OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics are 18-9 against the Royals since 2009...are 1-2 on this five-game homestand against Seattle (0-2) and Kansas City (1-0).
- Tommy Milone tossed a career-high 8.0 shutout innings (previous: 6.0 ip, Sept. 20, 2011 at PHI)...the only other pitcher in Oakland history to throw 8.0 or more shutout innings in his Oakland debut is Mike Norris, who tossed a complete game shutout April 10, 1975 against Chicago-AL (ML debut)...the last A's pitcher to toss at least 8.0 shutout innings with no strikeouts is Matt Keough on July 27, 1980 against Detroit in the second game of a doubleheader (8.2 ip).
- Coco Crisp (1 for 4) stole a base in the seventh inning and has now been successful in each of his last 24 stolen base attempts dating back to last season...has not been caught stealing since July 10, 2011 at Texas.
- Seth Smith (1 for 2) has hit safely in each of his four games (4 for 9, .444).
- Jemile Weeks (1 for 4) has hit safely in all seven games in his career against the Royals (13 for 30, .433).

- Alcides Escobar (1 for 3) has hit safely in each of the first four games (4 for 13, .308)...is a .387 (12 for 31) career hitter against the Athletics.
