OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics committed four errors, their most in a game since making a season-high five errors on Opening Day...now have 98 errors on the season, which is the most in the majors...are 34-48 in games started by a right-handed pitcher and 19-18 in games against left-handers...have lost seven straight against Texas, which is the A's longest losing streak against the Rangers since they dropped nine straight June 19-September 30, 1986...are 0-2 on this 10-game homestand against Texas (0-2), Baltimore (three games) and Toronto (four games).
- Trevor Cahill is 5-6 with a 2.62 ERA (25 er in 86.0 ip) in 13 starts at home and 4-5 with a 5.42 ERA (45 er in 74.2 ip) in 13 starts on the road... is 3-5 with a 3.11 ERA (22 er in 63.2 ip) in 10 starts against AL West competition and 6-6 with a 4.45 ERA (48 er in 97.0 ip) in 16 starts against everyone else.
- David DeJesus (1 for 4) is 10 for 32 (.313) with four doubles over his last eight games.
- Jemile Weeks (3 for 4) had a career-high-tying three hits (seventh time, last: July 27 vs. Tampa Bay)...recorded his seventh triple of the season, which is the third best total by a rookie in Oakland history (Luis Polonia, 10 in 1987; Mitchell Paige, 8 in 1977)...committed two errors and now has 11 on the season, which are the most by an AL second baseman...they are the most by an A's second baseman since Mark Ellis had 14 in 2003.
- Josh Willingham (1 for 4) is batting .288 (32 for 111) in 30 games since he was reinstated from the disabled list July 7...is 15 for 46 (.326) in 12 games against Texas this year.

- The Texas Rangers have won five of six and seven of the last nine games...are now a season-high 16 games over .500...are 17-11 since the All-Star Break...are 22-12 against American League West competition this year...are 2-0 on this 10-game road trip through Oakland (2-0), Los Angeles (four games) and Chicago (three games).
- Colby Lewis is 6-1 with a 2.96 ERA (24 er in 73.0 ip) over his past 11 starts...is 7-4 with a 2.95 ERA (26 er in 79.1 ip) in 12 starts on the road compared to 4-4 with a 5.15 ERA (42 er in 73.1 ip) in 12 starts at home...is 6-3 with a 3.12 ERA (31 er in 89.1 ip) in 16 career games, 14 starts, against the A's.
- Neftali Feliz has a 0.74 ERA (3 er in 36.1 ip) in 37 games against AL West competition since 2010.
- Josh Hamilton (2 for 4) has hit safely in 15 of his past 17 games (24 for 74, .324).
- Ian Kinsler (2 for 5) had three RBI and now has 12 RBI over his past seven games.
- Mike Napoli (1 for 4) has hit safely in 13 of his last 16 games (22 for 60, .367).
- Yorvit Torrealba (1 for 4) is on a season-high 11-game hitting streak (19 for 45, .422).
- Michael Young (1 for 4) is on a 12-game hitting streak (18 for 53, .340).
