- ➡THE LATEST: The Blue Jays lost 5-1 last night to the A's and trail the series two games to one...After scoring 46 runs in six games prior, the Jays have scored just one run in the last two games...Have lost two straight but Have won five of their last eight games & seven of their last 13 contests.
- Among the AL, since July 8, are 4th in the AL in winning % (.595, 22-15) & T4th in winning % (.559, 19-15) since the break.
- ➡WHERE WE STAND: Are 4th in the AL East, 13.0 GB of the 1st place Yankees (76-48)...Are 12.5 GB of the 2nd place Red Sox (76-49), 5.0 GB of the 3rd place Rays (68-56) & 15.5 GA of the 5th place Orioles (47-76).
- ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Today the Blue Jays will conclude a 7-day, 7-game road trip that began in Seattle with the final game of a 4-game set in Oakland...Are 3-3 on the trip after the last two games.
- Are 33-33 on the road this season, having won five of their last nine & 10 of their last 18 contests...Have won back-to-back series on the road (2-1 at BAL & 2-1 at SEA) of three games or more for the 1st time this season...A win today would split the series and would be the third consecutive series that the team has won or tied.
- Among the AL on the road, Jose Bautista leads in HR (18), BB (56), OBP (.448), OPS (1.055) & 2nd in SLG (.607).
- ◆ DOWN ON THE FARM: Yesterday the Lansing Lugnuts lost 10-9 in ten innings to Dayton...In the contest Toronto native Marcus Knecht hit his team leading 15th HR − a grand slam...The 6-0, 200 lb. right-handed hitting outfielder is now batting .289 with 31-2B and a team high 78 RBI − 4th best in Midwest League...OF Jake Marisnick was 2-5 to boost his average to .318 which is third in the Midwest League...The 6-4, 200lb. right-handed hitter has 22-2B, 12 HR, 71 RBI and 34 SB.

- BLUE JAYS vs. A'S: Are 4-5 vs. OAK this season (3-3 at home & 1-2 on the road)...Despite dropping four of their last six contests, the Jays have won 12 of their last 21 meetings dating back to 2009...TOR has also won eight of their last 14 games in OAK dating back to 2008.
- LAST SEASON: Posted an overall record of 4-3 (3-1 at home & 1-2 on the road) vs. OAK.
- ALL-TIME: Overall are 171-198, 82-102 at home & 89-96 on the road...The Jays have won three straight season series vs. OAK dating back to 2008, going 20-15 over that span...The Jays have won three of their last four season series in OAK dating back to 2007, posting a record of 12-8 over that span.

- "GETTING ON" WITH IT: Jose Bautista has reached base safely in 105 of his 113 games this year...No player in the ML has drawn more walks than Bautista (202) dating back to the start of 2010...Has drawn 32 more BB than the next highest player in the AL over that span (M. Cabrera-170).
- ♠ A FREE PASS: Friday night Jose Bautista recorded three walks to give him 102 walks in 113 individual games...This is the fewest games for any Blue Jays player to reach 100 walks in a season, previous was 130 games by Carlos Delgado in 2000...Jose becomes the first MLB player to reach 100 walks in 115 or fewer games since Barry Bonds in 2007 (87 games)...The last AL players prior to Bautista to reach 100 walks in 115 or fewer games were Jason Giambi (114 games in 2000) & Jim Thome in 1997 (111 games)...courtesy of Elias.
- ₱ RED HOT: Edwin Encarnacion has reached base safely in 18 of his last 19 games dating back to July 31...Over that time is batting .344 (22-64) with 8-XBH (4-2B, 4-HR)...Since July 7, Edwin leads the Majors with an OBP of .455...Among the AL since that time, ranks 3rd in OPS (1.038), 7th in SLG (.583), T-4th in 2B (12) & 5th in AVG (.356).
- Since the All-Star break, Edwin leads the AL is 4th in OBP (.451), 5th in OPS (1.035), T-4th times on base (64), 3rd in runs (28), T-4th BB (22), T-4th in 2B (11) & 11th in AVG (.339)
