#### **OAKLAND NOTES**

The Oakland Athletics have lost seven of their last nine games and 14 of the last 20...are 2-7 in this stretch of 11 consecutive games against all three AL
West opponents...are 12-21 in one-run games, which is the worst record in the majors...have allowed 52 unearned runs, which is the most in the
majors...are 1-1 on this four-game homestand against Los Angeles.

L — Cahill (8-8)

- Trevor Cahill threw a career-high 119 pitches (previous: 118, June 19, 2011 vs. SF)...is 2-8 with a 4.08 ERA (37 er in 81.2 ip) over his last 13 starts after going 6-0 with a 1.72 ERA in his first eight starts...is 3-3 with a 2.06 ERA (12 er in 52.1 ip) in eight starts against AL West competition.
- David DeJesus (2 for 3) is batting .410 (16 for 39) against Los Angeles this year and is a .346 (84 for 243) career hitter against the Angels, which is the best mark by any player against the team (min. 200 plate appearances).
- Scott Sizemore (0 for 4) is 0 for his last 18, which matches the longest hitless streak of his career (May 10-July 22, 2010)...is 3 for 32 (.094) over his last nine games after batting .343 in his first 21 games with the A's.
- Kurt Suzuki (1 for 3) is 12 for 37 (.324) over his last 11 games after going 2 for 30 over his previous eight games...is 11 for 32 (.344) against Los Angeles this year and is batting .323 (30 for 93) against AL West competition compared to .186 against everyone else.
- Ryan Sweeney (0 for 0) pinch ran for Matsui in the eighth inning and remained in the game in left field...that extended his errorless streak to 166 games, which is an Oakland record for outfielders.
- Jemile Weeks (3 for 4) had a season-high-tying three hits (fourth time, last: June 25 at PHI) and is now batting .368 (25 for 68) at home.
- Josh Willingham (0 for 3) had his seven-game hitting streak snapped...batted .393 (11 for 28) during the streak.

- The Los Angeles Angels have won five of their last six games and nine of their past 11...are 9-3 this month after going 9-17 in July last season...are 18-13 in day games this season...are 33-12 when scoring first and 18-31 when their opponents score first...are 1-1 on this four-game road trip to Oakland.

- Jered Weaver earned the 76<sup>th</sup> win of his career, passing Jarrod Washburn for sole possession of 10<sup>th</sup> place on the Angels all-time list...is on a six-game winning streak and has a 1.40 ERA (12 er in 77.1 ip) in 10 starts over that span...had his 12-inning scoreless streak snapped when Suzuki hit a sacrifice fly in the seventh inning...had his streak of seven or more innings pitched snapped at nine consecutive starts...is 5-6 with a 3.00 ERA (38 er in 114.0 ip) in 18 career starts against the A's.
- Erick Aybar (2 for 5) extended his hitting streak to eight games (12 for 33, .364) and has now hit safely in 18 of his past 21 contests (27 for 88, .307)...is a .331 (93 for 281) career hitter in July.
- Alberto Callaspo (1 for 1) had a career-high-tying three walks (also Sept. 29, 2009 at NYY)...is 14 for 40 (.350) over his past 13 games.
