OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics snapped their four-game losing streak...are 29-12 when scoring four or more runs compared to 11-41 when scoring less than
 four...are 24-21 at home compared to 16-32 on the road...have won seven of their past eight games against the Angels in Oakland...are 1-0 on this fourgame homestand against Los Angeles.
- Brandon McCarthy recorded a season-high-tying seven strikeouts (also April 15 vs. DET)...snapped his career-high five-game losing streak and is now 1-5 with a 4.07 ERA (27 er in 59.2 ip) in nine starts over that span...is 1-2 with a 2.33 ERA (10 er in 38.2 ip) at home and 1-3 with a 4.81 ERA (23 er in 43.0 ip) on the road.
- David DeJesus (1 for 3) is batting .389 (14 for 36) against Los Angeles this year and is a .342 (82 for 240) career hitter against the Angels, which is the best mark by any player against the team (min. 200 plate appearances).
- Hideki Matsui (1 for 4) snapped his 0 for 18 streak with a RBI single in the eighth inning...the hitless streak was one away from the longest of his career, which came earlier this season when he went 0 for 19 from May 27 to June 4.
- Kurt Suzuki (2 for 3) is 11 for 34 (.324) over his last 10 games after going 2 for 30 over his previous eight games...is 10 for 29 (.345) against Los Angeles this year and is batting .322 (29 for 90) against AL West competition compared to .186 against everyone else.
- Josh Willingham (3 for 4) had a season-high-tying three hits (also June 3 at BOS) and is now 9 for 20 (.450) in five starts since being reinstated from the disabled list July 7.
- Joey Devine left the game in the sixth inning with thoracic spasms in his upper back.

LOS ANGELES NOTES

- The Los Angeles Angels had their four-game winning streak snapped...are 18-31 when their opponents score first and 32-12 when scoring first...are 4-9 in their last 13 games in Oakland compared to 10-3 in their last 13 games against the A's at home...are 0-1 on this four-game road trip to Oakland.
- Dan Haren allowed a season-high-tying 10 hits (third time, last: June 24 at LAD)...did not walk a batter, his eighth start this season in which he has not allowed a walk...had his four-game winning streak snapped and is now 4-1 with a 2.17 ERA (9 er in 37.1 ip) over his past five starts...is 5-6 with a 3.70 ERA (31 er in 75.1 ip) at night compared to 5-0 with a 1.65 ERA (12 er in 65.1 ip) during the day.
- Erick Aybar (2 for 5) extended his hitting streak to seven games (10 for 28, .357) and has now hit safely in 17 of his past 20 contests (25 for 83, .301).
- Alberto Callaspo (1 for 4) is 13 for 39 (.333) over his past 12 games.
- Mike Trout (1 for 4) recorded his first career RBI with a single in the sixth inning.
