After scoring 46 runs over six games the Blue Jays were shutout out for the fifth time this season... In 2010 the Jays were shutout eight times... Have won five of their last seven games & seven of their last 12 contests... A win today would return Toronto to a season high.
- four games above .500, done once (8/18- 64-60).

 Among the AL, since July 8, are 4th in the AL in winning % (.611, 22-14) & 4th in winning % (.576, 19-14) since the break.
- ➡WHERE WE STAND: Are 4th in the AL East, 13.0 GB of the 1st place Yankees (76-47)...Are 12.5 GB of the 2nd place Red Sox (76-48), 4.0 GB of the 3rd place Rays (67-56) & 15.5 GA of the 5th place Orioles (47-75).
- ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Tonight, the Blue Jays continue a 7-day, 7-game road trip with game three of a 4-game set in Oakland...Are 3-2 on the trip after losing 2-0 last night at OAK...Prior to the shutout, had outscored opponents by a count of 30-14 over the previous four games with 9-HR.
- Are 33-32 on the road this season, having won five of their last eight & 10 of their last 17 contests...Have won back-to-back series on the road (2-1 at BAL & 2-1 at SEA) of three games or more for the 1st time this season...Are looking to win three consecutive series (three games or more) on the road for the first time since 4/10-26/09 (2-1 at CLE, 3-1 at MIN & 2-1 at CWS).
- Among the AL on the road, Jose Bautista leads in HR (18), BB (56), OBP (.448), OPS (1.055) & 2nd in SLG (.607).
- ₱ DOWN ON THE FARM: Last night, Adeiny Hechavarria was 3-5 with 3 RBI and HR #7 on the season his first with Las Vegas...The 22 year old shortstop has hit in all eight games he has played since being promoted to AAA Las Vegas...In those games he is batting .529(18-34) win one HR and 5 RBI.

- <u>BLUE JAYS vs. A'S</u>: Are 4-4 vs. OAK this season (3-3 at home & 1-1 on the road)...Despite dropping three of their last six contests, the Jays have won 12 of their last 20 meetings dating back to 2009...TOR has also won eight of their last 13 games in OAK dating back to 2008.
- ◆ LAST SEASON: Posted an overall record of 4-3 (3-1 at home & 1-2 on the road) vs. OAK.
- ALL-TIME: Overall are 171-197, 82-102 at home & 89-95 on the road...The Jays have won three straight season series vs. OAK dating back to 2008, going 20-14 over that span...The Jays have won three of their last four season series in OAK dating back to 2007, posting a record of 12-7 over that span.
- ◆ LEADER OF THE PACK: Despite missing 12 of the team's 125 games this season, Jose Bautista leads the Majors in HR (35), BB (102), OBP (.457), SLG (.639) & OPS (1.096).
- ➡ Jose Bautista currently leads the Majors with 35-HR this season...Also leads the ML with a HR every 11.23 AB (L. Berkman ranks 2nd at 12.96)....Dating back to 2009, Jose leads the AL with 45-HR after the All-Star Break (158 games).

- "GETTING ON" WITH IT: Jose Bautista has reached base safely in 105 of his 113 games this year...No player in the ML has drawn more walks than Bautista (202) dating back to the start of 2010...Has drawn 33 more BB than the next highest player in the AL over that span (M. Cabrera-169).
- ↑ A FREE PASS: Last night Jose Bautista recorded three walks to give him 102 walks in 113 individual games...This is the fewest games for any Blue Jays player to reach 100 walks in a season, previous was 130 games by Carlos Delgado in 2000...Jose becomes the first MLB player to reach 100 walks in 115 or fewer games since Barry Bonds in 2007 (87 games)...The last AL players prior to Bautista to reach 100 walks in 115 or fewer games were Jason Giambi (114 games in 2000) & Jim Thome in 1997 (111 games)...courtesy of Elias.
- ₱ RED HOT: Edwin Encarnacion has reached base safely in 17 of his last 18 games dating back to July 31...Over that time is batting .350 (21-60) with 8-XBH (4-2B, 4-HR)...Since July 7, Edwin leads the Majors with an OBP of .461...Among the AL since that time, ranks 2nd in OPS (1.054), 5th in SLG (.594), T-3rd in 2B (12) & 5th in AVG (.371).
- Since the All-Star break, Edwin leads the AL in OBP (.457), 5th in OPS (1.053), T-4th times on base (63), 2nd runs (28), T-4th BB (22), 9th in SLG (.596), T-4th in 2B (11) & 10th in AVG (.342)
- ₱ FIRST "IMPRESS"-IONS: In 14 games since making his MLB debut on Aug. 5, Brett Lawrie is batting .367 (18-49) with 8-XBH (4-2B, 1-3B & 3-HR) & has recorded six multi-hit games, over that span...Among all rookies in the Majors since his debut, ranks T1st in XBH (8), SLG (.673), 2nd in OPS (1.099), in TB (33), 3rd in OBP (.426), T-2nd in RBI (10), 3rd in AVG (.367) & T-3rd in HR (3).
- GOOD DAY OFF: Since having the game off on August 13th, Jose Bautista has hit in six straight (9-19, 2HR) with 10 walks and posting a .655 on-base percentage (19-29).
- SOLID RELIEF: Frank Francisco has not allowed a run over his last 10IP (10 games), which is his longest stretch of the season...Is just 2.2 innings off the Club season high by a reliever (Perez 12.2IP).
- ◆ TRADING ZERO's: The A's and Jays have traded shutouts during the first two games of the series...Toronto last participated in consecutive shutouts in three straight games in 2010...Lost 1-0 on June 23 vs St.L, Won 5-0 on June 24 vs St. L and then lost 9-0 on June 25 at Philadelphia.
