★ **LAST SEASON:** Posted an overall record of 4-3 (3-1 at home & 1-2 on the road) vs. OAK.

★ **ALL-TIME:** Overall are 170-196, 82-102 at home & 88-94 on the road...The Jays have won three straight season series vs. OAK dating back to 2008, going 19-13 over that span...The Jays have won three of their last four season series in OAK dating back to 2007, posting a record of 11-7 over that span.

★ **LEADER OF THE PACK:** Despite missing 12 of the team's 123 games this season, Jose Bautista leads the Majors in HR (35), BB (98), OBP (.453), SLG (.639) & OPS (1.092).

★ **POWER GAME:** Jose Bautista currently leads the Majors with 35-HR this season...Also leads the ML with a HR every 11.09 AB (L. Berkman ranks 2nd at 12.86)...Dating back to 2009, Jose leads the AL with 45-HR after the All-Star Break (157 games).

★ **"GETTING ON" WITH IT:** Jose Bautista has reached base safely in 103 of his 111 games this year...No player in the ML has drawn more walks than Bautista (198) dating back to the start of 2010...Has drawn 29 more BB than the next highest player in the AL over that span (M. Cabrera).

★ **A FREE PASS:** Jose Bautista has walked 98 times in 111 individual games this season...The fewest games for any Blue Jays player to reach 100 walks in a season was 130 games for Carlos Delgado in 2000...The last MLB player to reach 100 walks in 115 or fewer games was Barry Bonds in 2007 (87 games)...The last AL players to reach 100 walks in 115 or fewer games were Jason Giambi (114 games in 2000) & Jim Thome in 1997 (111 games)...courtesy of Elias.

★ **RED HOT:** Edwin Encarnacion has now reached base safely in 16 consecutive contests dating back to July 31...Over that time is batting .385 (20-52) with 8- XBH (4-2B, 4-HR), .515 OBP & a .692 SLG...Since July 7, Edwin leads the Majors with an OBP of .479...Among the AL since that time, ranks 2nd in OPS (1.104), SLG (.625), T-2nd in 2B (12) & 3rd in AVG (.375).

★ Since the All-Star break, Edwin leads the Majors in OBP (.477)...Among the AL since the break, ranks T-1st in times on base (62), 2nd in OPS (1.109), SLG (.632), runs (27), T-3rd in BB (22), T-4th in 2B (11) & 7th in AVG (.358).

★ **A TOUGH OUT:** Yunel Escobar has reached base safely in 15 straight & 44 of his last 47 contests dating back to June 18...Leads all shortstops in the Majors with 53-BB & AL shortstops in OBP (.372) & times on base (185).

★ **FIRST "IMPRESS"-IONS:** In 12 games since making his MLB debut on Aug. 5, Brett Lawrie is batting .357 (15-42) with 7- XBH (3-2B, 1-3B & 3-HR) & has recorded five multi-hit games, over that span...Among all rookies in the Majors since his debut, ranks T-1st in XBH (7), 2nd in SLG (.690), OPS (1.104), TB (29), 3rd in AVG (.357), OBP (.413), T-3rd in HR (3) & RBI (9).

★ **HOMER HAPPY:** The Blue Jays have now hit a home run 11 straight contests dating back to Aug. 6 (19 total)...No Club in the AL has hit more HR than TOR over that stretch...The Jays also lead the AL in August with 23-HR.

★ **THE LATEST:** With last night's 5-1 victory in the finale of a 3-game set at SEA, the Blue Jays improved to 63-60 on the season...Have now won back-to-back series (2-1 vs. LAA & 2-1 at SEA)...The Jays have now scored 39 runs over his last five games...Have won four of their last five & six of their last 10 contests...Are a season high three games above .500 for the 4th time this year...Have not been four games over .500 since the end of last season (85-77).

★ **Among the AL,** since July 8, are 4th in the AL in winning % (.618, 21-13) & 4th in winning % (.581, 18-13) since the break.

★ **WHERE WE STAND:** Are 4th in the AL East, 12.0 GB of the 1st place Yankees (74-47)...Are 11.5 GB of the 2nd place Red Sox (74-48), 3.5 GB of the 3rd place Rays (66-56) & 15.0 GA of the 5th place Orioles (47-74).

★ **ON THE ROAD AGAIN:** Tonight, the Blue Jays continue a 7-day, 7-game road trip with the opener of a 3-game set at Oakland...Are 2-1 on the trip after winning last night's series finale vs. SEA by a score of 5-1...Outscored the M's by a count of 23-14 over those three games, slamming 8-HR in the process.

★ Are 32-31 on the road this season, having won four of their last six & nine of their last 15 contests...Have won back-to-back series on the road (2-1 at BAL & 2-1 at SEA) of three games or more for the 1st time this season.

★ **Among the AL on the road,** Jose Bautista leads in HR (18), BB (52), OBP (.441), OPS (1.048) & 2nd in SLG (.607).

★ **DOWN ON THE FARM:** Last night, Las Vegas (AAA) blanked Memphis, 11-0...OF Travis Snider led the way offensively, going 1-for-4 with a HR, 3-RBI, BB & 2R...SS Adeiny Hechavarria went 2-for-4 with a walk & a run scored...In six games since being promoted from New Hampshire (AA), Adeiny is batting .560 (14-25) with 3-2B & 3-BB, recording a multi-hit performance in each of his six contests with the 51s.

Has 18 quality starts in 24 outings this season to rank T-6th in the AL...Team is only 12-12 in his starts having scored a total of 24 runs in the 12 losses...Is trying to win five straight starts for the first time in his career (4 starts, 2x).

- Won his 4th straight start (2x career) Aug. 13 vs. LAA...Allowed only one run and two hits over seven innings...7.0IP, 2H, ER, HR, 2BB, 3K.
- Aug. 7 at BAL, pitched eight or more innings for the 3rd consecutive start and 8th time this season.
- Evened his record at 9-9 with a 3-1 win, Aug 2 at TB...Allowed only one hit in his eight innings.
- Record his 2nd career shutout and 3rd complete game of the season 5-0 at St.L, June 26...Drove in two runs with his first career hit.
- Lost his 7th, 0-2 to ATL on June 20, allowing only two runs in seven innings...The two runs came on a 2-run home run by pitcher Tim Hudson in the bottom of the 7th.
- Won his 6th, 4-1 over BAL...Fanned a career high 12 for the 3rd time.
- June 4 at BAL, Matched his career high by allowing 11 hits...7.2IP, 11H, 5ER, HR, 3BB, 5K
- Picked up his 3rd win of the season at MIN, May 13 and came within one out of a shutout...8.2IP, 4H, 3BB, 8K.
- Suffered his first loss, despite tossing his 4th career complete game, Apr. 12 at SEA...Lost 2-3, 8.0IP, 5H, 2ER, HR, 2BB, 8K
- Became the first Blue Jays left-handed pitcher since Jimmy Key in 1989 to win on Opening Day. Became the 14th Blue Jays pitcher to win on Opening Day...Defeated the Twins by a score of 13-3 (6.1IP, 7H, ER, 7K).
- Became just the fourth Blue Jays left-hander to start on opening day and first since David Wells in 2000 (Tom Underwood-1979, Jimmy Key 1987-1989, David Wells-2000).

GETTING SOME RECOGNITION:

- Was named AL Player of the Week (ending Aug. 7)...In two starts went 2-0 with a 1.69 ERA, 12K, 4BB & just five hits allowed in 16.0 IP en route to winning his 1st career A.L. Player of the Week Award...Joins Jose Bautista as a weekly winner for the Jays this season & is the 1st Toronto hurler to win A.L. Player of the Week since Roy Halladay on May 18, 2009.

ON A ROLL:

- In his last four starts, all victories has posted a 1.15 ERA (31.1IP, 11H, 4ER, 9BB, 24K)...All four runs have come on solo homeruns...Opponents have hit just .114 (9-79)...Has pitched at least seven innings in all four starts.

REVERSE LEFTY:

- In his career has fared better vs. right-handed hitters holding them to a .236 average (.197 in 2011). Left-handed hitters are batting .277 (.256 in 2011).

ONE FOR THE AGES:

- Became the first American League pitcher to drive in two or more runs while tossing a shutout on June 26 at St.L, since California's Clyde Wright had two RBI in a two-hit, 4-0 win against the Rangers at Anaheim on September 14, 1972, the year before the designated-hitter rule was implemented in the American League.
