OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have won six of their last 10 games...lead the series with Los Angeles 9-5 and have won 10 of the last 12 games in Oakland...are 1-0 on the 10-game homestand against Los Angeles (1-0), Detroit (four games) and Texas (three games).
- Gio Gonzalez is 5-6 with a 4.99 ERA (37 er in 66.2 ip) in 10 starts since the All-Star Break after going 8-6 with a 2.47 ERA in 18 starts before the break...is 9-5 with a 2.80 ERA (32 er in 103.0 ip) in 16 starts at home compared to 4-7 with a 4.23 ERA (36 er in 76.2 ip) in 13 starts on the road...is 6-2 with a 2.72 ERA (16 er in 53.0 ip) in nine career starts against Los Angeles.
- Brandon Allen (0 for 3) is 0 for his last 21, which is the longest hitless streak of his career...is 6 for 57 (.105) with 29 strikeouts over his last 15 games after batting .354 in his first 13 games with the A's.
- Kurt Suzuki (3 for 4) recorded three hits, which matches his season-high (also April 15 vs. Detroit)...his two doubles in the game match a career-high (seventh time, last: July 24, 2011 at New York-AL)...is 14 for 40 (.350) against Los Angeles this season.

- The Los Angeles Angels are 6-12 in their last 18 road games...are 0-1 on this 10-game road trip through Oakland (1-0), Baltimore (three games) and Toronto (four games).
- **Joel Pineiro** is winless in his last six road starts and is 0-3 with a 10.50 ERA (28 er in 24.0 ip) over that span...is 0-3 with a 10.80 ERA (20 er in 16.2 ip) against Oakland this season.
- Alberto Callaspo (1 for 1) is hitting .306 in his career against the A's (37 for 121) and is 8 for 20 (.400) lifetime against Gonzalez.
- Vernon Wells (2 for 4) has hit safely in 15 of his last 18 games and is batting .328 (22 for 67) with 10 extra-base hits (4 2b, 2 3b, 4 hr) over that span.
