OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics are 0-2 on this five-game homestand against Seattle (0-2) and Kansas City (three games).
- Bartolo Colon** allowed seven earned runs...the last time he allowed seven or more earned runs was July 6, 2007 with Los Angeles-AL at New York-AL when he also allowed seven earned runs...is 15-12 with a 4.24 ERA (91 er in 193.0 ip) in 31 career appearances, all starts, against Seattle...the 12 losses are his most against any team.
- Jerry Blevins** had his career-high 10.1-inning scoreless streak dating back to last season snapped when Saunders homered in the sixth inning.
- Yoenis Cespedes** (1 for 3) has hit three home runs in his first four Major League games...is the only Athletic to hit safely in each of the first four games (4 for 13, .308).
- Kurt Suzuki** (1 for 4) has caught 598 games in his career...that moves him past Ossee Schreckengost for fifth place in Athletics history.

- The Seattle Mariners had all nine members of the starting lineup record one or more hits...the last time that happened was May 23, 2011 at Minnesota...are 2-0 on this six-game road trip to Oakland (2-0) and Texas (four games).
- Felix Hernandez** is 13-4 with a 2.71 ERA (48 er in 159.2 ip) in 23 career starts against the A's.
- Lucas Luetge** made his Major League debut and struck out the only batter he faced (Reddick).
- Munenori Kawasaki** (1 for 4) made his Major League debut with the start at shortstop...singled in the fourth inning for his first Major League hit.
- Ichiro Suzuki** (2 for 5) has 286 career hits against the Athletics...since moving to Oakland in 1968, no player has recorded more hits against the A's...is a .329 (286 for 869) career hitter against the team.
- Brendan Ryan** was scratched with a stiff neck.
