### **OAKLAND NOTES**

- The Oakland Athletics have won three of the past four games to snap their four-game losing streak...are 26-22 at home compared to 16-32 on the road...have now won nine of their past 11 games against the Angels in Oakland...went 3-1 on this four-game homestand against Los Angeles...begin a five-game road trip through Detroit (two games) and New York (three games) Tuesday.
- The A's scored seven runs before their first out of the game for the first time in Oakland history...scored a total of eight runs in the first inning, their most
  runs in an inning this season (previous: 6, May 17 vs. LAA, 6<sup>th</sup> inning)...it was their first time scoring eight or more runs in the first inning since scoring
  nine runs September 3, 2006 against Baltimore.
- Gio Gonzalez is 4-1 with a 1.62 ERA (7 er in 39.0 ip) over his past six starts...is 7-2 with a 1.88 ERA (15 er in 72.0 ip) in 11 starts at home and 4-2 with a 2.45 ERA (10 er in 36.2 ip) in six starts against AL West competition...is 5-2 with a 2.72 ERA (14 er in 46.1 ip) in eight career appearances, all starts, against Los Angeles.
- Coco Crisp (2 for 4) snapped a 0 for 11 streak with a single in the first inning...is batting .348 (16 for 46) against Los Angeles this year.
- Conor Jackson (2 for 3) hit a grand slam in the first inning...it was his first career grand slam and the first by an Athletic this season.
- Hideki Matsui (1 for 3) had a season-high three RBI (previous: 2, seven times; last: July 1 vs. ARI).
- Jemile Weeks (2 for 3) went 9 for 16 (.563) on the homestand and is now batting .382 (29 for 76) at home compared to .242 (15 for 62) on the road.

### **LOS ANGELES NOTES**

- The Los Angeles Angels have lost three of the last four games to snap their four-game winning streak...are 5-11 in their last 16 games in Oakland compared to 10-3 in their last 13 games against the A's at home...went 1-3 on this four-game road trip to Oakland...begin a three-game homestand against Texas Tuesday.
- Joel Pineiro allowed seven earned runs, the most by an Angels starter since Ervin Santana allowed nine August 4, 2010 at Baltimore...pitched 0.1 innings, which is the shortest start of his career and shortest by an Angel since John Lackey was ejected without recording an out May 16, 2009 at Texas...prior to Lackey's ejection, the shortest start by an Angel was when Santana went 0.1 innings August 28, 2007 at Seattle.
- Erick Aybar (0 for 2) had his nine-game hitting streak snapped...batted .361 (13 for 36) during the streak.
- Alberto Callaspo (3 for 4) is 18 for 49 (.367) over his past 14 games.
- Torii Hunter (0 for 3) is on a 0 for 15 streak.
- Howie Kendrick (0 for 4) is 1 for 17 (.058) since his 18-game hitting streak (22 for 69, .319) was snapped.
