## OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics are 8-6 in the month of September after going 11-17 last month...are 29-29 since the All-Star Break after going 39-53 before the break...are 46-20 when scoring first compared to 22-62 when their opponent scores first...are 2-2 on the final homestand of the season, a 10-game stand against Los Angeles (1-2), Detroit (1-0) and Texas (three games).
- The A's hit a season-high-tying three home runs (third time, last: Aug. 23 at New York-AL).
- Brandon McCarthy made his 23<sup>rd</sup> start of the season, which is a new career high (previous: 22, 2007)...is 3-2 with a 2.15 ERA (9 er in 37.2 ip) over his last five starts...pitched today on five days rest and is now 5-5 with a 2.73 ERA (27 er in 89.0 ip) in 13 starts on five days rest or more and 4-2 with a 4.19 ERA (31 er in 66.2 ip) in 10 starts on four days rest...is 1-0 with a 2.41 ERA (5 er in 18.2 ip) in three starts against Detroit this year.
- Coco Crisp (3 for 5) recorded his 10<sup>th</sup> game of three or more hits this season (last: Sept. 1 at Cleveland)...his season high is four hits (Aug. 24 at New York-AL).
- David DeJesus (1 for 3) is 9 for 21 (.429) against Detroit this year and is a .315 (115 for 365) career hitter against the Tigers with 52 RBI...the RBI are his most against any team.
- Kurt Suzuki (1 for 2) homered in the second inning and is now batting .329 (24 for 73) with four home runs over his last 22 games.

## DETROIT NOTES

- The Detroit Tigers had their 12-game winning streak snapped...it was their longest winning streak since the 1934 club had a team-record-tying 14 wins in a row July 31-August 14...are 3-1 on their final road trip of the season, a nine-game trip through Chicago (3-0), Oakland (0-1) and Kansas City (two games).
- Max Scherzer has a 5.33 ERA (48 er in 81.0 ip) in 14 starts on the road compared to a 3.66 ERA (42 er in 103.1 ip) in 17 starts at home...is 4-5 with a 3.95 ERA (32 er in 73.0 ip) in 12 starts since the All-Star Break after going 10-4 with a 4.69 ERA in 19 starts before the break.
- Austin Jackson (0 for 4) is 4 for 38 (.105) over his past 10 games...is 4 for 26 (.154) against the A's this year.
- Magglio Ordonez (1 for 4) is on a season-high 13-game hitting streak and is batting .370 (17 for 46) over that span.
- Ramon Santiago (0 for 3) had his season-high nine-game hitting streak snapped...batted .409 (11 for 27) during the streak.
