OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics had their season-high three-game winning streak snapped...are 0-1 on this six-game homestand against Cleveland (0-1) and Chicago (three games).
- The A's have scored just 46 runs, which are the fewest in Oakland history over the first 15 games of the season (previous: 47 runs, 1970...have hit 13 home runs in those 15 games...last year, did not hit their 13th home run until game 27.
- Graham Godfrey allowed a career-high five walks (previous: 2, twice; last: June 23, 2011 at New York-NL)...the five walks are the most by an A's starting pitcher since Rich Harden also walked five Aug. 14, 2011 vs. Texas...is 0-5 with a 4.25 ERA (14 er in 29.2 ip) in six games, five starts, since winning the first decision of his career (second start).
- Yoenis Cespedes (3 for 4) had his first career three-hit game...has reached base safely via hit or walk in 13 of his 14 games.
- Anthony Recker (1 for 2) has reached base safely via hit, walk or hit by pitch in all eight games of his career (4 for 22, 6 bb, hbp).
- Josh Reddick (2 for 5) has four multiple hit games in his past five contests (9 for 22, .409).
- Jemile Weeks (2 for 5) tripled in the seventh inning, the first triple by an Athletic this season.

- The Cleveland Indians have won six of the past seven games...have won six of eight games against the A's over the past two seasons...are 6-1 on this nine-game road trip to Kansas City (3-0), Seattle (2-1) and Oakland (1-0).
- **Ubaldo Jimenez** allowed a season-high five walks and has now walked three or more in each of his three starts...is 1-0 with a 3.75 ERA (5 er in 12.0 ip) in two career starts against the A's.
- Michael Brantley (1 for 4) is on a six-game hitting streak (9 for 30, .300).
- Shin-soo Choo (2 for 5) snapped his 0 for 9 streak with a RBI single in the fifth inning.
- Jack Hannahan (1 for 2) had a season-high tying three RBI (also April 5 vs. Toronto).
- Casey Kotchman (0 for 3) is on a 0 for 12 streak.
- Carlos Santana (1 for 3) is on a six-game hitting streak (7 for 23, .304).
