WINS AND LOSSES: The Indians improved to 6-1 on current roadtrip with a 4-3 win last night in Oakland as Jack Hannahan drove in 3 runs, Ubaldo Jimenez won his 2nd straight start and Chris Perez notched his 5th straight save chance...6-1 on the current 9-game, 10-day road trip through Kansas City (3-0), Seattle (2-1) and Oakland (1-0) after finishing the team's season-opening homestand at 1-4...the Tribe began current road trip with a 4-game win streak...at 7-5 (.583), Cleveland is enjoying its high-water mark of the season at 2-games over the .500 mark...the Indians are in 2nd place in the A.L. Central standings, 1.5 games behind Detroit (.692, 9-4)...Cleveland has played 12 games, fewest in the majors...the Indians are 3-2 in series openers thus far in 2012 (0-2 at home, 3-0 on the road) after going 30-23 in series openers last season...**The last time the Indians won 7 games on a road trip was in Sept of 2007 (7-3)...Last started 6-1 on the road in 1998.**

2-OUT MAGIC: The Indians have used the 2-out rally to their advantage on this roadtrip, scoring 23 runs with 2 outs on this current 7-game road trip, including 2 last night...Scored 12 with 2 outs last Friday in KC...In the first 5 games of the season at home the Indians scored 10 runs with 2 outs... On the year have scored almost half of their runs to date (33 of 68, 48.5%) with 2 outs...**As a team the Indians are hitting .288 (17-59) with RISP-2outs, .282 (31-110) with RISP overall and .294 (55-187) with runners on base... Are hitting .196 (49-250) with the bases empty this year.**

BULLPEN MAFIA RETURNS: Over the last 4 games the Indians bullpen has posted an ERA of 0.69 (13.0IP, 6H, 1R/ER) to lower the season relief team ERA total from 6.51 to its current standing of 5.01...The Indians team relief ERA (5.01) is currently 11th in the AL.

JIMENEZ IMPROVING: Last night RHP **UBALDO JIMENEZ** posted consecutive wins for only the 2nd time as an Indian (last Sept 11-16)...So far this year he is 2-0 w/a 4.00ERA (18.0IP, 16H, 8ER) and has gone at least 5.0IP in all 3 starts...He has limited hitters to a .235 (16-68) average against including a mark of .214 (6-28) by right-handed hitters.

SERIES STUFF: After securing a win in Thursday's rubber match with Seattle, Cleveland has secured consecutive series wins (home or road) for the first time this season...the series wins this week at Kansas City (3-game sweep) and at Seattle (2-of-3) mark the Indians' first consecutive series wins on the road since June 27-29, 2011 at Arizona (2-1) and July 1-3 at Cincinnati (2-1), first consecutive road series wins outside of Interleague Play since Sept. 6-8, 2010 at LA of Anaheim (2-1) and Sept. 17-19 at Kansas City (2-1)...this also marks the first time for Cleveland to win each of the club's first 2 road series in a given season since the 2002 campaign when the Indians took 2 of 3 from the Angels in Anaheim before sweeping a 3-game series against the Tigers at Comerica Park.

GENTLEMAN JACK: 3B JACK HANNAHAN is off to a great start, leading the American League in batting average with RISP (6 for 10, .600) and is 5 for 14 over his last 4 games with 2 2B & 6RBI...He is T12th in the AL IN RBI (11), 15th in batting average (.324) and 11th in on-base pct (.415).

OAKLAND PREVIEW: The Indians continue their West Coast swing with a 3-game series against the Athletics at The Coliseum, which will also conclude their first road trip of 2012...Cleveland won 5 of 7 meetings against the A's in 2011, including 2 of 3 here in Oakland...the Indians are 221-250 against the A's since they moved from Kansas City to Oakland for the 1968 season, which includes a 97-132 mark at The Coliseum...since the two franchises were both founded in 1901, Cleveland holds an overall edge of 1014-885-11 in all-time series...Are 1-0 vs. Oakland in 2012 (1-0 in OAK)

THIS-AND-THAT: TRAVIS HAFNER has reached via hit, walk, hit by pitch in 7 straight plate appearances dating back to the 7th inning of Thursday night's game at Seattle and 8 of his last 9 in his last 2 games to give him an AL-high .478 on base pct...He is also 4th in the AL in avg vs. RHP, 8th in OPS (1.034), tied for 7th in walks (9)...He is also 10th in batting avg (.333)...Hafner is 8-for-16 (.500) over his last 5 games to rise from .200 to .333...**CARLOS SANTANA** is T2nd in the AL in walks (12) with **SHELLEY DUNCAN** (Duncan is 3rd in the AL in on-base% at .478)...Santana is also 8th in on-base pct (.426) and 18th in OPS (.950)...**SHIN-SOO CHOO** is T6th in the AL in steals (2), T7th in walks (9), 19th in on-base pct (.390)...**CHRIS PEREZ** has posted 6.0 consecutive scoreless frames/appearances and 5 straight save conversions (T2nd in AL in saves)...**Indians catchers have thrown out 4 of 6 would-be basestealers this year (67%) and have been successful on 73% of their own steal attempts.**

WALK THIS WAY: The Indians drew a season-high 9 walks last night at Oakland and now lead the Major Leagues with 66 free passes in 12 games (5.5 walks per game)...The Padres (61) are 2nd but have played 3 more games than the Indians and are walking 4.1 times per game...**SHELLEY DUNCAN** (4.82) leads the AL in pitches per PA as **SANTANA/KOTCHMAN/KIPNIS** are all in the top 20 in the league.

58 JEANMAR GOMEZ RHP

(0-0, 2.25)

TONIGHT: The 24-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 2nd start and 3rd appearance tonight in the 2nd installment of this 3-game series against the Oakland A's, also the 23rd start and 25th appearance of his major league career...has retired 12 of the 13 batters he has faced this season (zero walks, 3 strikeouts), working 2.0 innings in each of his outings thus far...will be pitching on extended 6 days' rest, as he started Saturday's 10-inning, 11-9 victory at Kansas City, but was ejected after hitting the first batter he faced in the 3rd inning...has gone 5-4 with a 3.88 ERA (26 ER/60.1 IP) in 11 career starts on extended (5-or-more) days' rest.

LAST START: Made his 2nd appearance and first start last Saturday in a 13-7, 10-inning win over the Royals at Kauffman Stadium...logged just 2.0 innings and 20 pitches before receiving his first career ejection from home plate umpire Gary Darling after hitting Mike Moustakas, the first batter he faced in the 3rd inning...despite retiring the first 6 batters he faced in the game, Gomez was charged with an earned run, as Moustakas would later score as an inherited runner...Shin-Soo Choo broke a 9-9 tie with a 2-out, 2-run double in the top of the 10th.

VS. OAKLAND: Will be making his 3rd career start and appearance against Oakland, going 1-0 with a 0.79 ERA (1 ER/11.1 IP) in 2 previous outings, both coming last season...did not factor into the decision of a 4-3 win on May 5 here at The Coliseum (5.1 IP, 6 H, 1 R-ER, 2 BB, 1 SO) and earned a 6-2 victory on Aug. 30 in Cleveland (6.0 IP, 6 H, 1 R-0 ER, 1 BB, 4 SO)...that May 5 start has been his only career outing here in Oakland entering tonight's start.

ON THE ROAD: Has gone 4-7 with a 5.93 ERA (45 ER/68.1 IP) in 14 career appearances on the road, including 4-7, 6.06 (44 ER/65.1 IP) in 13 starts, but has won 3 of his last 4 decisions away from Cleveland...the Indians are 6-7 in his 13 career road starts; 8-1 in his 9 career starts at Progressive Field (5-1, 2.72 ERA).

2012: Started the year as the club's No. 5 starter, but had first scheduled turn through the rotation (4/10 vs. CWS) skipped due to a rainout the same day...first appearance of the season instead came the next day in relief on 4/11 vs. CWS, tossing 2.0 scoreless innings of a 10-6 loss...worked both the 7th and 8th innings, retiring all 6 batters he faced on 34 pitches...retired 3 of those 6 batters by way of strikeouts, fanning Gordon Beckham (called), Alejandro De Aza (swinging) and Adam Dunn (swinging).

SPRING TRAINING: Finished the spring 1-1 with a 1.37 ERA (3 ER/19.2 IP) over 6 Cactus League appearances/3 starts, while holding opponents to a .188 (13-69) average with 14 strikeouts and 8 walks...began his Cactus League slate with 13.0 consecutive scoreless frames and also tossed 1.0 scoreless inning in the club's March 1 intrasquad game...exited his final Cactus League start on March 30 against Cincinnati after 3.2 innings with a mild right hip strain, an injury that occurred as the result of a sprawling stretch on the ground to receive a throw at first base while successfully completing the back-end of a doubleplay.

2011: Split the season between AAA Columbus and Cleveland, getting 3 separate stints at the major league level: April 19-May 7, July 17 (one day) and Aug. 30-end of the season...went 5-3 with a 4.47 ERA (29 ER/58.1 IP) in 11 games/10 starts for the Indians and won a career-high 5 straight starts for Cleveland from August 30-Sept. 22 that also equaled a season-high by an Indians pitcher in 2011 (also Masterson in April)...and was promoted to Cleveland on April 19 to make 2011 debut at KC (L, 4.1IP, 9H, 5R-ER)...appeared in relief of injured Carlos Carrasco on April 24 at MIN (ND, 3.0IP, 3H, 1R/ER), his only major league relief appearance to date...started the season in the Clippers rotation, going 10-7 with a 2.55 ERA (39 ER/137.2 IP) in 21 starts...was named to the International League All-Star team, but did not participate, instead making one start for Mahoning Valley on July 13 during the break to stay on regular rest...at the time of Aug. 30 recall by Cleveland, he was 2nd in the IL in ERA (2.55), T5th in wins (10), 10th in WHIP (1.25), T15th in innings pitched (137.2) & 15th in strikeouts (107)...finished T3rd among Indians minor league pitchers in wins (10) and 3rd in ERA (2.54).

CAREER: Is in his first full season with the Indians and third overall after making his major league debut with 11 starts/appearances for Cleveland in 2010 followed by 10 starts/11 appearances for the Tribe in 2011...earned a spot in the Indians 2012 season-opening rotation as the club's No. 5 starter...won his big league debut on July 18, 2010 vs. Detroit (7-2 win)...a native of Caracas, Venezuela, Gomez was signed by Cleveland as a non-drafted free agent on April 4, 2005.

TOMORROW'S SCHEDULED STARTER: RHP JUSTIN MASTERSON (0-1, 6.48 ERA in 3 games/starts)

The 27-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 4th start and appearance of the season in Sunday's series finale against the A's here at The Coliseum...will be pitching on regular 4 days' rest, as he started the first game of the Seattle series on Tuesday, a 9-8 victory over the Mariners at Safeco Field (3.2 IP, 7 H, 8 R-ER, 4 BB, 1 SO, 1 HR, 71 pitches/39 strikes)...marked just the 4th time in his career to log fewer than 4.0 complete innings in a start...faced the minimum through 2.0 innings and retired 6 of the first 7 batters he pitched to before issuing a walk ahead of a 2-run home run by John Jaso, the Mariners' No. 9 batter...gave up 6 runs and faced 10 batters in the 4th before getting relieved by Nick Hagadone with 2 outs...became the first Indians starter to allow 8-or-more earned runs in a start of less than 4 complete innings without taking a loss since Rick White on Aug. 17, 2004 at Texas (1.2 IP, 7 H, 8 R-ER)...Masterson held Toronto to a single run on 2 hits over 8.0 innings on Opening Day, but has posted an 11.42 ERA (8.2 IP, 15 R-13 ER) over his last 2 outings...has gone 1-2 with a 5.73 ERA (14 ER/22.0 IP) in 7 career appearances against Oakland, including 1-2, 9.00 (14 ER/14.0 IP) in 3 starts...will be making his 3rd career start and 4th appearance here at The Coliseum; has taken losses in both career starts at this venue on Sept. 17, 2009 (4.0 IP, 6 H, 5 R-ER, 4 BB, 6 SO, 1 HR) and April 25, 2010 (4.0 IP, 8 H, 7 R-ER, 4 BB, 4 SO, 1 HR) and also tossed 4.0 scoreless innings in a relief appearance on April 14, 2009.
