WINS AND LOSSES: After being held scoreless through 8 innings by Felix Hernandez, the Indians rallied for a pair of runs in the 9th to post a come-from-behind 2-1 win over the Mariners last night...Cleveland has won 5 of the club's last 6 games improving to 5-1 on the current 9-game, 10-day road trip through Kansas City (3-0), Seattle (2-1) and Oakland (3 games) after finishing the team's season-opening homestand at 1-4...the Tribe began current road trip with a 4-game win streak...at 6-5 (.545), Cleveland has matched its high water mark this season, sitting one game above the .500 mark for the second time this season (also 5-4 following Tuesday's 9-8 win at Seattle)...the Indians are in 2nd place in the A.L. Central standings, 2.0 games behind Detroit (.692, 9-4)...Cleveland has played 11 games, fewest in the majors...the Indians are 2-2 in series openers thus far in 2012 (0-2 at home, 2-0 on the road) after going 30-23 in series openers last season.

BETTER LATE THAN NEVER: The Indians won last night for the first time this season when trailing after 8 innings (1-3), also posting their first final-at bat victory of 2012...the 2-1 triumph signaled just the 5th time over the last 4 seasons for Cleveland to win a road game when scoring 2-runs-or-less, as the club had only 2 such wins during the 2011 campaign on April 9 at Seattle (2-1) and June 13 at New York-AL (1-0).

RHINESTONE COWBOY: RHP JOSH TOMLIN posted his first win of 2012 last night, holding the Mariners to a single run on 5 hits and no walks over 8.0 innings, while matching a career-high with 7 strikeouts...it was just the 2nd such road outing by a Cleveland starter since 2007, as Tomlin joined LHP CLIFF LEE as just the 2nd Indians starter over the past 6 seasons (2007-12) with road 8.0+ innings with 7+ strikeouts, while holding an opponent to one-or-zero runs, 5 hits-or-less, and zero walks in a road start... Lee earned a 2-0 victory in Game 2 of a doubleheader on April 24, 2008 at Kansas City, posting a 9.0-inning CG SHO (3 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 9 SO)...Tomlin became just the 2nd Indians right-hander over the past 7 seasons (2006-12) with a road start that met those thresholds, joining RHP JAKE WESTBROOK, who took a 3-2 loss June 17, 2006 at Milwaukee despite holding the Brewers to one unearned run over 8.0 IP (5 H, 1 R-0 ER, 0 BB, 8 SO).

SERIES STUFF: After securing a win in last night's rubber match with Seattle, Cleveland has secured consecutive series wins (home or road) for the first time this season...the series wins this week at Kansas City (3-game sweep) and at Seattle (2-of-3) mark the Indians' first consecutive series wins on the road since June 27-29, 2011 at Arizona (2-1) and July 1-3 at Cincinnati (2-1), first consecutive road series wins outside of Interleague Play since Sept. 6-8, 2010 at LA of Anaheim (2-1) and Sept. 17-19 at Kansas City (2-1)...this also marks the first time for Cleveland to win each of the club's first 2 road series in a given season since the 2002 campaign when the Indians took 2 of 3 from the Angels in Anaheim before sweeping a 3-game series against the Tigers at Comerica Park.

GENTLEMAN JACK: 3B JACK HANNAHAN collected a pair of hits last night, including a game-winning 2-run single off BRANDON LEAGUE in the 9th, raising his season average to .313...both hits last night came against right-handers, as Hannahan ranks among the A.L.'s best in that category:

Available content includes press releases, game notes, lineups, rosters and the Indians 2012 Information and Record Book.

OAKLAND PREVIEW: The Indians continue their West Coast swing with a 3-game series against the Athletics at The Coliseum, which will also conclude their first road trip of 2012...Cleveland won 5 of 7 meetings against the A's in 2011, including 2 of 3 here in Oakland...the Indians are 220-250 against the A's since they moved from Kansas City to Oakland for the 1968 season, which includes a 96-132 mark at The Coliseum...since the two franchises were both founded in 1901, Cleveland holds an overall edge of 1013-885-11 in the all-time series.

THIS-AND-THAT: The Indians bullpen combined to throw 10.0 scoreless frames over the 3 games of the Seattle series, holding the Mariners 3-for-33 (.091) with 8 strikeouts...**TRAVIS HAFNER** matched Hannahan for the team lead with 2 hits last night and is tied with **ASDRUBAL CABRERA** for the team lead with 4 multi-hit efforts this season...Hafner is 7-for-15 (.467) over his last 4 games to rise from .200 to .314...Cabrera ranks 2nd on the team with 20 total bases, despite missing all 3 games of the Seattle series (MLB Bereavement List)...**CARLOS SANTANA** leads the team with 9 RBI and 21 total bases, hitting safely in 5 straight at 6-for-20 (.300) to raise his season average from .211 to .256...**SHELLEY DUNCAN** paces the club with 11 walks, tied for most in the A.L., and is tied with Cabrera for team lead with 8 runs scored...Duncan's .444 on-base pct. is also 3rd in the league behind only Tampa Bay's Carlos Pena (.458) and Texas' Josh Hamilton (.448)...**CHRIS PEREZ** has posted 5.0 consecutive scoreless frames.

WALK THIS WAY: The Indians drew 4 more walks in last night's win against the Mariners, including 3 free passes in the club's decisive 2-run, 9th-inning rally...the Indians have posted the best walk-rate in the majors this season and trail only San Diego and Washington (59 each) for the overall lead in free passes with 57, although the Padres and Nationals have each played 14 games this season, 3 more than the Indians.

TONIGHT'S OUTING: The 28-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his third start and appearance of 2012 tonight in the opener of a 3-game series against the Oakland Athletics, also the 151st start and 152nd appearance of his major league career...this will also be his first career outing here at The Coliseum, as he has made just one career start and appearance vs. the A's, which came last season (more below)...enters tonight's outing looking to join Derek Lowe (2-1) as the second Indians hurler to record multiple wins this season...will be pitching on regular 4 days' rest for the first time this season, as his last start came on Sunday in a 13-7, series-finaled win over the Royals in Kansas City...has gone 36-26 with a 3.32 ERA (213 ER/576.2 IP) in 90 career starts on regular rest, 45 points lower than his overall 3.77 career ERA...currently owns the 3rd-best opponents avg. vs. RH batters in the majors...opened the year as the Indians no. 2 starter after being tabbed to start on Opening Day for the Rockies in both 2010 and 2011.

LAST START: Earned his first win of the season in Sunday's series finale at Kansas City, a 13-7 Indians victory over the Royals (5.0 IP, 9 H, 4 R-ER, 3 BB, 5 SO, 112 pitches/70 strikes)...was his first career appearance at Kauffman Stadium...fell into an early 3-0 hole after allowing a 3-spot in the 2nd inning on an Alcides Escobar RBI-double and a 2-run single by Chris Getz, but the Cleveland offense responded with 6 runs in the 3rd...gave up his 4th and final run in the 4th after Getz tripled and scored on Eric Hosmer's RBI-groundout.

VS. OAKLAND: Will be making just his second career start and appearance against Oakland tonight, his first here at The Coliseum, as his only previous outing to date came last season in a 4-3, 16-inning Indians win on Aug. 31 at Progressive Field (6.0 IP, 6 H, 3 R-ER, 2 BB, 6 SO, 1 HR, 114 pitches/70 strikes)...started opposite Rich Harden...allowed a bases-loaded walk to Scott Sizemore in the 2nd, an RBI-single to Brandon Allen in the 3rd, and a solo home run to Kurt Suzuki in the 4th...Jimenez retired the side in order in each of his other 3 frames (1st, 5th, 6th).

ON THE ROAD: Will be making his second consecutive start away from Cleveland...has won 3 of his last 4 road starts dating back to last season, going 6-10, 4.81 (49 ER/91.2 IP) in 16 games/starts on the road in 2011 overall...has gone 3-2 with a 7.64 ERA (30 ER/35.1 IP) in 7 road starts for Cleveland since last summer's trade (3-4 team record)...has gone 29-28 with a 3.95 ERA (205 ER/466.2 IP) in 78 career road starts.

2012: Started the Indians' 2nd game of the season on April 7 vs. TOR and took ND (7.0 IP, 1 H, 2 R-ER) in a 12-inning, 7-4 loss despite carrying a perfect game thru 5.2 IP (retired first 17 BF) and a no-hitter thru 6.2 IP...became first Indian since Millwood (5/9/05 vs. LAA) to hold opponent to one-or-zero hits in a start of at least 7.0 inn...served a 5-game MLB suspension from April 8-14 stemming from an incident on April 1 in Scottsdale vs. Colorado...**SPLITS:** Has held right-handers to a .091 (2-22) opponents' average, 3rd-lowest in the majors behind ARI's Cahill (.048, 1-21) and TB's Jeff Niemann (.048, 1-21)...Brett Lawrie (1B) and Alcides Escobar (2B) have both hits by RH batters vs. Jimenez...lefties batting .333 (8-24)...opponents' 1st time thru order: .235 (4-17); 2nd time: .200 (3-15); 3rd time: .214 (3-14).

SPRING TRAINING: Made 7 Cactus League appearances this spring, all in a starting capacity, going 1-4 with a 7.43 ERA (19 ER/23.0 IP)...his 23.0 innings trailed only Josh Tomlin (27.2 IP) for the Cleveland staff lead...opponents batted .316 (30-95) with 15 strikeouts and 15 walks.

2011: High profile mid-season acquisition went a combined 10-13 w/a 4.68 ERA in 32 starts between Cleveland and Colorado (188.1IP, 186H, 98ER, 78BB, 180K, .254AVG)...his 180 strikeouts were tied for 26th in the majors, while his 8.6 strikeouts per 9.0IP were 14th ahead of Jon Lester, Felix Hernandez & Roy Halladay...his 2CG finished T9th in the NL despite not pitching in the Senior Circuit after July 30...went 6-9 w/a 4.46 ERA (123.0IP, 118H, 68R/61ER, 51BB, 118K, .251 avg) and 2CGs in 21 starts w/Colorado prior to being acquired on July 31 by the Indians...at the time of the trade he was 8th among N.L. pitchers in strikeouts per 9.0IP (8.6), 15th in strikeouts (118) and 21st in batting average against (.251)...Jimenez made 2nd straight Opening Day start for Rockies, becoming the 4th pitcher in club history to start two-straight Opening Day games, joining Kevin Ritz (1996-97), Darryl Kile (1998-99) & Mike Hampton (2001-02)...was on the 15-day DL from April 2-18 w/a torn cuticle on his right pitching thumb that dated back to spring training...was also bothered by right groin problems early in the season...went 4-4, 5.10 (37 ER/65.1 IP) in 11 starts for Cleveland following his acquisition.

CAREER: Is in his 7th major league season in 2012 (5th full season)...entered 2012 with 132 starts since 2008, which was T7th-most by any pitcher in the majors over that span...was originally signed by Colorado in 2001 as a non-drafted free agent out of the Dominican Republic...made his major league in 2006, making one start and one relief appearance for the Rockies that season...made 15 appearances/starts in 2007 before joining the rotation full-time in 2008...won 15 games in 2009...went 19-8 with a 2.88 ERA and his first career no-hitter in 2010; also started the All-Star Game and finished 3rd in N.L. Cy Young voting...was acquired by Cleveland from Colorado at the 2011 July trade deadline.

TOMORROW'S SCHEDULED STARTER: RHP JEANMAR GOMEZ (0-0, 2.25 ERA in 2 games/one start)

The 24-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 2nd start and 3rd appearance on Saturday night in the 2nd installment of this 3-game series against the Oakland A's...has retired 12 of the 13 batters he has faced this season (zero walks, 3 strikeouts)...will be pitching on extended 6 days' rest, as he started Saturday's 10-inning, 11-9 victory at Kansas City, but received his first career ejection from home plate umpire Gary Darling after 2.0-plus innings following a hit-by-pitch to the first batter in the 3rd inning (Moustakas)...Moustakas would later score as an inherited runner after Gomez had retired his first 6 batters faced...Shin-Soo Choo broke a 9-9 tie with a 2-out, 2-run double in the top of the 10th...Gomez made his first appearance of the season with 2.0 scoreless innings of relief on April 11 vs. Chicago-AL (10-6 loss) after his first turn through the rotation was skipped following April 10 rainout...will be making his 3rd career start and appearance against Oakland, going 1-0 with a 0.79 ERA (1 ER/11.1 IP) in 2 previous outings, both coming last season...did not factor into the decision of a 4-3 win on May 5 here at The Coliseum (5.1 IP, 6 H, 1 R-ER, 2 BB, 1 SO) and earned a 6-2 victory on Aug. 30 in Cleveland (6.0 IP, 6 H, 1 R-0 ER, 1 BB, 4 SO)...is 4-7 with a 5.93 ERA (45 ER/68.1 IP) in 14 career appearances on the road, including 4-7, 6.06 (44 ER/65.1 IP) in 13 starts, but has won 3 of his last 4 decisions away from Cleveland.
