



# BALTIMORE ORIOLES GAME NOTES

Oriole Park at Camden Yards • 333 West Camden Street • Baltimore, MD 21201

Baltimore Orioles (46-72) vs. Oakland Athletics (53-67)  
RH Tommy Hunter (1-2, 4.67) vs. LH Gio Gonzalez (9-10, 3.25)

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Orioles and Athletics meet in the opener of their three-game set and the first game of a 10-game, 11-day road trip that will also take them to Anaheim and Minneapolis (four games)...The Orioles are coming off a 3-7 homestand which saw them go 1-2 against Toronto, 1-3 against Chicago and 1-2 against Detroit.

**VS. OAKLAND:** The season series is tied, 3-3, with the home team sweeping each series so far...The Orioles lost the season series 3-7 in 2010 as they went 2-4 in Baltimore and 1-3 in Oakland...The Orioles trail in the all-time series 240-242, going 116-122 in Baltimore and 124-120 in Oakland...The Orioles have not won a season series with the A's since going 8-3 in 1998 (they split eight games in 2007)...In the June 6-8 series, the O's completed their first three-game sweep of the A's in Baltimore since July 21-23, 1998...**Since the start of the 2008 season, the Orioles are 7-20 against the Athletics, including a 1-12 mark in Oakland and have been outscored 66-36 in those 13 games, scoring two or fewer runs in eight of the 13 contests.**

**HARDY'S HEROICS:** J.J. Hardy has been named AL Player of the Week for the week ending August 14...Hardy batted .323 (10-31) with two doubles, four homers and 10 RBI in the seven games...He is the second Oriole to win Player of the Week honors this year as Nick Markakis won the award for the week of July 14-17...Hardy has homered five times in his last eight games...He has three multi-homer games since July 26 and Friday marked his seventh career multi-homer game...In addition to signing a three-year extension on July 18, he:

- Leads AL shortstops with a .988 fielding percentage.
- Leads the major leagues in homers since June 1 (21), one ahead of Albert Pujols and Dan Uggla.
- His 10 homers since the All-Star break (July 13) are third behind Uggla (12) and Pujols (11).
- Is tied with Colorado's Troy Tulowitzki for the most home runs by a shortstop in the majors (23) despite playing in 28 fewer games than Tulowitzki.
- Has the most homers (23) by an AL East shortstop since Miguel Tejada hit 24 for the Orioles in 2006.
- Has 13 more home runs this year than the Orioles' shortstops hit the last three years combined.
- His 23 homers are the 3rd-best single season total for an O's SS since 2000 (Tejada: 34-'04 and 26-'05).
- Recorded an RBI in eight straight games from August 2-12, which tied for the 4<sup>th</sup>-longest streak in O's history and longest since Miguel Tejada collected an RBI in nine straight from April 8-17, 2005.

**ROAD WOES:** The O's have lost 14 of their last 17 road games...The Birds are 17-37 on the road this year...**The Birds have not won a road series since May 13-15 at Tampa Bay (2-1).**

**THE STREAK CONTINUES:** Needing a hit in the final game of the series yesterday to keep his streak alive, Nick Markakis had a three-hit day and has now recorded a base hit in 178 consecutive series, the longest active streak in the majors...He has had a hit in each series since being held hitless in a three-game series (he played in two of the games) by Tampa Bay May 23-25, 2008...According to Elias, Juan Pierre hit in 241 consecutive series from 2003-2007...Markakis would have to get a hit in each series from now until the second-to-last series in 2012 to catch him.

**IN A FUNK:** Since hitting the second ball to ever reach the second deck in left field at Camden Yards August 6, Mark Reynolds is 1-for-26 with 12 strikeouts.

**HOMER HAPPY:** The Orioles have already hit more home runs in 2011 (140) than they hit the entire 2010 season (133)...The O's hit their 133<sup>rd</sup> homer of 2011 on August 10...The O's have homered in 84 of their 118 games, tying them with the Yankees for the second-highest total in the big leagues behind Toronto (88)...The O's are 39-45 in games when they homer.

**ROUGH DAY AT THE OFFICE:** After walking just three batters in their previous 18.1 innings pitched (over five games), the bullpen walked three in one inning Sunday (Kevin Gregg-2 and Jim Johnson walked one intentionally)...The bullpen had allowed just one run in their previous 23.1 innings (over six games) before allowing four runs in three innings Sunday...Orioles pitchers have walked 25 batters in the last 11 games after issuing 24 free passes in the seven games before that.

**PLAYING CATCH-UP:** The Orioles have been outscored 87-40 in the first inning this year...The Birds have been outscored by 81 runs in the first three innings this year.

**RBI GUY:** Adam Jones has hit 18 of his 21 home runs at home...In the AL, only Mark Teixeira (20) and Curtis Granderson (19) have more home runs in their home park than Jones...Jones has driven in a career-high 72 runs in 118 games and is on pace for 99 RBI this year...Only two centerfielders in O's history have driven in 100 runs in a season: Brady Anderson (110) in 1996 and Mike Devereaux (107) in 1992...**In his last 22 games, Jones has 11 multi-hit games and has batted .337 (30-89) with six doubles and five homers...He has driven in 16 runs in those 22 games and has hit in 18 of them.**...Jones leads AL outfielders with 319 total chances and is tied for third in the AL with 11 outfield assists (first among MLB centerfielders)...Jones leads the majors in batting average with two outs (.355, 61-172) and his 21 homers are the second-most in the AL by a centerfielder (behind Curtis Granderson's 33)...The 21 homers are the fourth-most among AL outfielders.

**THE BOMB SQUAD:** The Orioles were the first team in the major leagues this year (now joined by the Yankees and Cubs) to have three players hit 20 or more home runs (Mark Reynolds-26, J.J. Hardy-23, and Adam Jones-21)...The Orioles have hit 140 homers and are on pace to hit 192 home runs in 2011 after hitting 133 in 2010...The 192-homer pace would be the most homers by an Oriole team since the 1997 team hit 196, which was the sixth-most homers in a single season in franchise history...**Since June 1, the Orioles' 92 home runs lead the majors and they have hit at least two homers in 29 of the 65 games since June 1.**...In the last seven years, only the 2008 Orioles had more 20-homer players (Aubrey Huff-32, Melvin Mora and Luke Scott-23 and Nick Markakis and Kevin Millar-20).

**RECORD PACE:** 3B Mark Reynolds (26 homers) is on pace to hit 36 home runs this year which would set a franchise record for homers by a third baseman (Tony Batista's 31 in 2002 is the record)...Reynolds' 23 errors at the hot corner broke Brooks Robinson's Orioles record for most errors by a third baseman (22 in 1958)...After making 20 errors in his first 79 games, Reynolds had made just one error in his next 37 games before a pair of miscues on Sunday.

**TOMORROW'S STARTER:** LH Brian Matusz is expected to be recalled from Triple-A Norfolk to make his seventh start of the year for the Orioles...In his six starts for the O's, Matusz is 1-4 with a 8.77 ERA...In his last four starts (June 12-30), Matusz averaged 3.2 innings per start and posted a 13.50 ERA (14.2IP, 22ER)...In four career starts against the Athletics, Matusz is 2-2 with a 5.48 ERA (23.0IP, 14ER)...He won his only start in Oakland on April 18, 2010 (6.1IP, 3ER)...In eight starts since being optioned to Norfolk, Matusz went 2-3 with a 3.62 ERA (49.2IP, 20ER) and in his last two starts was 2-0 with a 0.56 ERA (16.0IP, 1ER), including a shutout of Lehigh Valley in his last start (August 11)...Matusz missed the first two months of the season with a strained left intercostal muscle (upper back).

**Originally selected:** Selected in the supplemental round of the 2007 First Year Player Draft (54<sup>th</sup> overall) by the Rangers out of the University of Alabama as a draft-eligible sophomore.

**QUICK HITS:** Was acquired by the Orioles along with 1B **Chris Davis** on July 30 in exchange for RHP **Koji Uehara**...His 22 wins for Texas from 2009-10 were second-most for any Rangers pitcher behind **Scott Feldman's** 24...Was a member of the Gold-medal winning USA National Team...Attended the University of Alabama for two years.

**LIFETIME vs. OAKLAND:** Is 4-0 with a 4.59 ERA (33.1IP, 17ER) in seven games (five starts) against the A's...As a starter, Hunter is 4-0 with a 4.65 ERA (31.0IP, 16ER)...His last start against Oakland came on September 24, 2010, when he allowed one run on six hits in 5.1 innings and earned the win.

**LAST OUTING:** Worked 6.2 innings, allowing four runs on seven hits but did not factor in the decision August 10 against the White Sox...Nolan Reimold hit a walk-off two-run home run in the bottom of the 10<sup>th</sup>.

**CAREER AS A STARTER:** In 46 major league starts in his career, Hunter is 22-13 with a 4.55 ERA (261.0IP, 132ER) and 21 Quality Starts.

**CAREER AT ORIOLE PARK:** In three career starts at Camden Yards, Hunter is 1-1 with a 5.30 ERA (18.2IP, 11ER).

**WITH TEXAS IN 2011:** Was 1-1 with a 2.93 ERA (15.1IP, 5ER) in eight relief appearances for the Rangers.

**WITH TRIPLE-A ROUND ROCK IN 2011:** Was 2-2 with a 5.06 ERA (26.2IP, 15ER) in eight games (five starts) for Triple-A Round Rock

**BIG WINNER:** Hunter's .688 winning percentage (22-10) over the 2009-10 seasons ranked eighth in the majors among pitchers with at least 30 decisions in that span...Hunter's .765 (13-4) winning pct. was best in the majors in 2010...His 13 victories after beginning of June were T4th-most in the majors behind only **C.C. Sabathia** (17), **Trevor Cahill** (14), and **Roy Halladay** (14)...Hunter became the first pitcher in Texas history with 13 wins with 22 or fewer starts and the first in the majors since **Andy Pettitte** for New York-AL in 2002 (13-5, 22 starts)...**Gaylord Perry** is the only other Texas pitcher with as many as 12 wins in a season of 22 or fewer starts.

**GAME 4 GUY:** Was on all three Texas postseason rosters last fall, starting Game 4 in each of the club's playoff series.

**QUALITY STUFF:** Hunter made seven straight quality starts from June 22-July 25 to match **C.J. Wilson** (April 8-May 13) for longest streaks among Rangers in 2010.

**DISABLED LIST:** Began the season on the DL for Texas after suffering a strained right groin in a spring training start on March 24...During his rehab start for Triple-A Round Rock on May 9, re-aggravated the injury on his final pitch...Made seven rehab appearances (four starts) for the Express from June 4-30, going 1-2, 6.53 ERA (20.2IP, 15.0ER)...The last three outings came in relief...Was reinstated from DL July 1 and made his season debut for Texas on July 2 at Florida in relief.

**STREAKER:** Tied **Kenny Rogers** for the third-longest winning streak by a starter in Rangers history as he won eight straight from June 5-July 25, 2010...**Bobby Witt** (12) and Rogers (nine) have the only longer streaks...Became the first starter in Rangers history to begin a season 8-0 exclusively as a starter.

**BIRTHDAY PARTY:** Earned a 3-1 win on July 3, 2010 vs. Chicago (AL) (7.0IP, 1ER), a night on which he also celebrated his 24th birthday...Earned a victory on his birthday for the second consecutive season, as his first major league win came on July 3, 2009 vs. Tampa Bay...The most recent major league pitcher to earn victories on consecutive birthdays had been Tim Wakefield for Boston on August 2 of both 2004 and 2005.

**RARE LINE:** Did not record a strikeout or issue a walk over 8.0 innings in a 6-4 win on August 22, 2010 at Baltimore, marking the first time in over four years a pitcher tossed at least 8.0 innings without a walk or strikeout...The other two pitchers in the past 11 seasons (2000-2010) to pull the trick both did it against Minnesota in May 2006: Detroit's **Justin Verlander** (May 17, 2006 at Detroit) and Seattle's **Joel Pineiro** (May 1, 2006 at the Metrodome)...Only one other pitcher in Rangers history had done it (8.0+ IP, 0 BB, 0 SO): **Jon Matlack** on May 11, 1979 at Toronto (9.0 IP).

**A COMPLETE DEBUT:** Made his 2010 season debut on June 5 vs. Tampa Bay and recorded a complete game in a 6-1 Texas victory...According to Elias, Hunter became the first pitcher in 19 years to earn a CG victory against an opponent with the outright best record in the majors (36-19) in his first appearance of a season...The last pitcher to do so was San Francisco's **Mike Remlinger** on June 15, 1991 vs. Pittsburgh at Candlestick Park.

**CAREER FIRSTS:** Made his major league debut August 1, 2008 against TOR (no decision)...Recorded his first major league win on his 23<sup>rd</sup> birthday as he beat TB on July 3, 2009...Recorded first win in relief July 5, 2011 against BAL...Tossed first ML complete game on Sept. 13 (G1) vs. SEA.

**FAST RISER:** Hunter began the 2008 season in high Class-A Bakersfield and reached the big leagues on August 1 after nine starts for the Blaze, eight starts for Double-A Frisco Roughriders and eight starts for the Oklahoma RedHawks.

**ROLL TIDE:** Played two seasons for the University of Alabama, where he was used as both a starter and a closer...Received freshman second-team All-America honors with the Crimson Tide in 2006 after going 10-3, 3.30 (117.1IP, 43ER) with 80 strikeouts, 22 walks and one save over 20 games (16 starts)...Entered the 2007 college season as a preseason All-American, as selected by the *National College Baseball Writers Association* and *Rivals*...Was also listed on the 2007 Roger Clemens Award Watch List...Led Alabama's staff in wins (seven), saves (five), innings pitched (107.0) and strikeouts (96) in 2007 as a draft-eligible sophomore...Registered a 3.87 ERA (107.0IP, 47ER) in 26 games (11 starts).

**PERSONAL:** Raymond Thomas Hunter...Attended Indianapolis Cathedral High School where he played baseball and football...Originally drafted out of high school by Tampa Bay in the 18th round of the 2005 June draft...Earned a gold medal with the 2006 USA National Baseball Team, alongside fellow Rangers 2007 draftee **Julio Borbon**...Went 3-0, 3.80 (21.1IP, 9ER) in the tournament, posting 23 strikeouts to just 4 walks over 14 games (one start)...signed by Rangers scout **Jeff Wood**.

The O's have 13 position players on the active roster, 7 right-handers, 4 left-handed hitters and 2 switch hitters...Orioles batters were 8<sup>th</sup> in the AL with a .259 average & 11<sup>th</sup> with a .702 OPS last season...They were 12<sup>th</sup> in the league with a .661 OPS with RISP...O's DHs ranked 2<sup>nd</sup> in OPS (.865), average (.278), HR (31) and 5<sup>th</sup> in RBI (85)...Baltimore PHs batted .131 (8-61) with a .459 OPS in 2010.
