OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics are 10-10 in the month of September after going 11-17 last month...went 43-38 at home this season...went 4-6 on their final homestand of the season, a 10-game stand against Los Angeles (1-2), Detroit (2-2) and Texas (1-2)...finish the season with a six-game road trip through Los Angeles (three games) and Seattle (three games) starting tomorrow.
- Trevor Cahill has tossed 200.2 innings this year, which is a new career high (previous: 196.2 in 2010)...went 6-8 with a 3.20 ERA (39 er in 109.2 ip) in 17 starts at home and is 5-6 with a 5.64 ERA (57 er in 91.0 ip) in 16 starts on the road.
- Andrew Bailey has converted all 13 of his save opportunities since the All-Star Break and is now a perfect 36 for 36 in save chances following the break in his career.
- Coco Crisp (1 for 4) hit a RBI single in the eighth inning... is 15 for 50 (.300) in September and is a .305 (206 for 675) career hitter in the month, his best average for any month of the season.
- Jemile Weeks (3 for 3) hit his first Major League home run in the sixth inning, snapping his career-opening 90-game streak in which he did not hit a home run...that was the second longest homerless streak to open a career in Oakland history...the record is held by Mike Bordick, who went 132 games before hitting his first home run May 10, 1992.
- Josh Willingham (1 for 4) is 14 for 44 (.318) with 11 RBI over his last 13 games.

TEXAS NOTES

- Colby Lewis did not factor in the decision...is 6-2 with a 3.53 ERA (32 er in 81.2 ip) in 12 starts against American League West teams this year, including 4-0 with a 3.05 ERA (14 er in 41.1 ip) in six starts against Oakland...is 7-3 with a 3.23 ERA (37 er in 103.0 ip) in 18 games, 16 starts, against the A's in his career.
- Adrian Beltre (1 for 4) has hit safely in 18 of his 19 games (28 for 78, .359) since being activated from the disabled list September 1...batted .333 (21 for 63) with 19 RBI in 16 games against the A's this season.
- Josh Hamilton (2 for 4) is 10 for 22 (.455) over his last five games and is now batting .344 (31 for 90) over his last 21 games...is batting .361 (39 for 108) against Oakland since the start of the 2010 season.
- Mike Napoli (0 for 1) had his eight-game hitting streak snapped...batted .552 (16 for 29) during the streak.
- Michael Young (2 for 4) is 7 for 13 (.538) over his past three games...batted .390 (30 for 77) against Oakland this year.
- Yorvit Torrealba (2 for 3) left the game in the eighth inning due to a headache...he will be reevaluated after the game.
