OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics snapped their four-game losing streak...the streak matched their longest home losing streak of the season (also May 30-June 14)...snapped their five-game homerless streak, which was one short of the season high of six (May 16-21)...have committed 10 errors in the last seven games and now have 100 for the season...had committed 100 errors in a season just once over the previous seven years (105 in 2009)...snapped their four-game losing streak against Baltimore, which was their longest since May 23, 1998-April 23, 1999 when they lost eight straight...are 76-35 (.685) against the Orioles since the start of the 1999 season, which is the best winning percentage against the Orioles by an AL team over that span...are 1-4 on this 10-game homestand against Texas (0-3), Baltimore (1-1) and Toronto (four games).
- Guillermo Moscoso** is 4-1 with a 3.15 ERA (14 er in 40.0 ip) in seven starts at home compared to 2-5 with a 3.80 ERA (18 er in 42.2 ip) in nine games, seven starts, on the road.
- Brandon Allen** (1 for 3) hit his first career triple in the eighth inning...is now 7 for 13 (.538) in four games since he was recalled from Triple-A Sacramento Saturday.
- Hideki Matsui** (1 for 4) has reached base via a hit or walk in 28 of his 29 games since the All-Star Break and is batting .389 (44 for 113) since the break.
- Cliff Pennington** (3 for 4) is batting .360 (32 for 89) since the All-Star Break after batting .235 before the break...is 11 for 28 (.393) against Baltimore this year and is a .361 (26 for 72) career hitter against the Orioles.
- Jemile Weeks** (2 for 5) is 15 for 45 (.333) in his last 10 games after going 9 for 50 (.180) in his previous 11 games...is batting .338 (44 for 130) at home.
- Josh Willingham** (2 for 4) hit a home run in the third inning, his team-leading 20th of the season...has now reached the 20 home run plateau four times in his career (last: 2009, 24 home runs)...is a .347 (26 for 75) career hitter against the Orioles with five home runs and 13 RBI in 21 games.

- The Baltimore Orioles are 5-10 in the month of August...have lost 15 of their last 19 road games and are now 18-38 on the road on the season...are 15-54 when their opponent scores first compared to 32-19 when scoring first...are 1-1 on this 10-game road trip through Oakland (1-1), Los Angeles (three games) and Minnesota (four games).
- Brian Matusz** is 0-5 with an 11.81 ERA (28 er in 21.1 ip) over his past five starts...is now 2-3 with a 6.07 ERA (20 er in 29.2 ip) in his five career starts against Oakland.
- J.J. Hardy** (0 for 4) is 0 for 17 over his past four games after going 13 for 33 (.394) in his previous eight games.
- Adam Jones** (1 for 3) is batting .333 (32 for 96) over his past 24 contests.
- Nick Markakis** (1 for 4) is batting .288 (15 for 52) over his past 13 games.
