#### **OAKLAND NOTES**

- The Oakland Athletics have lost three of the last four games after winning a season-high three in a row...are 1-3 on this six-game homestand against Cleveland (1-2) and Chicago (0-1).
- The A's were shut out for the fourth time this season, which is the most in the majors...have scored just 52 runs, which is the fewest in Oakland history
  over the first 18 games of the season (previous: 54 runs, 1970).
- Bartolo Colon had his scoreless streak snapped at 18.1 innings when Dunn homered in the fourth inning...allowed three walks after walking a total of
  two in his first three starts...had walked two or fewer in 18 consecutive starts dating back to July 14 of last year, which was the second longest streak of
  his career (19 starts, Sept. 25, 2005-May 12, 2007).
- Fautino De Los Santos entered the game in the ninth inning and did not record an out...has not recorded an out in any of his past three appearances...that is the first time that has happened in Athletics history since at least 1918.
- Rich Thompson made his A's debut and tossed 0.2 innings.
- Yoenis Cespedes (1 for 4) is 8 for 26 (.308) over his last seven games after batting .212 over his first 10 contests...has reached base safely via hit or walk in 16 of his 17 games.
- Luke Hughes (0 for 3) made his A's debut with the start at third base...was claimed off waivers from Minnesota yesterday.
- Cliff Pennington (0 for 3) had his eight-game hitting streak against Chicago snapped...batted .423 (11 for 26) during the streak.

### **CHICAGO NOTES**

- The Chicago White Sox have won a season-high four in a row and five of the past six games...have won six straight road games, their longest streak since also winning six straight July 24-Aug. 9, 2011...are 7-2 on the road overall and 3-4 at home...are 4-0 on this six-game road trip to Seattle (3-0) and Oakland (1-0)
- The White Sox hit back-to-back home runs in the fourth inning (Dunn, Konerko)...it was their first time hitting back-to-back home runs this year.
- Jake Peavy tossed his sixth career shutout (10th complete game), his first since May 18, 2011 against Cleveland...the shutout extends his scoreless streak to 14.0 innings... is 3-0 with a 1.25 ERA (3 er in 21.2 ip) in his past three starts after allowing three runs in 6.0 innings in his first start.
- Adam Dunn (1 for 3) hit a home run in the fourth inning...all four of his home runs have come on the road...last year, homered a total of three times on the road all season...is now 8 for 21 (.381) with three home runs and 11 RBI in his last six games.
- Alex Rios (3 for 5) had a season-high tying three hits for the second game in a row...it is his first time with consecutive games of three or more hits since June 24-25, 2008 at Cincinnati (with Toronto)...is on an 11-game hitting streak (17 for 41, .415).
- Dayan Viciedo (1 for 4) snapped his 0 for 16 streak with a single in the fourth inning.
