WINS AND LOSSES: The Indians improved to 7-1 on current roadtrip with a 5-1 win last night in Oakland as Jeanmar Gomez won his 1st game (5.1IP, 4H, 1R) and JASON KIPNIS (4-5, 2RS, 3B, 3RBI) had a big night...7-1 on the current 9-game, 10-day road trip through Kansas City (3-0), Seattle (2-1) and Oakland (2-0) after finishing the team's season-opening homestand at 1-4...the Tribe began current road trip with a 4-game win streak and have now won 3 straight games...at 8-5 (.615), Cleveland is enjoying its high-water mark of the season at 3-games over the .500 mark...the Indians are in 2nd place in the A.L. Central standings, 1.0 game behind Detroit (.667, 10-5)...Cleveland has played 13 games, fewest in the majors...the Indians are 3-2 in series openers thus far in 2012 (0-2 at home, 3-0 on the road) after going 30-23 in series openers last season...**The last time the Indians won 7 games on a road trip was in Sept of 2007 (7-3)...Last time won 8 games on a roadtrip was 1998 (8-3, May 28-June 7, 1998)**

ROAD WARRIORS: The Indians are 7-1 on the road, their best road start since starting 1988 at 7-1 away from home...Also the first time since 1988 the Indians won their first three road series' to begin a season...The club also began 7-1 on road in 1981, 1938, 1910...The only time the Indians have started 8-1 away from home was in 1910 (**Credit ELIAS**)...**On road trip Indians are hitting .294 (85-289) w/19 2B, 8HR & 53RS (6.6RS/GM)**

2-OUT MAGIC: The Indians have used the 2-out rally to their advantage on this roadtrip, scoring 27 runs with 2 outs on this current 8-game road trip, including 4 more last night...Scored 12 with 2 outs last Friday in KC...In the first 5 games of the season at home the Indians scored 10 runs with 2 outs...On the year have scored over half of their runs to date (37 of 73, 50.7%) with 2 outs...**As a team the Indians are hitting .299 (20-67) with RISP-2outs, .276 (34-134) with RISP overall and .293 (61-208) with runners on base... Are hitting .213 (57-268) with the bases empty this year.**

BULLPEN MAFIA RETURNS: Over the last 5 games the Indians bullpen has posted an ERA of 0.54 (16.2IP, 10H, 1R/ER) to lower the season relief team ERA total from 6.51 to its current standing of 4.67...The Indians team relief ERA (4.67) is currently 10th in the AL.

BROTHERS IN ARMS: The Indians have won 3 straight games on the strength of their pitchign staff, posting a combined team ERA of 1.67 (27.0IP, 22H, 5R/ER) along the way...Over the last 4 games the staff has an ERA of 2.31 (35.0IP, 30H, 9ER).

RIGHT IS RIGHT: The Indians are 7-1 against right-handed starting pitchers after notching three straight wins against right-handed starters...The Indians are hitting .261 (74-283) off RHP this year with 10 2B, 10HR & 45 RBI (.761OPS) and are hitting .228 (44-193) off LHP with a .752OPS... The Indians are 1-4 vs. lefty starting pitchers...**To date in the American League this year right-handed pitchers have started 71% of the games played.**

GENTLEMAN JACK: 3B JACK HANNAHAN is off to a great start, leading the American League in batting avearge with RISP (6 for 10, .600) and is 7 for 18 over his last 5 games with 3 2B & 6RBI...He is T17th in the AL IN RBI (11), 10th in batting average (.342) and 9th in on-base pct (.422).

OAKLAND PREVIEW: The Indians conclude their West Coast swing today against the Athletics at The Coliseum, which will also conclude their first road trip of 2012...the Indians are 222-250 against the A's since they moved from Kansas City to Oakland for the 1968 season, which includes a 98-132 mark at The Coliseum...since the two franchises were both founded in 1901, Cleveland holds an overall edge of 1015-885-11 in all-time series...**Are 2-0 vs. Oakland in 2012 (2-0 in OAK) and have not swept them in a 3-game series in Oakland since April 2000**

THIS-AND-THAT: TRAVIS HAFNER has reached via hit, walk, hit by pitch in 11 of his last 14 plate appearances in his last 3 games to give him an AL-high .490 on base pct...He is also 3rd in the AL in avg vs. RHP, 8th in OPS (1.040)...He is also 9th in batting avg (.350)...Hafner is 10-for-20 (.500) over his last 6 games to rise from .200 to .350...**CARLOS SANTANA** is T1st in the AL in walks (12) ahead of **SHELLEY DUNCAN** (12BB, 3rd in AL; Duncan is 4th in the AL in on-base% at .434)...Santana is also 15th in on-base pct (.407)...**SHIN-SOO CHOO** is T1st in the AL in steals (3), T11th in walks (9), 18th in on-base pct (.391)...**CHRIS PEREZ** has posted 6.1 consecutive scoreless frames/7 straight scoreless appearances and 6 straight save conversions (T1st in AL in saves with BAL Jim Johnson)...**Indians catchers have thrown out 4 of 9 would-be basestealers this year (44%) and have been successful on 71% of their own steal attempts.**

WALK THIS WAY: The Indians have 13 walks in the series at Oakland and now lead the Major Leagues with 70 free passes in 13 games (5.4 walks per game)...The Padres (66) are 2nd but have played 3 more games than the Indians and are walking 4.1 times per game...**SHELLEY DUNCAN** (4.77) is 2nd in the AL in pitches per PA as **SANTANA/KOTCHMAN** are both in the top 20 in the league.

63 JUSTIN MASTERSON RHP

(0-1, 6.48)

TODAY'S START: The 27-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his fourth start and appearance of 2012 in the series finale today against the Oakland Athletics, also the 91st start and 150th appearance of his career...It is his 2nd start on the road and his 1st start against Oakland this year...Also his 3rd day game start.

LAST START: Did not get a decision in his last start of Tuesday, April 17 in Seattle's Safeco Field...Did not get a decision despite lasting a season-low 3.2IP while giving up a season-high 8 runs/earned runs...Departed from the game in the 4th inning after 71 pitches (39K) with the club trailing, 8-1...Indians took Justin off the hook by scoring 7 runs in the 5th inning and eventually notching a 9-8 win...Allowed 2 runs in the 3rd inning (Jaso 2-run HR) and 6 runs in the 4th before departing (Suzuki 2-run 1B/Smoak RBI single)...3.2IP, 7H, 8R/ER, 4BB, 1K, HR, HB.

APRIL SUCCESS: Has gone 7-4 with a 3.74 ERA (38 ER/91.1 IP) in 19 career appearances during the month of April, including 7-4, 3.69 (35 ER/85.1 IP) over 15 starts...Masterson won his first 5 starts of 2011 (all in April), going 5-0 with 2.18 ERA (8 ER/33.0 IP), the first Indians pitcher to win each of his first 5 starts of the year since Cliff Lee in 2008 (6-0)...according to Elias, Masterson became just the third Indians pitcher since 1955 to win his first 5 starts to begin a season while posting a sub-2.20 ERA, joining Bob Lemon in 1955 (5-0, 2.08 ERA) and Cliff Lee in 2008 (5-0, 0.96 ERA)...Masterson became just the 4th pitcher in team history to win five games during April in one season, joining Lemon, Lee and Greg Swindell in 1988 (5-0, 2.53 ERA).

VS. OAKLAND: Has gone 1-2 w/a 5.73 ERA in 7 games/3 starts (22.0IP, 22H, 14ER, 12BB, 24K) in his career vs. Oakland...Averaging 9.8 SO per 9.0IP in his career vs. Oakland...Last start came on August 26, 2010 in Cleveland, a 3-2 win over the A's and Vin Mazzaro...6.0IP, 5H, 2R/ER, 2BB, 3K...Did not face Oakland in 2011

IN OAKLAND: Career in Oakland he is 0-2 w/a 9.00 ERA in 3 games/2 starts (12.0IP, 16H, 12R/ER, 8BB, 16K)...Making first appearance here since April 25, 2010 (L, 4.0IP, 8H, 7R/ER)...

ON THE ROAD: Is making his second start on the road this year...He is 0-0 w/a 19.64 ERA in 1 road start (3.2IP, 7H, 8R/ER)...Went 8-5 with a 3.15 ERA (34 ER/97.0 IP) over 15 road starts in 2011...was 2-4, 2.58 (13 ER/45.1 IP) over his first 7 road outings of 2011 before finishing the season 6-1, 3.66 (21 ER/51.2 IP) over his final 8 starts on the road...is 12-23 with a 4.87 ERA (156 ER/288.1 IP) in 70 road outings in his career/44 starts.

2012: Earned first career nod as Indians Opening Day starter, taking ND in 16-inning, 7-4 loss on 4/5 vs. TOR despite exiting with 4-1 lead...according to B-R.com, he joined Cubs' Warneke (1934) and Phillies' Schilling (1997) as just 3rd pitcher since 1918 w/ 8.0+ IP and 10+ K's, while holding an opponent to no more than 2 hits and one run in an O.D. start...Was his 2nd career double-digit strikeout game...Equaled career-high with 8 runs allowed in start at Seattle on April 17...

2011: Enjoyed a break-out season, leading the team with a 3.21 ERA, 158 strikeouts, 33 starts, 216.0 innings pitched and 12 wins (tied, also Tomlin), all career-bests...among pitchers with at least 150.0 IP, Masterson's 3.21 figure was the 8th-lowest by an Indians hurler over the last 28 seasons (1985-2012)...also ranked among American League leaders in ERA (12th), innings (13th), strikeouts (20th) and slugging pct. allowed (7th, .349)...also allowed just 11 homers in 216.0 IP, the 2nd-fewest HR-per-9.0IP in the A.L. (0.46) behind the Tigers' Doug Fister (11 HR/216.1 IP)...went 8-5, 3.15 (34 ER/97.0 IP) in 15 starts away from Cleveland, ranking among A.L. leaders in both road wins and ERA...held right-

handed batters to a .210 avg. (73-347), 9th-lowest in the A.L...led A.L. hurlers with 14 runners caught stealing while on the mound, allowing the 9th-fewest stolen bases (14) in the league among pitchers who logged at least 200 innings... had the 3rd-best ground ball/fly ball ratio at 2.13 (364 GB/171 FB).

COOL RUNNINGS: Is the first Jamaican-born pitcher in major league history and just the 4th player from that country overall, joining Chili Davis (1981-99), Devon White (1985-2001) and Rolando Roomes (1988-90).

CAREER: Is pitching in his 5th major league season in 2012 (4th full season)... was selected by Boston in the 2nd round (71st overall) of the 2006 June draft out of San Diego State...made his major league debut as a member of the Red Sox with 9 consecutive starts from April 24-July 5, 2008, but spent the rest of the season pitching in relief and went on to play a key role in the Red Sox bullpen during the ALDS and ALCS...was acquired by Cleveland, along with LHP Nick Hagadone and RHP Bryan Price, from Boston on July 31, 2009 in exchange for C Victor Martinez...underwent arthroscopic surgery on his left, non-throwing shoulder on October 12, 2011 in Wilmington, DE to repair a pre-existing posterior labral tear...surgery was performed by Dr. Craig Morgan...is under club control through 2014.

TUESDAY'S SCHEDULED STARTER: RHP DEREK LOWE (2-1, 3.50 ERA in 3 games/starts)

The 38-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 4th start and appearance on Tuesday night in the opening game of a 3-game set against the Kansas City Royals...Fell to 2-1 in his last start of Wednesday, April 18 in Seattle, a 4-1 win for the M's and Jason Vargas...4.1IP, 8H, 4R/ER, 6BB, 0K, 113 pitches...Earned his 2nd win of 2012 on Friday in an 8-3 victory over the Royals at Kauffman Stadium (6.2 IP, 11, 3 R-ER, 0 BB, 2 SO, 92 pitches/59 strikes)...had a 7-0 lead before taking the mound following 7-run first inning by the Tribe's offense...the win snapped a 4-game road losing streak for Lowe...Won each of his first 2 starts in an Indians uniform, both quality starts, as he also posted a 4-3 victory over Toronto in his Cleveland debut on April 8, holding the Jays to a pair of unearned runs over 7.0 IP...is 4-5 w/a 4.76 ERA in 23 games/10 starts vs. KC in his career (73.2IP, 80H, 39ER) and career in Progressive Field he is now 4-2 w/a 2.47ERA in 15 games/4 starts (43.2IP, 39H, 12ER)...is in his first season with Cleveland after being acquired from Atlanta on Oct. 31 and started the Tribe's 3rd game of 2012.
