- ★ THE LATEST: With last night's 7-0 victory in the opener of a 4-game set at OAK, the Blue Jays improved to 64-60 on the season...The Jays have now scored 46 runs over his last six games...Have won five of their last six & seven of their last 11 contests...Are a season high four games above .500...Have not been five games above .500...Have not been five games aver .500 since the end of last season (85.77)
- contests...Are a season high **four** games above .500...Have not been **five** games over .500 since the end of last season (85-77). Among the AL, since July 8, are 4th in the AL in winning % (.629, 22-13) & 4th in winning % (.594, 19-13) since the break.
- ➡WHERE WE STAND: Are 4th in the AL East, 12.0 GB of the 1st place Yankees (75-47)...Are 11.5 GB of the 2nd place Red Sox (75-48), 3.5 GB of the 3rd place Rays (67-56) & 15.5 GA of the 5th place Orioles (47-74).
- ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Tonight, the Blue Jays continue a 7-day, 7-game road trip with the game two of a 4-game set at Oakland...Are 3-1 on the trip after winning last night's series opener at OAK by a score of 7-0...Have outscored opponents by a count of 30-14 over those four games, slamming 9-HR in the process.
- Are 33-31 on the road this season, having won five of their last seven & 10 of their last 16 contests...Have won back-to-back series on the road (2-1 at BAL & 2-1 at SEA) of three games or more for the 1st time this season...Are looking to win three consecutive series (three games or more) on the road for the first time since 4/10-26/09 (2-1 at CLE, 3-1 at MIN & 2-1 at CWS).
- *Among the AL on the road, Jose Bautista leads in HR (18), BB (53), OBP (.440), OPS (1.046) & 2nd in SLG (.606).
- → DOWN ON THE FARM: Last night, New Hampshire (AA) hammered Altoona, 11-2...RHP Nestor Molina pitched five shutout innings and struck out nine in just his second start with the Fisher Cats...Molina has allowed just one run over 11IP and has struck out 17 while just walking one...Offensively were led by RF Moises Sierra who was 3-for-4 with a walk, an RBI, a double and scored four times.

- <u>BLUE JAYS vs. A'S</u>: Are 4-3 vs. OAK this season (3-3 at home & 1-0 on the road)...Despite dropping three of their last five contests, the Jays have won 12 of their last 19 meetings dating back to 2009...TOR has also won eight of their last 12 games in OAK dating back to 2008.

- ➡ Jose Bautista currently leads the Majors with 35-HR this season...Also leads the ML with a HR every 11.20 AB (L. Berkman ranks 2nd at 12.86)....Dating back to 2009, Jose leads the AL with 45-HR after the All-Star Break (158 games).

- * "GETTING ON" WITH IT: Jose Bautista has reached base safely in 104 of his 112 games this year...No player in the ML has drawn more walks than Bautista (199) dating back to the start of 2010...Has drawn 30 more BB than the next highest player in the AL over that span (M. Cabrera).
- ♠ FREE PASS: Jose Bautista has walked 99 times in 112 individual games this season...The fewest games for any Blue Jays player to reach 100 walks in a season was 130 games for Carlos Delgado in 2000...The last MLB player to reach 100 walks in 115 or fewer games was Barry Bonds in 2007 (87 games)...The last AL players to reach 100 walks in 115 or fewer games were Jason Giambi (114 games in 2000) & Jim Thome in 1997 (111 games)...courtesy of Elias.
- *RED HOT: Edwin Encarnacion has now reached base safely in 17 consecutive contests dating back to July 31...Over that time is batting .375 (21-56) with 8-XBH (4-2B, 4-HR), .500 OBP & a .661 SLG...Since July 7, Edwin leads the Majors with an OBP of .473...Among the AL since that time, ranks 2nd in OPS (1.086), 3rd in SLG (.613), T-3rd in 2B (12) & 4th in AVG (.371).
- Since the All-Star break, Edwin leads the Majors in OBP (.470)...Among the AL since the break, ranks 2nd in OPS (1.088), T-2nd in times on base (63), runs (28), T-3rd in BB (22), 4th in SLG (.618), T-4th in 2B (11) & 7th in AVG (.355).
- FIRST "IMPRESS"-IONS: In 13 games since making his MLB debut on Aug. 5, Brett Lawrie is batting .378 (17-45) with 8-XBH (4-2B, 1-3B & 3-HR) & has recorded six multi-hit games, over that span...Among all rookies in the Majors since his debut, ranks 1st in XBH (8), SLG (.711), OPS (1.151), 2nd in TB (32), OBP (.440), T-2nd in RBI (10), 3rd in AVG (.378) & T-3rd in HR (3).

- SOLID RELIEF: Frank Francisco has not allowed a run over his last 10IP (10 games), which is his longest stretch of the season...Is just 2.2 innings off the Club season high by a reliever (Perez 12.2IP).
- <u>ACE OF JAYS:</u> With last night's 7-0 shutout Ricky Romero became the first Blue Jays pitcher to have two shutouts on the road in one season since David Cone (two) in 1995...courtesy of Elias...Also becomes only the second Blue Jays left-hander and first since Jimmy Key (4x, last 1992) to have two shutouts in the same season.
