#### OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have won the past two games after losing five straight...are now 9-8 over the last 17 games...have committed 108 errors on the season, which is the most by an A's team since 2001 (125)...are 36-30 at home compared to 26-46 on the road...are 1-0 on this six game homestand against Seattle (1-0) and Kansas City (three games)
- Guillermo Moscoso** snapped his two game losing streak...is 5-2 with a 2.62 ERA (16 er in 55.0 ip) in nine starts at home compared to 2-6 with a 4.82 ERA (25 er in 46.2 ip) in 10 games, eight starts, on the road...is 3-0 with a 0.45 ERA (1 er in 20.0 ip) in three starts against AL West teams...is 4-4 with a 3.22 ERA (23 er in 64.2 ip) in 12 games at night compared to 3-4 with a 4.38 ERA (18 er in 37.0 ip) in seven games during the day.
- Andrew Carignan** made his Major League debut and pitched a scoreless ninth inning.
- Hideki Matsui** (2 for 4) snapped a career-high-tying streak of 16 consecutive games without a walk (last: June 29-July 19, 2003)
- Cliff Pennington** (1 for 4) is batting .410 (16 for 39) with 14 RBI over his last nine games...is batting .344 (51 for 147) in 42 games since the All-Star break after hitting .235 in 88 games before the break.
- Michael Taylor** (0 for 3) made his Major League debut.
- Jemile Weeks** (1 for 3) extended his career-high hitting streak to 10 games...is batting .381 (16 for 42) with 11 runs scored during the streak.

- The Seattle Mariners have lost six of the last eight games and are now 15-31 since the All-Star Break...are 24-42 on the road this year...are 0-1 on this six game road trip through Oakland (0-1) and Los Angeles (three games).
- Jason Vargas** is 1-8 with a 6.49 ERA (44 er in 61 ip) over his last 11 starts...is 0-3 with a 4.83 ERA (13 er in 24.2 ip) against Oakland this year...is now 3-3 with a 4.59 ERA (20 er in 39.2 ip) in his career against Oakland.
- Dustin Ackley** (1 for 4) extended his hitting streak to a career-high-tying six games and is batting .429 (8 for 17) during that span.
- Chiro Suzuki** (1 for 4) has reached base safely in 15 of his past 16 games...is batting .338 (24 for 71) over that span.
- Casper Wells** (1 for 3) snapped a 0 for 30 streak with a double in the second inning.
