OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics lost a 1-0 game in Oakland for the first time since July 19, 2009 against Los Angeles...have now been shutout 13 times this year, which is the most in the American League...had a season-low one hit (previous: 2, June 24 at Philadelphia)...are 20-53 when their opponent scores first compared to 37-17 when scoring first...split the season series with Toronto 5-5...have not won the season series since 2007 and are 15-21 against the Blue Jays since 2008...went 4-6 on this 10-game homestand against Texas (0-3), Baltimore (2-1) and Toronto (2-2)...begin a 10-game road trip through New York (three games), Boston (three games) and Cleveland (four games) Tuesday.
- Guillermo Moscoso** tossed a career-high 8.0 innings (previous: 7.0 ip, twice; last: July 6, 2011 vs. Seattle)...has been the starting pitcher in two of the A's three 1-0 losses this year (also June 24 at Philadelphia)...had his two-game winning streak snapped and now has a 1.80 ERA (4 er in 20.0 ip) over his past three starts...has never won three straight...is 4-2 with a 2.81 ERA (15 er in 48.0 ip) in eight starts at home this year...is 1-1 with a 2.25 ERA (4 er in 16.0 ip) in three career appearances, two starts, against Toronto.
- Coco Crisp** (0 for 4) is 4 for 30 (.133) over his past eight games after missing six games with a strained right calf.
- Kurt Suzuki** (0 for 3) is batting .203 (43 for 212) over his last 60 games after hitting .256 over his first 46 contests.
- Jemile Weeks** (1 for 4) is 19 for 63 (.302) over his last 15 games after going 9 for 50 (.180) over his previous 11 games...is batting .366 (34 for 93) during the day and .324 (48 for 148) at home.

TORONTO NOTES

- The Toronto Blue Jays had their first 1-0 win since September 23, 2010 against Seattle...are now 50-41 all-time in 1-0 games, including 8-3 in such games against Oakland...their 11 1-0 games against the A's are their most against any team...have won six of their last nine games and eight of their last 14...are 20-15 since the All-Star Break...went 4-3 on this seven-game road trip through Seattle (2-1) and Oakland (2-2)...begin a seven-game homestand against Kansas City (three games) and Tampa Bay (four games) Tuesday.
- Luis Perez** made his first Major League start after appearing in 29 games in relief this year...is 2-1 with a 2.43 ERA (8 er in 29.2 ip) on the road compared to 1-1 with a 4.50 ERA (10 er in 20.0 ip) at home...is 1-0 with a 2.16 ERA (2 er in 8.1 ip) in three career appearances, one start, against Oakland.
- Casey Janssen** recorded five strikeouts, which is his career high as a reliever (previous: 4, June 13, 2010 at Colorado).
- Jose Bautista** (2 for 3) hit his 36th home run of the season, which leads the Major Leagues...extended his hitting streak to seven games (11 for 21, .524)...also has 11 walks and has reached base safely in 22 of 33 plate appearances over that span.
- Edwin Encarnacion** (0 for 4) went 4 for 24 (.167) on the road trip.
- Mark Teahen** (0 for 3) is 2 for 32 (.063) over his last 15 games.
