OAKLAND NOTES

• The Oakland Athletics are 5-2 in September after going 11-17 last month...recorded their 10th shutout of the year...are 26-25 since the All-Star Break after going 39-53 before the break...are 39-32 at home and 26-46 on the road...are 28-28 during the day compared to 37-50 at night...won the season series with Kansas City 5-4 and have now won each of the past three season series...went 4-2 on this six game homestand against Seattle (3-0) and Kansas City (1-2)...begin a three-game road trip to Texas Friday.

L — Chen (10-7)

- Guillermo Moscoso tossed a no-hitter through 7.2 innings before Salvador Perez singled to right field...had pitched 11.0 consecutive hitless innings dating back to his last start...retired 30 consecutive batters dating back to his last start prior to walking Alcides Escobar in the sixth inning, which is an Oakland record for consecutive batters retired...Dallas Braden (2010) and Catfish Hunter (1968) each retired 29 straight around their perfect games...threw a career-high 8.2 innings (previous: 8.0, Aug. 21, 2011 vs. Toronto)...his 129 pitches were the most by an A's pitcher since Mark Mulder threw 132 pitches against Toronto May 2, 2001.
- Coco Crisp (2 for 4) recorded his career-high 40th stolen base, becoming the 10th player (26th time) in Oakland history to steal 40 bases in a season.
- Adam Rosales (0 for 3) is 0 for his last 28, which is the longest hitless streak of his career (previous: 17, June 12-23, 2010).
- Scott Sizemore (1 for 4) is batting .235 (28 for 119) over his last 35 games but 18 of his 28 hits over that span are for extra bases (13 doubles, five home runs).
- Jemile Weeks (4 for 5) had his first career four-hit game and is now 7 for 10 (.700) over his past two games...has hit safely in 14 of his last 15 games (25 for 66, .379)...is hitting .363 (45 for 124) during the day and .331 (58 for 175) at home...went 12 for 26 (.462) against Kansas City this year.

KANSAS CITY NOTES

- The Kansas City Royals are 4-5 over the last nine games...were shutout for the seventh time this season...are 26-45 on the road and 34-39 at home...are 10-63 when trailing after seven innings compared to 41-11 when leading after seven...are 2-1 on this seven-game road trip through Oakland (2-1) and Seattle (four games).
- The Royals recorded two outfield assists and now have a Major-League leading 48 on the season...recorded an assist at home plate for the 25th time when Jeff Francoeur started a 9-4-2 putout of Jemile Weeks in the first inning...that is the most in the majors since the Montreal Expos had 30 in 1978.
- Bruce Chen is 0-2 with a 7.94 ERA (10 er in 11.1 ip) over his past two starts after going 5-0 with a 2.81 ERA in his previous five starts...is 2-3 with a 4.61 ERA (27 er in 52.2 ip) in 11 career games, seven starts, against Oakland.
- Alex Gordon (1 for 4) has hit safely in 11 of his past 12 games (18 for 50, .360).

W — Moscoso (8-8)

- Eric Hosmer (0 for 4) had his 15-game hitting streak in road games snapped...batted .397 (25 for 63) during the streak.
- Mike Moustakas (0 for 3) had his 11-game hitting streak on the road snapped...batted .391 (18 for 46) during the streak.
- Salvador Perez (1 for 3) singled with two outs in the eighth inning to break up Guillermo Moscoso's no-hitter...is 20 for 53 (.377) over his last 14 games.
