with 98 hits.
- The pitching staff currently has a 3.24 ERA during day games, 3rd in the American League.
- **Jason Vargas'** 3 shutouts are tied for the AL lead with James Shields (TB)...T3rd most in club history behind Randy Johnson (4, 1994) and Dave Fleming (4, 1992).

SEATTLE VS. ATHLETICS...today is the 10th (6-3) of 19 games between the Mariners and A's in 2011...went 2-3 in first trip to Oakland, April 1-3 and 2-2 at Safeco, April 21-24...the Mariners went 6-13 against the A's last season, including 2-7 at Oakland Coliseum...Seattle is 49-36 vs. Oakland since 2007...Mariners trail the all-time series 213-286, including a 92-159 mark in Oakland...

SWEEPS...the Mariners last swept Oakland in a 3-game series Sept. 29-Oct. 1, 2009 in Seattle... have not had a 3-game sweep here since Sept. 17-19, 2007.

DON'T GO ON OLIVO...**Miguel Olivo** threw out 3 of 4 attempted basestealers last night at Oakland...it is the second time in his career to throw out 3 runners in a game (also: July 5, 2003 at TB w/CWS)...Olivo is the 7th catcher (11th time) in club history to record 3 or more caught stealing in a game, and first since Kenji Johjima on 5/19/09 vs. LAA...the other Mariners catchers to accomplish this feat were Dave Valle (2), Bob Kearney (4), Jamie Nelson, Rick Sweet & Jerry Narron.

PUNCH OUTS...**Felix Hernandez** struck out 10 batters last night at Oakland...marked the fifth time this season and 14th time in his career to strikeout at least 10 batters in a game...his five games with 10 or more strikeouts currently ranks T2nd in the Majors (w/C.J. Wilson and Clayton Kershaw) this season...only Cliff Lee (6) has recorded more starts with at least 10 strikeouts.

ANOTHER HIT FOR ICHIRO...**Ichiro** has recorded 270 career hits vs. the Athletics, ranking 3rd all-time (since 1968)...he trails only Rod Carew (282) and George Brett (271)...Ichiro is a career .333 (270x810) hitter vs. the Athletics...has recorded 5 consecutive multi-hit games vs. OAK, batting .524 (11x21) with 1 run scored, 1 double and 3 stolen bases.

WELCOME BACK OLIVO...**Miguel Olivo** returned behind the plate last night after missing the last 5 games with a strained hamstring...this season the Mariners are 36-30 (.545) when he starts behind the plate...the team has ERA of 2.90 (191 ER, 592.1), while averaging 3.56 runs per game (235 R, 66 G) in his starts...when Olivo is not starting the team is 7-13 (.350) with an ERA of 3.84 (76 ER, 178.1), while averaging 2.85 runs per game (57 R, 20 G).

BULLPEN STREAKING...the Mariners bullpen has allowed only 1 run in last 18.0 innings since June 24...during this stretch they have limited opponents to a .175 average (11x63), while walking 4 and striking out 14...this season the Mariners relievers rank fourth in the AL with a 3.26 ERA.

NOT JUST GOOD, RECORD SETTING GOOD...Mariners starters lead the American League (2nd in MLB) with a 3.07 ERA (196 ER, 574.2 IP); the club record is 3.67, set in 1990...the team has only had a starters ERA of under 4.00 in six seasons prior to 2011, including last season when it finished with a 3.83 mark, 3rd-best mark ever (3.77 in 2001 ranks 2nd).

STRONG START(ERS)...Mariners starters have tossed at least 7.0 innings in 47 games this year, 2nd most in Majors (PHI, 49)...tossed at least 7.0 in 16 of last 21 games...on pace for 89 starts of 7.0+ IP which would be the best in club history (84, 1993)...had 69 starts of 7.0+ IP in 2010.

DAY TRIPPER...**David Pauley** is 1-0, 0.00 in 13 DAY games this season...he has not allowed a run in 21.2 innings under the sun...is only qualifying AL pitcher with a zero ERA in day games in 2011.

ALL STARS AMONG US...Mariners pitchers **Felix Hernandez** (2nd ASG) and **Brandon League** (1st ASG) have been elected to play for the AL in the 82nd All-Star Game July 12 in Phoenix...this marks the first time since 2003 that the Mariners will have multiple pitchers represented in the Midsummer Classic (Moyer, Hasegawa).

RIGHT ON...Mariners face a right-handed starter in each of next 6 games leading up to the All-Star break...Seattle is 35-29 (.547) vs. right-handed starters, compared to 8-14 (.363) vs. lefty starters... Seattle has won 4 of last 5 games by RH starters.

AS YOU KNOW...Felix Hernandez struck out 10 and did not walk a batter Tuesday night...**BUT, DID YOU KNOW?**...it was the second time this season that Hernandez has had a double-digit-strikeouts-but-no-walks start; he also did it at San Diego on May 22, when he rolled up 13 strikeouts...he is the only pitcher in the Major Leagues with two such games this season; the last Seattle pitcher to do that twice in a season was Randy Johnson, who did it three times in 1995.

ABOUT VARGAS...pronounced VAR-gus.

- 28-year-old lefty is making his 18th start of the season and 103rd career MLB appearance (83rd start) tonight against the A's.
- Acquired from the Mets in 3-team, 12-player trade 12/10/08.
- Selected by Marlins in 2nd round, 68th overall in '04 draft.
- Made Major League debut w/1.0 shutout inning of relief July 14, 2005 at PHI (with FLA)...first ML start July 18, 2005 at Arizona (5.0,4,3,2,4,3).
- Traded by the Marlins to the Mets in exchange for Henry Owens (rhp) and Matt Lindstrom (rhp) on Nov. 20, 2006.
- Did not pitch during 2008 season, spending year recovering from surgery to repair the labrum in his left hip...had surgery March 17, 2008 and spent summer rehabbing at Mets minor league facility in Port St. Lucie, FL.
- Played college baseball at LSU (2002), Cypress Junior College (2003) and Long Beach State (2004)...as junior at LBSU, went 7-4, 4.14 on mound & hit .354 with 14 doubles, 5 home runs as the DH.
- Is 2-6, 5.99 in 19 G/12 GS career in July...1-0, 0.00 in 1 July GS this season.
- 16-15, 4.15 in 60 G/52 GS prior to ASG...is 8-16, 4.92 ERA (104 ER, 190.1 IP) in 42 G/30 GS in Post All-Star games.

LAST TIME OUT...W #6 w/3rd CG ShO of season in 6-0 win over SD... allowed 6 hits, all singles, and did not walk a batter...is his 4th 9.0 IP/0 ER game of season, his 3rd CG ShO (had one ND).

BOUNCEBACK...Vargas has proven to be a resilient pitcher this season... in last 5 starts following a loss, he has combined to go 4-0 with a 1.11 ERA (5 ER, 40.2 IP)...has tossed a shutout in each of his last 3 starts following losses (6/3 vs. TB, 6/19 vs. PHI & 7/1 vs. SD).

SHUTOUTS...is (tie) first in the AL with 3 shutouts (also has a 9.0 IP, 0 R no-decision this year):

- **6-hitter July 1 vs. SD**, with all 6 hits being singles; K'd 7 and had 0 BB...
- **3-hitter June 19 vs. PHI**, celebrated Father's Day by allowing just 3 singles, incl. 2 by Ryan Howard; K'd 6 and threw a career-high 119 pitches (prev: 117 8/21/05 vs. LAD)...retired 15 straight from the 4th through 9th.
- **4-hitter June 3 vs. TB**, his first career shutout and just second career CG.

A MONTH OF SHUTOUTS...has tossed a pair of CG shutouts in June: June 3 vs. Tampa Bay & June 19 vs. Philadelphia...joins the Phillies Cliff Lee as the only pitchers with at least 2 shutouts in June (Lee had 3)...**is the first Mariner to toss multiple shutouts in a month since Freddy Garcia posted back-to-back shutouts July 1 & July 6, 2001**...is just the 5th pitcher in club history to post multiple shutouts in a month (Randy Johnson - 4x, Freddy Garcia, Mike Parrott, Mark Langston)...club record for shutouts in a month is Langston with 3 in September 1988.

SR. CIRCUIT TRIO...has made last three starts vs. NL and is 2-1, 1.50 with 2 CG ShO (24.0 IP, 17 H, 4 ER)...**SIX PACK**...is 3-2, 2.28 in six starts since the start of June (47.1 IP, 12 ER)...**AND OVER HIS LAST 11**...over his last 11 starts (since 5/5) is 5-3 with a 2.75 ERA (24 ER, 78.2 IP)... was 1-2 with a 5.45 ERA (21 ER, 34.2 IP) in first 6 starts of 2011.

VS. AL WEST...is 7-8 with a 3.62 ERA (52 ER, 129.1 IP) in 24 career appearances (19 GS) against AL West opponents...has made 5 starts vs. the AL West this season, going 2-2, 3.51 (13 ER, 33.1 IP)...went 3-5 with a 3.54 mark (27 ER, 68.2 IP) in 11 starts vs. the AL West last season.

CG SHUTOUT...logged his first career shutout, and 2nd career complete game June 3 vs. Tampa Bay...first CG since rookie season in 2005 (8/21/05 vs. LAD w/FLA)...was the first shutout by a Mariners pitcher since **Felix Hernandez** on June 30, 2010 at New York (AL), and first by a Mariner at Safeco Field since Cliff Lee on June 18, 2010 vs. Cincinnati...added a second shutout June 19 vs. Philadelphia and a third July 1 vs. SD...**is first Mariner to record a trip of shutouts at Safeco Field in the same season** (Jamie Moyer had two in 2002).

9.0 INNINGS (AGAIN & AGAIN & AGAIN)...threw 9.0 shutout innings July 1 vs. SD, his 4th start of 9.0 ShO IP this season, but is credited with only 3 shutouts...held the Orioles to zero runs in 9.0 innings on May 12, but game was tied 0-0 and went into extra innings...is one of 4 pitchers this season with 4 or more starts without allowing a run in 9.0 innings (also, Cliff Lee-4).

9.0 SHUTOUT & NO-DECISION...on May 12 at Baltimore became the 4th pitcher in club history to record a no-decision while throwing at least 9.0 ShO inn...is first Mariner since Tim Belcher (6/4/95 at BOS), joining Erik Hanson (10.0 IP, 8/1/90 at OAK) & Mike Moore (6/29/88 vs. TEX).

LONG TIME COMING...snapped his career-high 9-game losing streak with a win on April 29 at Boston...was his first victory since Aug. 14, 2010 at Cleveland...went 0-9 with a 5.67 ERA (47 ER, 74.2 IP) in 13 starts between victories.

AT SAFECO...is 14-11 with a 3.13 ERA (77 ER, 221.1 IP) in 38 G/34 GS in his career at Safeco Field...went 7-5, 2.86 in 16 starts at Safeco Field in 2010, and is 5-5, 3.66 (32 ER, 78.2 IP) in 12 starts this season...owns the lowest ERA by a starter (min. 20 GS) in the history of Safeco Field: 1. Vargas (3.13), 2. Hernandez (3.17), 3. Bedard (3.35), 4. Fister (3.38), 5. Moyer (3.55).

2011 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS...

- Pitched 6.0 or more innings in 13 of 17 starts...averaging almost exactly 6.2 innings per start.
- Has a run support average of 3.65, 16th-lowest among AL starters...received 2 or fewer runs of support in 10 of 17 starts.
- in 5 June starts went 2-2 with a 2.82 ERA (12 ER, 38.1 IP) and 24 strikeouts & 8 walks.
- Recorded 16.0 consecutive scoreless innings over two starts, May 12 at BAL (9.0 IP) & May 18 vs. LAA (7.0 IP).
- Earned his first win of the season (and first since 8/14/10) April 29 at Boston...allowed 8 hits & 4 runs in 7.0 innings.
