#### OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have lost four of the last five games and are now a season-high-tying 14 games under .500 (fourth time, last: 49-62 on Aug. 5)...have made nine errors in the last five games and now have an American League-leading 99 for the season...have hit two home runs or fewer in each of the last 91 games, which ties the Oakland record for the longest such streak (July 31, 1974-May 16, 1975)...have lost eight straight against Texas, which is their longest losing streak against the Rangers since they dropped nine straight June 19-September 30, 1986...are 0-3 on this 10-game homestand against Texas (0-3), Baltimore (three games) and Toronto (four games).
- Rich Harden** started today on four days rest and is 0-2 with a 6.53 ERA (15 er in 20.2 ip) in four starts on five days rest or fewer compared to 3-0 with a 2.84 ERA (8 er in 25.1 ip) in four starts on six days rest or more...did not allow a home run, snapping his career-long streak of eight consecutive games with a home run allowed.
- Brandon Allen** (3 for 4) had a career-high-tying three hits (also Aug. 28, 2009 vs. Houston).
- David DeJesus** (0 for 3) has four errors in his last 34 games after going errorless over his previous 301 games.
- Jemile Weeks** (2 for 5) is batting .360 (31 for 86) during the day and .342 (41 for 120) at home.

#### TEXAS NOTES

- The Texas Rangers have won six of seven and eight of the last 10 games...are a season-high 17 games over .500...are now 18-11 since the All-Star Break...are 23-12 against American League West competition this year...are 3-0 on this 10-game road trip through Oakland (2-0), Los Angeles (four games) and Chicago (three games).
- Matt Harrison** is 1-1 with a 4.91 ERA (10 er in 18.1 ip) in three starts in August after going 3-0 with a 2.04 ERA in July...is 4-1 with a 4.10 ERA (17 er in 37.1 ip) in nine career games, six starts, against the A's.
- Neftali Feliz** is 3-0 with a 0.72 ERA (3 er in 37.1 ip) and 22 saves in 23 opportunities in 38 appearances against AL West competition since 2010.
- Ian Kinsler** (1 for 5) had his streak of seven consecutive games with one or more RBI snapped, which was the longest such streak of his career...had a total of 12 RBI over that span.
- David Murphy** (1 for 3) had a RBI single in the ninth inning...is batting .306 (19 for 62) over his last 20 games...has a seven-game hitting streak against Oakland (8 for 24, .333).
- Yorvit Torrealba** (2 for 5) is on a season-high 12-game hitting streak (21 for 50, .420).
- Michael Young** (0 for 2) had his 12-game hitting streak snapped...batted .340 (18 for 53) during the streak.
