



# BALTIMORE ORIOLES GAME NOTES

Oriole Park at Camden Yards • 333 West Camden Street • Baltimore, MD 21201

Baltimore Orioles (47-72) vs. Oakland Athletics (53-68)  
LH Brian Matusz (1-4, 8.77) vs. RH Guillermo Moscoso (5-6, 3.52)

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Orioles and Athletics meet in game two of their three-game set and the second game of a 10-game, 11-day road trip that will also take the O's to Anaheim and Minneapolis (four games)...The Orioles have won consecutive games for the first time since July 16-17 and are in search of their first three-game winning streak since June 6-10, when they won four straight...**Brian Matusz** looks to snap a four-game losing streak.

**VS. OAKLAND:** The Orioles lead the season series, 4-3, with the Birds going 1-3 in Oakland and 3-0 in Baltimore...The Orioles lost the season series 3-7 in 2010 as they went 2-4 in Baltimore and 1-3 in Oakland...The Orioles trail in the all-time series 241-242, going 116-122 in Baltimore and 125-120 in Oakland...In the June 6-8 series, the O's completed their first three-game sweep of the A's in Baltimore since July 21-23, 1998...**Since the start of the 2008 season, the Orioles are 8-20 against the Athletics, including a 2-12 mark in Oakland and have been outscored 68-42 in those 14 games, scoring two or fewer runs in eight of the 14 contests.**

**JUST DO IT:** A win in either of the remaining two games of this series would clinch the Orioles' first season series win over Oakland since 1998 (O's went 8-3).

**FINISH THEM OFF:** In the last six series where the Orioles won the series opener, the Orioles have gone just 1-12 in the remaining games of those six series...The Orioles have won seven series openers on the road this year, including their last four in a row (includes last night)...The Orioles have won just two of the six road series after claiming the series opener (April 1-3 at Tampa Bay and April 29-May 2 at Chicago).

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT...:** The Orioles won for the second time on the road when being out-hit (now 2-27) and are now 5-58 overall when being out-hit...It was the second road win of the year when allowing 10 or more hits (also July 3 at Atlanta).

**HARDY'S HEROICS: J.J. Hardy has been named AL Player of the Week for the week ending August 14...**Hardy batted .323 (10-31) with two doubles, four homers and 10 RBI in the seven games...He is the second Oriole to win Player of the Week honors this year as **Nick Markakis** won the award for the week of July 14-17...Hardy has homered five times in his last nine games...He has three multi-homer games since July 26 and Friday marked his seventh career multi-homer game...In addition to signing a three-year extension on July 18, he:

- Leads AL shortstops with a .988 fielding percentage.
- Leads MLB in homers since June 1 (21), one ahead of **Albert Pujols**, **Mark Reynolds** and **Dan Uggla**.
- His 10 homers since the All-Star break (July 13) are third behind **Uggla** (12) and **Pujols** (11).
- Is second behind Colorado's **Troy Tulowitzki** (24) for the most home runs by a shortstop in the majors (Hardy has 23) despite playing in 28 fewer games than Tulowitzki.
- Has the most homers (23) by an AL East shortstop since **Miguel Tejada** hit 24 for the Orioles in 2006.
- Has 13 *more* home runs *this year* than the Orioles' shortstops hit the *last three years combined*.
- His 23 homers are the 3rd-best single season total for an O's SS since 2000 (Tejada: 34-'04 and 26-'05).
- Recorded an RBI in eight straight games from August 2-12, which tied for the 4<sup>th</sup>-longest streak in O's history and longest since **Miguel Tejada** collected an RBI in nine straight from April 8-17, 2005.

**QUALITY CONTROL: Jo-Jo Reyes and Tommy Hunter** have given the Orioles consecutive Quality Starts in the last two games...The last time the Orioles had consecutive Quality Starts was July 19-24, when they had five straight...The O's played 19 games between consecutive Quality Starts.

**ROAD WOES:** The O's have lost 14 of their last 18 road games...The Birds are 18-37 on the road this year...**The Birds have not won a road series since May 13-15 at Tampa Bay (2-1).**

**ALL OR NOTHING:** Since hitting the second ball to ever reach the second deck in left field at Camden Yards August 6, **Mark Reynolds** went 1-for-28 with 14 strikeouts before homering Monday off **Trystan Magnuson**.

**PLAYING CATCH-UP:** The Orioles have been outscored 87-40 in the first inning this year...The Birds have been outscored by 80 runs in the first three innings this year.

**RBI GUY: Adam Jones** has hit 18 of his 21 home runs at home...In the AL, only **Mark Teixeira** (20) and **Curtis Granderson** (19) have more home runs in their home park than Jones...Jones has driven in a career-high 72 runs in 119 games and is on pace for 98 RBI this year...Only two centerfielders in O's history have driven in 100 runs in a season: **Brady Anderson** (110) in 1996 and **Mike Devereaux** (107) in 1992...**In his last 23 games, Jones has 11 multi-hit games and has batted .333 (31-93) with six doubles and five homers...He has driven in 16 runs in those 23 games and has hit in 19 of them.**...Jones leads AL outfielders with 322 total chances and is tied for third in the AL with 11 outfield assists (first among MLB centerfielders)...Jones leads the AL in batting average with two outs (.353, 61-173) and his 21 homers are the second-most in the AL by a centerfielder (behind **Curtis Granderson's** 33)...The 21 homers are the fourth-most among AL outfielders.

**RECORD PACE: 3B Mark Reynolds** (27 homers) is on pace to hit 37 home runs this year which would set a franchise record for homers by a third baseman (**Tony Batista's** 31 in 2002 is the record)...Reynolds' 23 errors at the hot corner broke **Brooks Robinson's** Orioles record for most errors by a third baseman (22 in 1958)...After making 20 errors in his first 79 games, Reynolds had made just one error in his next 37 games before a pair of miscues on Sunday.

**THE BOMB SQUAD: Since June 1, the Orioles' 94 home runs lead the majors** (by eight over Boston) and they have hit at least two homers in 30 of the 66 games since June 1...Additional home run notes:

- The O's have already hit more home runs in 2011 (142) than they hit the entire 2010 season (133)... The O's hit their 133<sup>rd</sup> homer of 2011 on August 10.
- The Orioles were the first team in the major leagues this year (now joined by the Yankees and Cubs) to have three players hit 20 or more home runs (**Mark Reynolds-26**, **J.J. Hardy-23**, and **Adam Jones-21**).
- The O's have hit 142 homers and are on pace to hit 193 home runs, which would be the most homers by an Oriole team since the 1997 team hit 196 (the 6<sup>th</sup>-most homers in a single season in franchise history).
- In the last seven years, only the 2008 Orioles had more 20-homer players (**Aubrey Huff-32**, **Melvin Mora** and **Luke Scott-23** and **Nick Markakis** and **Kevin Millar-20**) than the 2011 club.
- The O's have homered in 85 of their 119 games, the second-highest total in the big leagues behind Toronto (89)...The O's are 40-45 in games when they homer.

**TOMORROW'S STARTER: RH Alfredo Simon** makes his eighth start of the year and fourth road start...In his three road starts, Simon is 1-2 with a 3.78 ERA (16.2IP, 7ER)...Simon has never started against the Athletics, but is 0-1 with one save and a 11.57 ERA (4.2IP, 6ER) in three relief outings against Oakland...His loss came on May 27 of this year in Oakland, his only career appearance at the Coliseum.

**QUICK HITS:** Last name is pronounced MAT-iss...Is making his 47<sup>th</sup> major league start (Orioles are 23-23 when he starts)...Missed the first two months of the 2011 season with a strained left intercostal muscle (upper back)...Is in his third pro season...Attended the University of San Diego, where he was a two-time finalist for the Golden Spikes Award and led the NCAA in strikeouts with 141 in 2008.

**MATUSZ VS. OAKLAND:** In four career starts against the Athletics, Matusz is 2-2 with a 5.48 ERA (23.0IP, 14ER)...He won his only start in Oakland on April 18, 2010 (6.1IP, 3ER).

**AT ORIOLE PARK:** In 23 home starts in his career, Matusz is 7-11 with a 5.01 ERA (125.2IP, 70ER)...10 of his 23 starts have been Quality Starts and he has worked fewer than 5.0 innings in a home start just five times (once when he was hit by a line drive and removed as a precaution).

**ON THE ROAD:** In his 23 career road starts, Matusz is 9-7 with a 4.64 ERA (120.1IP, 62ER) and 10 Quality Starts...The Birds are 13-10 in those 23 contests.

**ROUGH STRETCH:** In his last four starts (June 12-30), Matusz averaged 3.2 innings per start and posted a 13.50 ERA (14.2IP, 22ER)...He lost his last four decisions and was optioned to Norfolk after the June 30 start against St. Louis.

**AT TRIPLE-A NORFOLK:** In eight starts with Norfolk after being optioned there on July 30, Matusz was 2-3 with a 3.62 ERA (49.2IP, 20ER) and in his last two starts was 2-0 with a 0.56 ERA (16.0IP, 1ER), including a shutout of Lehigh Valley in his last start (August 11).

**STREAK SNAPPED:** Matusz had his career-best seven game winning streak snapped June 12 against Tampa Bay...During that 10 start span, he was 7-0 with a 1.74 ERA (57.0IP, 11ER) and the O's were 10-0...According to Elias, the O's won all 10 of those games started by Matusz despite never scoring more than five runs in any single game, something that has happened just one other time in the last 30 years for the Orioles...The only other Orioles starter since 1981 to win as many as 10 straight games started by one pitcher despite the team scoring five or fewer runs in each game was **Erik Bedard**, who won 12 straight from June 21-August 21, 2007.

**DISABLED LIST:** Matusz was on the disabled list from March 30-June 1 with a strained left intercostal muscle...Matusz made three rehab starts with minor league affiliates in May and worked 15.0 innings, allowing two earned runs on nine hits and four walks while striking out 10.

**LEADER OF THE PACK:** In 2010, led AL rookies in strikeouts (143), innings pitched (175.2) and games started (32) and finished second in opponents' average (.255), tied for second in wins (10) and was third in ERA (4.30).

**INTERLEAGUE PLAY (CAREER):** Has made six Interleague starts and is 0-5 with a 7.49 ERA (33.2IP, 28ER)...The Orioles have lost all six games he started...Matusz is hitless in four at-bats in his major league career.

**STRONG FINISH:** Went 6-0 with a 1.57 ERA (46.0IP, 8ER) over his final eight starts starting August 19...The Orioles won each of those eight games.

**CONGRATS:** Was named AL Rookie of the Month for August 2010 as he went 4-1 with a 2.43 ERA (37.0IP, 10ER) in six August starts...He is the first Oriole to be named Rookie of the Month since **Nolan Reimold** (June 2009) and the first O's pitcher to win the award since **Rodrigo Lopez** (July 2002).

**AT HIS BEST AGAINST THE BEST:** In 2010, his 3.70 ERA (80.1IP, 33ER) against the AL East was his lowest against any AL division...Had a 4.03 ERA vs. the Central and a 5.84 ERA vs. the West...In nine career starts against the Yankees and Red Sox, Matusz is 4-3 with a 2.49 ERA (61.1IP, 17ER).

**LACK OF SUPPORT:** In his 32 starts in 2010, the Orioles scored two or fewer runs while Matusz was in the game 17 times...The Orioles went 6-11 in those 17 games and Matusz was 1-9, with his lone win coming in his last start of the year, October 2 against Detroit.

**THANKS FOR NOTHING:** In Matusz' 32 starts in 2010, the Birds scored 119 runs (3.7 runs per game) and just 82 runs while Matusz was in the game (2.6 runs per game)...Matusz received 28 runs of support while he was in the game (average of 1.7 runs per game) in his 17 starts from April 29-July 29...Matusz was 1-11 in those 17 starts.

**MASTERFUL:** In his last eight starts of 2010 (46.0IP), only 24 runners reached second base (seven of those were September 6 at New York) against Matusz...The left-hander was 6-0 with a 1.57 ERA (46.0IP, 29H, 8ER) in those eight outings.

**SOX SLAYER:** Matusz finished 2010 with a 2-0 record in five starts against the Red Sox, which according to Elias made him the first rookie in 66 years to go undefeated in five starts in one season against Boston...The last to do so was the St. Louis Browns' **Sig Jakucki** in 1944 (4-0 in five starts)...The Browns franchise became the Baltimore Orioles in 1954.

**GET AHEAD:** In 2010, Matusz held opposing hitters to a .161 average (58-360) in two-strike counts...For his career, opponents are batting just .165 (74-449) once he has two strikes on them.

**EARLY ISSUES:** Matusz allowed 88 runs in 2010, with 41 of them (47 percent) scoring in the first three innings.

**HIDE THE LEFTIES:** In his 40 career starts entering 2011, LH batters are batting .214 (39-182) with just three doubles, three triples and four homers...In 2010, he allowed six extra-base hits to lefties (three doubles, a triple and two homers) in 147 AB.

**AWARDS GALORE:** Won the 2009 Jim Palmer Award for the best pitcher in the Orioles' minor league system...Was named Orioles Organizational Pitcher of the Month for June and July of 2009...Was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week with Double-A Bowie, July 6-12, 2009...Was named to the 2009 Carolina League All-Star Team with Single-A Frederick, but was promoted to Bowie before the game...Was named the Carolina League Pitcher of the Week, May 25-31, 2009...Pitched in MLB Futures Game for Team USA on July 12, 2009 in St. Louis...Named the Orioles' #1 prospect by *Baseball America* after the 2009 season.

The O's have 13 position players on the active roster, 7 right-handers, 4 left-handed hitters and 2 switch hitters... Orioles batters were 8<sup>th</sup> in the AL with a .259 average & 11<sup>th</sup> with a .702 OPS last season... They were 12<sup>th</sup> in the league with a .661 OPS with RISP... O's DHs ranked 2<sup>nd</sup> in OPS (.865), average (.278), HR (31) and 5<sup>th</sup> in RBI (85)... Baltimore PHs batted .131 (8-61) with a .459 OPS in 2010.
