#### OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics recorded their third walk-off win of the season (last: May 16 vs. LAA)...improve to 6-10 in extra-inning games and 13-21 in one-run games...are 25-22 at home compared to 16-32 on the road...have won eight of their past 10 games against the Angels in Oakland...are 2-1 on this four-game homestand against Los Angeles.
- Today's doubleheader was the first scheduled doubleheader in Oakland since August 10, 1997 against Milwaukee...the A's split a doubleheader for the first time since May 26, 2001 at Minnesota...the A's and Angels played two for the first time since July 30, 1983 at California, a sweep by the A's...the A's and Angels have now played 15 doubleheaders and Oakland is 5-1-9, including 4-0-7 in Oakland.
- Rich Harden** is 1-1 with a 5.00 ERA (10 er in 18.0 ip) in three starts since being reinstated from the 60-day disabled list July 1, including 1-0 with a 3.46 ERA (5 er in 13.0 ip) in two starts at home...is 6-3 with a 3.77 ERA (41 er in 98.0 ip) in 16 career appearances, 15 starts, against Los Angeles.
- David DeJesus** (1 for 4) is a .344 (85 for 247) career hitter against the Angels, which is the best mark by any player against the team (min. 200 PA).
- Scott Sizemore** (2 for 5) recorded his first career walk-off hit...snapped his 0 for 18 streak with a bunt single in the third inning...the hitless streak matched the longest of his career (also May 10-July 22, 2010).
- Eric Sogard** (1 for 3) recorded the first extra-base hit of his career with a double in the seventh inning.
- Ryan Sweeney** (2 for 5) is 14 for 41 (.341) over his last 15 games and is now a .331 (55 for 166) career hitter against the Angels.
- Jemile Weeks** (2 for 5) went 5 for 9 in the doubleheader and is now batting .370 (27 for 73) at home compared to .242 (15 for 62) on the road.

#### LOS ANGELES NOTES

- The Los Angeles Angels fall to 6-10 in extra-inning games this season...are 5-10 in their last 15 games in Oakland compared to 10-3 in their last 13 games against the A's at home...are 1-2 on this four-game road trip to Oakland.
- Today's doubleheader was the first scheduled doubleheader for the Angels since September 9, 1978 against Kansas City.
- Ervin Santana** allowed a season-high-tying 10 hits (also April 18 at TEX)...is 1-0 with a 2.48 ERA (8 er in 29.0 ip) over his past four starts...has tossed six or more innings in 17 of his 20 starts this season...is 13-3 with a 2.00 ERA (32 er in 143.2 ip) in 23 career appearances, 21 starts, against the A's.
- Erick Aybar** (1 for 3) extended his hitting streak to nine games (13 for 36, .361) and has now hit safely in 19 of his past 22 contests (28 for 91, .308).
- Mark Trumbo** (1 for 4) hit a two-run home run in the second inning and has now homered in five of his past eight games (five total)...has 18 home runs this season, which is the most among American League rookies.
