## Pitching Notes

### Tomorrow's Starter - Bruce Chen

- Bruce will start tomorrow's matinee finale...is 10-6 with a 4.11 ERA (55 ER in 120.1 IP) on the year and 58-56 in 312 career outings (164 starts).
- Cleveland brought Chen's career-best 5-game winning streak to a halt on Friday in KC...the Tribe built a 2-0 lead on 3 hits in the first...Asdrubal Cabrera belted a 2-run homer in the third and Jason Donald added a solo shot in the fourth...Bruce went 6.0 innings, taking the loss in a 5-4 game.
- Chen was 5-1 with a 3.19 ERA in August as he earned Royals Pitcher of the Month honors...despite Friday's setback, he is 14-6 over his last 27 starts.
- Bruce is 1-0 with a 1.45 ERA in 4 appearances (2 starts) at the Coliseum (3 ER in 18.2 IP)...he has faced the Athletics 10 times overall (6 starts), posting a 2-2 mark and a 4.18 ERA (22 ER in 47.1 IP)...the last outing was a win in Kansas City on September 15, 2010 (5.0 IP, 6 H, 3 ER).
- Tomorrow's start will be Chen's 10th of the year away from home...he is 5-4, recording a 4.30 ERA in 52.1 IP (25 ER).

- Nate made a last-minute start last Wednesday at Detroit, filling in for Felipe Paulino...Adcock settled down after allowing a run in the first, limiting Detroit to 2 runs over 5.1 IP while tossing 55 pitches (39 strikes)...he left a 4-2 game and took a no decision as Detroit rallied for a 5-4 win.
  - A 2010 Rule 5 pick from Pittsburgh, Adcock was 11-7 in 27 appearances (26 starts) in 2010 for Bradenton in the Florida State League.

- Jesse inherited 2 runners in the sixth on Sunday with 1 out and Cleveland up 4-1...he allowed a 3-run homer to Shelley Duncan with 2 outs...after a scoreless seventh, it was Duncan delivering again with a 2-run blast off of Chavez as the Indians went on to a 9-6 win.
  - Chavez was recalled from Triple-A Omaha on Thursday...he was 2-4 with a 3.75 ERA and 16 saves in 45 appearances (57.2 IP) for the Storm Chasers.

### Louis Coleman

- Louis worked around a pair of singles with 3 strikeouts in the seventh last Thursday at Detroit, keeping KC's 10-8 lead intact.
  - Coleman was named Royals Pitcher of the Month for July after posting a 0.61 ERA, the lowest in the A.L. among pitchers with at least 14.2 IP.
  - He earned his first Major League win in a 14-inning marathon on July 25 at Boston, becoming the 260th player in club history with at least one win.

### Aaron Crow

- Aaron entered Thursday's game with KC leading Detroit 6-5 in the sixth...he allowed 3 runs, including a 2-run blast to Austin Jackson that gave Detroit an 8-6 lead...KC rallied with 4 in the seventh en route to an 11-8 victory, lifting Aaron to his fourth win of the year.
  - Crow represented the Royals at the All-Star Game in Phoenix, though he did not pitch...he became the first player from the 2009 Draft class to earn All-Star status and the fourth rookie in franchise history, joining Ellie Rodriguez (1969), Kevin Seitzer (1987) and Mike MacDougal (2003).
  - The Mizzou product was KC's first-round pick (12th overall) in 2009...pitched at the High-A and AA levels in 2010, going 9-10 with a 5.73 ERA.

### Greg Holland

- Greg worked around a leadoff walk and an intentional pass with 2 outs to toss a scoreless eighth yesterday...recorded his fourth win in the 11-6 game.
  - He has allowed just 3.4% of his inherited runners on the year to score (1 of 29), best in the Majors among pitchers with 20 or more inherited runners.
  - Holland's ERA stands at 1.83 (11 ER in 54.0 IP), which is third among A.L. pitchers with at least 50.0 innings of work.
  - Holland has been dominant at home, posting a 3-0 record and a 0.35 ERA while limiting opponents to a .106 average (9-for-85) in 26.0 IP.
  - Greg earned his first Major League win in his 2011 debut on May 19 vs. Texas...was 2-0 with a 2.08 ERA and 2 saves in 13 games for Omaha.

- Joakim entered in the ninth yesterday after KC plated 5 in the top half...he fanned the side in order to close the 11-6 win.
  - Joakim continues to climb baseball's career list for saves...with his next rescue, he'll tie former Royal Tom Gordon and Dan Plesac for 65th all-time.
  - He recorded a career-high 43 saves in 2010 while earning his second A.L. All-Star nod and his second Royals' Bruce Rice Pitcher of the Year award.

### Everett Teaford (L)

- Everett inherited a pair of runners in the fifth yesterday with KC trailing 5-4...he allowed an inherited run on a sac fly but did not allow a hit over 2.2 scoreless innings, helping the Royals stay in a game that they would ultimately win, 11-6.
  - Teaford is in his third stint with KC on the year...was 3-2 with a 3.34 ERA in 16 outings (3 starts) for the Storm Chasers.
  - Everett entered on July 9 with KC leading Detroit 13-6 in the seventh...he tossed 3.0 shutout frames to earn his first save in the Majors.

### Blake Wood

  - Wood stranded 2 inherited runners in the eighth last Monday at Detroit and went on to notch his first Major League save with 2.0 scoreless frames.
  - He was recalled from Omaha (AAA) on April 14...he made 3 appearances with the Storm Chasers, tossing 5.0 scoreless frames with 6 K's.

**Hitting Notes**

**Billy Butler** *This Series: 3-for-4, 4 runs, 2 HR, 3 RBI, BB* *Last Stand: 5-for-11, run, 3 2B, RBI, 2 BB* *Hit Streak: 6 g (10-24)*

- Billy recorded his second straight 3-hit game yesterday with a single in the first, a solo homer in the third and a 2-run shot in the seventh...was his 6th career multi-homer game and second of 2011 (also July 29 at Cleveland)...has now hit in 6 straight (.417, 10-for-24)...has also hit in 20 of his last 24 games (.389, 37-for-95) with 22 RBI...is now tied for seventh in baseball with 38 doubles and tied for 10th in the A.L. with 157 hits.
- He is third in the Majors to Yankees' Cano (48) and Granderson (46) with 45 RBI since the All-Star break.
- He homered in a career best 4 straight games July 26-29, hammering 5 in that span, coming up a game shy of Mike Sweeney's 2002 club record.
- He won co-AL Player of the Week honors from July 25-31, the third of his career, hitting 13-for-32 (.406) with 5 homers and a .938 slugging pct.
- Leads all Major Leaguers since the start of 2009 with 134 doubles (NYY's Robinson Cano is second with 129).

**Melky Cabrera** *This Series: 2-for-5, 2 runs, RBI* *Last Stand: 3-for-12, 4 runs, 2B, RBI, BB* *Hit Streak: 6 g (8-26)*

- Melky was 2-for-5 yesterday with a single and run scored in the first and an RBI single and run in the ninth...now sixth in MLB with 39 doubles, 1 shy of joining teammates Jeff Francoeur (43) and Alex Gordon (41) as the first trio of Royals ever with 40+ doubles in a season...Billy Butler is 2 doubles from 40.
- Notched two outfield assists August 18 vs. Boston, including Carl Crawford at home to end the fourth...has 12 outfield assists, tied for sixth in MLB.
- His .343 (83-for-242) mark since July 2 is the sixth-best mark in MLB...has 30 extra-base hits and 38 RBI over that 59-game span.
- Has set career highs in 2011 in hits (177), doubles (39), homers (17), RBI (81), runs scored (89) and steals (17).
- He has 55 multi-hit games, second in the Majors behind Boston's Adrian Gonzalez (59).
- He ranks third in the A.L. in hits with 177 and eighth with 275 total bases...he is second in road average (.330).

**Alcides Escobar** *This Series: 1-for-4, run* *Last Stand: 2-for-2, RBI, Sac* *Hit Streak: 3 g (5-13)*

- Alcides returned to the lineup yesterday after a sprained left ankle and was 1-for-4, stealing two bases and scoring a run...the steals extended his career high total to 22...hit a solo home run on August 29 in Detroit, his first home run in 136 at bats.
- Is tied for first in the Majors with 17 sacrifice hits, tied for third-most all-time in Royals history and tied for seventh in American League with 6 triples.
- He leads all Major League shortstops in assists with 420; also leads in total chances (676), is second in putouts (242) and double plays (92).

**Jeff Francoeur** *This Series: 1-for-5, 2 RBI* *Last Stand: 3-for-8, 2 2B, 2 RBI* *Hit Streak: 5 g (8-22)*

- Frenchy was 1-for-5 yesterday with a two-run single in the first inning...the Major League-leading 44 doubles are tied with Jermaine Dye (1999) for the most all-time among Royals outfielders.
- Collected his 1,000th career hit last Thursday in Detroit on a 2-run homer in the second.
- He signed a 2-year extension thru 2013 on August 18...has set a career high with 19 steals and is tied for second in the Majors with 12 sac flies.
- Last Wednesday, he started a 9-4-2 out at the plate in the eighth for his 13th outfield assist, tied for fourth in baseball.
- Has hit in 25 of his last 31 (.328, 41-for-125)...over a longer stretch, is hitting .314 (70-for-223) with 26 doubles over his last 57 games since July 3.
- He is 10th in A.L. with 63 extra-base hits...he joins TB's Ben Zobrist and teammate Alex Gordon as the only three players in MLB with 40+ doubles, 15+ homers and 15+ stolen bases.
- Is batting .271 with a .740 OPS vs. right handers in 2011 after entering the season with career marks of .256 and .699.
- Leads all of baseball with 94 outfield assists since the 2005 season...2007 N.L. Gold Glove winner.

**Chris Getz** *This Series: run* *Last Stand: 2-for-7* *Hit Streak: 4 g (4-9)*

- Chris pinch ran in the ninth yesterday and scored what proved to be the winning run...started at shortstop for the second game in a row Sunday and was 1-for-4...he made his first Major League start and appearance at shortstop on August 26 in Cleveland.
- Has yet to homer as a Royal with the streak currently at 593 at bats, which is the longest to start a Royals career.
- He has swiped 20 bases in 27 attempts this season and is 61-for-73 in his career, an 83.6 percent success rate.

**Johnny Giavotella** *This Series: 0-for-4* *Last Stand: 3-for-12, run, HR, 3 RBI, BB* *Hit Streak: 0 g (0-4)*

- Johnny was 0-for-4 in yesterday's win, but began a spectacular 4-6-3 double play in the fourth.
- He had a memorable first weekend in the bigs by blasting his first career homer, a solo shot off Max Scherzer, in the fifth on August 7...he had his contract selected from Omaha (AAA) prior to the August 5 vs. Detroit...his first hit came later that evening, a double to right off Rick Porcello.
- Was hitting .338 in 110 games for the Storm Chasers, recording an minor league-leading 153 hits with 34 doubles, nine home runs, 72 RBI and 67 runs...was a PCL All-Star starter, PCL Player of the Month for June and hit a combined .391 (90-for-130) with 31 extra-base hits in June and July.

**Alex Gordon** *This Series: 1-for-4, run, 2B, RBI, BB* *Last Stand: 3-for-12, 2 R, HR, 3 RBI, BB, 2 SB* *Hit Streak: 10 g (17-42)*

- Alex was 1-for-4 with a walk yesterday, the hit a key RBI double in the ninth that gave KC a 7-6 lead...later scored on Cabrera's single...has now hit in 10 straight (.405, 17-for-42).
- Gunned down Fukudome at home plate to end the fifth on August 26, his 20th outfield assist on the season which is a single-season record for the Royals, breaking the mark of 17...leads all of baseball by 6...is one of 24 players in MLB since 1969 with 20+ assists.
- Gordo has hit .327 in his last 67 games (87-for-266) with 54 runs scored (2nd in Majors) since June 21.
- In addition to homers and doubles (41), also has career bests in runs (93), hits (167), RBI (76) and stolen bases (16).
- Overall, he ranks third in the Majors in doubles (41), fourth in A.L. extra-base hits (66), tied for fifth in hits (167), sixth in runs (93), seventh in total bases (277) and tied for eighth in multi-hit games (44)...also eighth in home batting average (.325, 92-for-283).

**Eric Hosmer** *This Series: 3-for-5, 2 runs, 2 2B, 2 RBI* *Last Stand: 3-for-11, 3 runs, 2B, 3 RBI, BB, SF* *Hit Streak: 3 g (6-13)*

- Eric was 3-for-5 yesterday with a RBI double in the first and RBI double in the ninth, scoring twice...recorded his first career two-homer game in Detroit last Wednesday with two solo shots.
- Leads A.L. rookies in hits (125), multi-hit games (34) and walks (34)...he's second in doubles (23), total bases (199), runs (53) and extra-base hits (41).
- He batted .426 (20-for-47) during career-best 11-game streak from July 19-30, including 7 multi-hit games, 5 doubles, a HR and 8 RBI.
- Of his 15 career homers, 10 have either tied the game (4) or give the Royals a lead (6)...his 22 go-ahead RBI and 10 game-winning RBI lead the Royals.
- Had his contract purchased from Omaha (AAA) on May 6...named Royals Player of the Month for May (.283, 5 HR, 17 RBI).
- Hit home runs in consecutive games on May 11 and 12 in New York, the first blast, his first MLB home run off A.J. Burnett.

**Mitch Maier** *This Series: Has not played* *Last Stand: 1-for-3, run, BB* *Hit Streak: 4 g (4-12)*

- Mitch made his first start since August 25 on Sunday vs. Cleveland in right field and was 1-for-3 with a walk and a run scored.
- He pitched the eighth inning on July 26, the eighth different position player in franchise history to take the mound and first since Tony Pena, Jr., in 2008 (10th instance)...Maier retired Dustin Pedroia on a fly ball to the Green Monster, then worked around a David Ortiz double for a scoreless frame.
- Possesses 3 of Kansas City's 5 pinch hits this season (3-for-11).

**Mike Moustakas** *This Series: 2-for-5, 2 RBI* *Last Stand: 0-for-12, RBI, BB* *Hit Streak: 1 g (2-5)*

*(moo-STOCK-us)*

- Mike was 2-for-5 yesterday with a 2-run single in the ninth...snapped his career-high hitting streak at 15 games last Friday night...hit .421 (24-for-57) with 6 doubles and a .985 OPS during the streak, which tied the longest streak by a Royals rookie (DeJesus, twice in 2004).
- He had his contract selected from Omaha (AAA) on June 10 and singled off of Ervin Santana for his first hit that night...he became the 261st Royal to homer in team history with his blast in the fourth inning the following night (June 11) off Joel Pineiro.
- He was batting .287 (64-for-223) for the Storm Chasers with 15 doubles, 10 home runs and 44 RBI in 55 games.

**Yamaico (ya-MIKE-oh) Navarro** *This Series: Has not played* *Last Stand: Did not play* *Hit Streak: 2 g (3-7)*

- Yamaico was recalled from Omaha last Friday...hit .272 (25-for-92) with the Storm Chasers in 25 games with two homers, 9 RBI and 11 runs.
- Was acquired July 30 from the Boston Red Sox with minor league righthanded pitcher Kendal Volz in exchange for infielder Mike Aviles...was 3-for-7 in two starts for the Royals on August 3 and 4 with a double, 3 RBI, 2 walks and 2 runs scored.
- He homered in his first MLB at bat this season with Boston, a pinch hit blast in Houston off of J.A. Happ on July 2, his first big league home run.

**Salvador Perez** *This Series: 2-for-4* *Last Stand: 1-for-6, 3 runs, HBP* *Hit Streak: 1 g (2-4)*

- Salvador was 2-for-4 yesterday, including a single that led to the go ahead run in the ninth...is hitting .356 (16-for-45) over his last 12 games...blasted his first Major League home run in Detroit on August 29 to deep left center off Max Scherzer in the fourth inning.
- He made his big league debut on August 10 at Tampa Bay, recording his first hit with a single off Wade Davis...he also added a RBI, run and picked runners off of both first and third base, the first pickoffs by a Kansas City catcher this year...had his contract selected from Omaha (AAA) August 10.
- Perez, 21, hit .333 (16-for-48) with 5 doubles, 1 HR and 10 RBI in 12 games with Omaha after his promotion from NW Arkansas in late July...the Valencia, Venezuela resident batted .283 for the Naturals with 14 doubles, 9 homers and 43 RBI in 79 games.

**Brayan Pena** *This Series: def. replacement* *Last Stand: 1-for-5* *Hit Streak: 1 g (1-5)*

- Brayan caught the ninth yesterday...was 1-for-5 Sunday...attended the birth of his third son on August 10 in Miami.
- Batting .366 (15-for-41) in close and late situations...all 3 of his homers this season have been 3-run shots at Rangers Ballpark in Arlington.

**40-DOUBLE CLUB EXCLUSIVITY**--Jeff Francoeur (44) and Alex Gordon (42) are currently the fifth pair of Royals teammates to have 40 or more doubles in the same season, joining Hal McRae (46) and Frank White (45) in 1982, Jermaine Dye (44) and Mike Sweeney (44) in 1999, Johnny Damon (42) and Dye (41) in 2000 and Billy Butler (51) and Alberto Callaspo (41) in 2009...Melky Cabrera needs one more to join the duo with 40 while Billy Butler is hot on their heels at 38...when Melky collects his 40th double, the Royals will possess the first outfielder in Major League history in which all 3 recorded 40-double seasons (thank you [runyontheroyals.com](#))...should both Cabrera and Butler attain the 40-double mark, which is likely to this point, Kansas City would be the fourth big league franchise in history to have 4 members of the 40-double club joining the 2006 Texas Rangers (Michael Young-52, Mark Teixeira-45, Gary Matthews Jr.-44 and Mark DeRosa-40), the 1932 Phillies (Chuck Klein-50, Dick Bartell-48, Hal Lee-42 and Don Hurst-41) and the 1929 Detroit Tigers (Charlie Gehringer-45, Roy Johnson-45, Dale Alexander-43 and Harry Heilmann-41).

**FRENCHY TIES TEAM DOUBLE MARK**--Jeff Francoeur's 2-run double in the first inning Saturday night not only gave KC a lead it would not relinquish, but it tied Kansas City's team record for doubles in a season by an outfielder...it was Frenchy's 44th two-base hit of the year, matching Jermaine Dye's mark established in 1999...Francoeur has been on a doubles roll of late, collecting 15 in his last 29 contests to take over the Major League lead in doubles with 44, one more than Ben Zobrist in the A.L. and 7 up on Arizona's Justin Upton who leads the N.L. with 37.

**PLAYOFFS START TOMORROW**--The Royals have three teams beginning their minor league post-season work tomorrow night as the second season begins...the Omaha Storm Chasers (AAA) will open its best-of-five series in Round Rock, the site of the first two games, followed by the remaining necessary contests slated for Werner Park starting Friday night...the defending Texas League Champion Northwest Arkansas Naturals will begin their title defense tomorrow night at Arkansas, where the first two games of their best-of-five will be played...the Naturals will return to Springdale on Friday...the Kane County Cougars (A) will start a best-of-three at home tomorrow against Burlington and then travel for the final two contests (if necessary).

**BILLY ON ELITE LIST**--According to STATS, LLC, Royals designated hitter Billy Butler is 1 of 7 players in Major League Baseball since the beginning of 2009 to have more than 500 hits, 200 runs, 50 home runs and a greater than .300 batting average...after going 3-for-4 with two home runs and 3 RBI yesterday, Butler has 529 hits, 220 runs, 54 home runs and an average of .307 since 2009...the other six on the list joining Butler are the Tigers' Miguel Cabrera, the Yankees' Robinson Cano, the Brewers' Ryan Braun, the Rangers' Michael Young, the Cardinals' Albert Pujols and the Red Sox' Adrian Gonzalez.

**ALEX SHATTERING TEAM ASSIST MARK**--Alex Gordon has recorded 20 outfield assists this year, not only leading the Majors, but shattering the club record of 17 which was held by Jermaine Dye (1999) and Mark Teahen (2007)...with 20 assists, Gordo is just the 24th player since 1969 to have 20 or more in a season and the first since Alfonso Soriano had 22 in 2006 for the Nationals...of his 20, half have cut off a run at home...the 27-year old Gordon was a third baseman up until the middle of last year...one other note on Gordon's assist roll, according to Stats, Inc, he is one of only four players since 1969 to record at least 20 outfield assists and commit two or fewer errors as an outfielder (Joe Orsulak - 22 assists and one error with Baltimore in 1991; George Hendrick - 20 assists and two errors with St. Louis in 1979 and Andruw Jones - 20 assists and two errors with Atlanta in 1998).

**BEST OUTFIELD ARMS IN BALL**--The Kansas City outfield has 46 assists in the books this year, 11 more than the N.L. leading Giants and 13 up on second place Detroit in the A.L...of the 46 assists, 22 have been in the first games of a series...Alex Gordon leads the Majors with 20, while Jeff Francoeur is tied for fourth with 13 and Melky Cabrera is sixth with a dozen...Mitch Maier became the first outfielder other than the three starters to pick up an assist on Sunday, nailing Carlos Santana at the plate to end the first...the KC outfield has also been involved at nailing a big league leading 24 runners at the plate this year, the second most in MLB since 1974 (Montreal Expos, 30 in 1978), which is as far back as that information is available...this is the second time in club history that 3 outfielders have double-digits in assists, joining the 1969 club (Lou Piniella-13, Pat Kelly-12, Bob Oliver-11)...Frenchy has 94 outfield assists in his big league career, which ranks #1 over the 72 by Baltimore's Nick Markakis since 2005...current teammate Melky Cabrera is tied for fourth on that list with 58.

**...AND THEY CAN HIT, TOO**--Royals' outfielders have been the most productive overall group in baseball at the plate, leading all of baseball with a .295 collective batting average, 514 hits, 195 extra-base hits, 128 doubles and 829 total bases...KC is also among baseball's elite with 261 runs (4th in Majors, 2nd in the A.L.), 240 RBI (3rd in Majors and A.L.) and a .826 OPS (4th in Majors, 2nd in A.L.)...Jeff Francoeur is enjoying one of his best overall seasons at the plate, setting a personal best with 44 doubles, while currently ranking tied for third on the club with 16 home runs...Melky Cabrera has established career bests in home runs (17) and RBI (81) and is flirting with his first career .300 season, with a .303 average which at this point has shattered his previous career best of .280 with the Yankees in 2006...Alex Gordon is having a breakout season, already establishing a career bests in hits (167), doubles (42), runs (93), extra-base hits (66) and home runs (20)...Frenchy, Gordo and Melky are three of just seven players in MLB with 35+ doubles, 15+ homers and 15+ steals...the others are Arizona's Justin Upton, the Rays' Ben Zobrist, the Brewers' Ryan Braun and the Red Sox' Jacoby Ellsbury.
