#### **THE TWINS:** The Twins are 3-3 on this 11-day, 10-game road trip after splitting a four-game series at Texas and splitting the first two games in Oakland...today, the Twins will continue the trip with the final game of a three-game series in Oakland... the Twins have won three of their last four vs. the A's...following this series, the Twins have a scheduled off day on Monday before starting a three-game series in Anaheim on Tuesday...they are 5-1-2 in their last eight series.

TWINS FALL TO A'S AFTER TWO EARLY LEADS: The Twins had 1-0 and 2-1 leads, but lost to the A's 8-3 last night in Oakland...Nick Blackburn (7-8) was the starter and loser, allowing seven runs (six earned) on 10 hits in 4.1 innings...he issued five walks (one intentional) and recorded two strikeouts...Anthony Swarzak allowed one unearned run on one hit in 2.2 innings, with one walk and four strikeouts...Jose Mijares pitched a scoreless eighth inning...the Twins were limited to eight hits, as Jim Thome led the way, going 2-for-4 with a double, rbi and a run scored...Michael Cuddyer was 1-for-4 with a rbi and Delmon Young was 1-for-3 with a rbi...the Twins were 3-for-10 with runners in scoring position and left five runners on base.

TWINS VS. OAKLAND: The Twins have won three of their last four games vs. the A's and 11 of their last 17 games overall, dating back to September 13, 2009...over the 17 game stretch the Twins pitching staff has posted a 2.63 ERA (154.0 ip, 45 er), with the A's hitting just .243 (139-for-571) vs. the Twins...the Twins have won five of their last six in Oakland...the with a win today, the Twins would win the season series vs. the A's for the second consecutive season (they were 6-3 vs. Oakland in 2010).

PERK PITCHING PERFECT: Glen Perkins has allowed just one earned run over his last 18 appearances (dating back to June 26), going 3-0, 0.59 ERA (15.1 ip, 1 er) with two saves...he has allowed just five hits, two walks (both intentional) while recording 20 strikeouts...over that span, he has held opponents to a .102 (5-for-49) batting average...35 of his 43 appearances this season have been scoreless and he has yet to allow more than one run in an appearance.

NATHAN FINDING HIS GROOVE: Since coming back from the disabled list on June 24 Joe Nathan has pitched in 13 games, allowing just two runs in 12.1 innings (1.46 ERA)...he has allowed just seven hits and struck out 10 without allowing a walk... opponents are batting just .159 (7-for-44) off him during the 13-game stretch.

COMPANY AT THE TOP: Joe Nathan's save Tuesday night was the 255th of his career, and his 254th as a member of the Twins...he tied Rick Aguilera for first on the Twins All-Time saves list Wednesday night...additionally, Nathan has converted five consecutive save opportunities since moving back into the closer's role.

THOME ON THE MOVE - TRACKING DOWN SOME LEGENDS: Jim Thome has 1,706 career walks, just two shy of tying Mel Ott for eighth on baseball's all-time list...additionally, after driving in a run in last night's game, Thome has 1,751 runs batted in, just one shy of tying Tony Perez for 27th on baseball's all-time list...Thome has a career .557 slugging percentage, tying him with Willie Mays and Mickey Mantle.

HITTERS THAT GET TO OAKLAND - AND HIT WELL AT OAKLAND COLISEUM: Joe Mauer has a career .323 (63-for-195) batting average vs. Oakland, including hitting .312 (34-for-109) in Oakland...additionally, Delmon Young has hit .329 (28-for-85) in Oakland while Jason Kubel owns a career .310 (27-for-87) average in Oakland.

LIMITING THE WALKS: The Twins have walked 10 batters in their last two game and have now walked 319 batters this season...only the White Sox (289), Mariners (287) and Indians (278) have walked fewer batters in the A.L. this season. the Twins issued 702 walks in 2010, fewest in the A.L. and second-fewest in the Major Leagues behind Philadelphia (681).

MINOR LEAGUE PLAYER OF THE WEEK: New Britain (Eastern League - Double-A) left-handed pitcher Tyler Robertson is the Twins Minor League Player of the Week for July 23-30...Robertson, 23, was 1-0 with one save in three appearances for the Rock Cats...he did not allow a run and recorded seven strikeouts while walking three batters in his 5.0 innings last week...Robertson was selected by the Twins in the third round of the 2006 First-Year Player Draft out of Bella Vista (CA) High School...he entered the season with a career 30-32 minor league record and a 3.71 ERA over 98 appearances (95 starts).

LAST START: Did not factor into the decision in the Twins' 9-8 victory, July 26 at Texas opposite C.J. Wilson. surrendered eight earned runs for the sixth time in his career and first since July 10, 2009 vs. Kansas City, when he allowed nine...gave up a 3-run home run to Yorvit Torrealba in the fourth...Twins rallied in the ninth inning, scoring two runs off of Neftali Feliz on a Nishioka grounder and Mauer double.

TWO STARTS AGO...: Was the loser in the Twins' 6-2 defeat, July 21 vs. Detroit opposite Justin Verlander. started the first of four games at Target Field against the Tigers..lost to the Tigers for the first time since April 29, 2010 and lost to them in a home start for the first time in his career...tossed 6.0-plus innings in an outing for the 12th straight start...gave up a two-run homer to Brennan Boesch in the fifth inning. threw 103 pitches, 74 strikes

FIRST-HALF WRAP-UP: Went 6-6, 4.10 (123.0 ip, 56 er) with 24 walks and 53 strikeouts in 18 starts.

- Started Opening Day, April 1 at Toronto, allowing eight runs (seven earned) on six hits in 4.0 innings (L).
- » Started the 2011 Home Opener, April 8 vs. Oakland, allowing one run on four hits in 8.0 innings (W).
- » Recorded his 100th career victory and his 15th career complete game, June 3 at Kansas City.
- » Recorded his 16th career complete game, June 15 vs. Chicago (AL).
- » Went 3-1, 2.54 (39.0 ip, 11 er) in five June starts...his 39.0 innings pitched ranked 10th in the AL.
- » Logged his 1,000th career strikeout, June 26 at Milwaukee, fanning Prince Fielder in the fifth inning.
- » Pitched 7.0-plus ip in 12 starts and 8.0-plus in six starts.
- » Led the Twins pitching staff in innings pitched with 123.0...ranked 15th in the American League.

THE DIFFERENCE OF DIVISIONS: Pavano has gone 4-2, 3.61 (57.1 ip, 23 er) with two complete games eight starts against the AL Central this season and 25-15, 4.32 (300.0 ip, 144 er) in 46 career games (45 starts)...he is 22-13 against his own division since 2009 and 12-6 since 2010.

» He is 9-7, 4.64 (149.1 ip, 77 er) in 23 career starts against the American League West...he is 1-1, 4.63 (35. ip, 18 er) in five starts this season, beating Oakland on April 8 and losing to Los Angeles on May 29.

TRAVELING MAN: Pavano has won three of his last four road decisions...in his career, he is 51-57, 4.72 (811.2, 426 er) in 142 career road games (133 starts).

» Prior to his last start, he had allowed just 13 earned runs in his last six road starts (44.0 ip) for an ERA of 2.66...he tossed 7.0-plus in five of those six.

**PAVANO PER USUAL:** Pavano started the season with a record of 2-4, 6.64 (42.0 ip, 31 er) with opponents batting .294 with 11 doubles, two triples, five home runs, 11 walks and 17 strikeouts in his first seven starts...in his last 14 starts, he is 4-3, 3.73 (99.0 ip, 41 er) with opponents batting .280 (109-for-389) with 23 doubles, nine home runs, 17 walks and 42 strikeouts...he has pitched 7.0-or-more innings in 10 of the 14.

SUMMER'S WHERE IT BEGINS: Last year, Pavano was 5-5, 3.99 (65.1 ip, 29 er) at the end of May...from June 3rd through the rest of the 2010 season, Pavano went 12-6, 3.64 (155.2 ip, 63 er)...he went 8-0, 2.36 (76.1 ip, 20 er) in 10 starts from June 9-July 27, 2010.

This season he is 4-2, 4.02 (71.2 ip, 32 er) with two complete games since the start of Ju

CARL COMPLETE: Pitched the 16th complete game of his career on June 15 vs Chicago (AL)...his nine comce the start of 2010 are third-most in baseball behind Roy Halladay (15) and Cliff Lee (11).

**ON STRIKE:** His 59 strikeouts entering today are the fifth-fewest in baseball among pitchers with a minimum of 100.0 innings pitched...he ranks behind Brad Penny (53), Kyle McClellan (55), Wade Davis (56).

#### THIS AND THAT ON PAVANO:

- He reached 1,000 strikeouts on June 26 at Milwaukee, fanning Prince Fielder in the fifth inning...earlier in June, he reached his 100th career victory in the Majors, beating Kansas City on June 3.
- » He pitched 6.0-plus innings in 12 consecutive starts from May 18 to July 21...also 15 times in 21 starts this season, going 6-3, 2.98 (111.2 ip, 37 er) in those outings.

#### **CAREER NOTES**

- He was originally drafted by the Boston Red Sox in the 13th round of the 1994 First-Year Player Draft
- Graduated from Southington (Conn.) High School in 1994, winning the state championship as a senior.
- Traded to the Expos in November of 1997 in a deal that sent Pedro Martinez to Boston.
- Won a World Series as a member of the Florida Marlins in 2003...started Game 4 vs. NYY (8.0-7-1-1-0-4).
- Was a 2004 National League All-Star as a member of the Florida Marlins.
- Finished sixth in the National League Cy Young Award voting in 2004...Roger Clemens was the winner.
- His 18 wins in 2004 were good for second-most in the National League.
- Signed a four-year contract with the New York Yankees after the 2004 season and appeared in 26 games over the four-year span after missing time with numerous injuries, including "Tommy John" surgery in 2007.
- Has spent seven different stints on the disabled list in his career: 1999, 2000, 2001, 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008 (one time in each of those seasons).
- He is in his 18th season at the professional level and 14th in the Major Leagues
- Traded to the Twins on August 7, 2009 from Cleveland for PTBNL (RHP, Yohan Pino).
- Signed a two-year contract to remain with the Twins, January, 19, 2011.
