OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have lost six straight against Texas, which is the A's longest losing streak against the Rangers since they also lost six straight July 7, 1999-May 6, 2000...are 0-1 on this 10-game homestand against Texas (0-1), Baltimore (three games) and Toronto (four games).
- Brandon McCarthy left the game in the fourth inning with a right knee contusion...allowed a career-high-tying seven runs (third time, last: April 26, 2011 at Los Angeles)...had his career-high-tying four-game winning streak snapped (also May 24-Sept. 8, 2009)...had a 2.78 ERA in five starts over that span.
- Trystan Magnuson tossed a career-high 3.2 innings (previous: 3.1 ip, June 30, 2011 vs. Florida)...the innings match the most thrown in a game by an A's reliever this season (David Purcey, May 19 vs. Minnesota and Bobby Cramer, June 9 at Chicago).
- Conor Jackson (2 for 4) is batting .319 (30 for 94) since the All-Star Break after batting .243 before the break.
- Cliff Pennington (1 for 3) is 4 for 22 (.182) with 11 strikeouts over his past six games.
- Adam Rosales (0 for 1) is 0 for his last 25, which is the longest hitless streak of his career (previous: 17, June 12-23, 2010).
- Ryan Sweeney (1 for 3) is batting .322 (19 for 59) in 23 games since the All-Star Break...is 4 for 11 (.364) against Texas this year and is a .314 (44 for 140) career hitter against the Rangers.
- Jemile Weeks (0 for 4) is batting .211 (16 for 76) over his last 17 games.
- Josh Willingham (1 for 3) is batting .290 (31 for 107) in 29 games since he was reinstated from the disabled list July 7.
- Sonny Gray made his first start with Double-A Midland and did not allow a run (2.2 ip, 2 h, 1 bb, 5 so)...he threw 46 pitches, 31 strikes.

TEXAS NOTES

- The Texas Rangers have won six of the last eight games and are now 16-11 since the All-Star Break...are 21-12 against American League West competition this year...are 1-0 on this 10-game road trip through Oakland (1-0), Los Angeles (four games) and Chicago (three games).
- C.J. Wilson is 6-4 with a 2.68 ERA (27 er in 90.2 ip) in 13 starts on the road this year... is 4-5 with a 4.24 ERA (32 er in 68.0 ip) in 35 career appearances against Oakland, including 3-2 with a 3.63 ERA (16 er in 39.2 ip) in six starts.
- Elvis Andrus (1 for 4) has hit safely in 14 of his past 15 games (18 for 62, .290).
- Endy Chavez (3 for 4) recorded his eighth three-hit game of the season...his season-high is four hits (June 2 at Cleveland).
- Mike Napoli (1 for 4) is batting .403 (31 for 77) in 22 games since the All-Star Break.
- Yorvit Torrealba (1 for 4) is on a season-high 10-game hitting streak (18 for 41, .439)
- Michael Young (2 for 5) is on an 11-game hitting streak (17 for 49, .347)...is a .317 (238 for 750) career hitter against the A's...the 238 hits are his most against any team and the fifth most hits by any player against Oakland.
