OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have lost four straight and five of the last six games to fall to a season-low 15 games under .500, the first time they have been 15 games under since September 9, 2009 (62-77)...have hit two home runs or fewer in each of the last 92 games, which is an Oakland record (previous: 91 games, July 31, 1974-May 16, 1975)...are 0-4 on this 10-game homestand against Texas (0-3), Baltimore (0-1) and Toronto (four games).
- Gio Gonzalez is 0-5 with a 7.90 ERA (24 er in 27.1 ip) over his past five starts...the five-game losing streak matches his career high (also Aug. 17, 2008–June 30, 2009)...is 1-5 with a 6.29 ERA (24 er in 34.1 ip) in six starts since the All-Star Break after going 8-6 with a 2.47 ERA in 18 starts before the break...is 0-6 with a 5.85 ERA (26 er in 40.0 ip) in seven starts against AL East teams this year and 9-5 with a 2.43 ERA (29 er in 107.1 ip) in 17 starts against everyone else.
- Brandon Allen (3 for 4) has back-to-back three-hit games (6 for 8, .750)...the three hits match his career high (also Aug. 28, 2009 vs. Houston).
- Coco Crisp (1 for 3) is 25 for 74 (.338) over his last 19 games.
- David DeJesus (1 for 4) is 11 for 39 (.282) with five doubles over his last 10 games...has now hit nine doubles in 25 games since the All-Star Break after tallying just nine in 79 games before the break.
- Hideki Matsui (1 for 4) has now reached base safely via a hit or walk in 27 of his 28 games since the All-Star Break and is batting .394 (43 for 109) since
 the break.
- Jemile Weeks (1 for 5) has gone homerless in each of his 58 games, which is the longest since Mike Bordick set the Oakland record with a 132-game streak before hitting his first home run May 10, 1992.

BALTIMORE NOTES

Mark Reynolds (27)

- The Baltimore Orioles are 40-29 when scoring four or more runs compared to 7-43 when scoring fewer than four...are 32-19 when scoring first and 15-53 when their opponent scores first...are 1-0 on this 10-game road trip through Oakland (1-0), Los Angeles (three games) and Minnesota (four games).
- Tommy Hunter allowed a career-high 10 hits (previous: 9, four times; last: July 3, 2010 vs. Chicago)...is 1-1 with a 5.40 ERA (11 er in 18.1 ip) in four games, three starts, since joining the Orioles...is 5-0 with a 4.28 ERA (19 er in 40.0 ip) in eight career games, six starts, against Oakland.
- Vladimir Guerrero (1 for 4) singled in the seventh inning, the 2,535th hit of his career...that ties him with Roger Connor for 89th on the all-time list.
- Adam Jones (1 for 4) is batting .333 (31 for 93) over his past 23 contests.
- Nick Markakis (1 for 4) singled in the fourth inning and has now recorded a hit in 179 consecutive series, the longest active streak in the majors...is batting .292 (14 for 48) over his past 12 games.
- Matt Wieters (1 for 3) homered in the second inning and is now 12 for 41 (.293) over his last 11 games after going 7 for 44 (.159) in his previous 11 games.
