#### OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have won six of the last nine games...are 2-1 in extra-inning games and 3-0 in games decided in the last at-bat...went 3-3 on this six-game homestand against Cleveland (1-2) and Chicago (2-1)...begin a nine-game, 10-day road trip to Baltimore (three games), Boston (three games) and Tampa Bay (three games) on Friday.
- The A's recorded their second walk-off win of the season on Ka'aihue's 14th-inning single (also April 11 vs. Kansas City, Gomes hit by pitch).
- Today's 14-inning game was the A's longest since playing 16 innings Aug. 31, 2011 at Cleveland (L, 3-4).
- Jarrod Parker** was recalled from Triple-A Sacramento today and made his A's debut...made his Major League debut last year with Arizona and has now allowed one run in 12.0 innings (0.75 ERA) in two career starts.
- Jim Miller** recorded his first Major League win.
- Yoenis Cespedes** (3 for 5) hit a game-tying two-run home run in the 14th inning... is 11 for 34 (.324) with 11 RBI over his past nine games.
- Josh Reddick** (2 for 6) snapped his 0 for 14 streak with a two-out RBI double in the sixth inning.

#### CHICAGO NOTES

- The Chicago White Sox have lost the past two games after winning a season-high four consecutive games...went 4-2 on this six-game road trip to Seattle (3-0) and Oakland (1-2)...begin a seven-game, eight-day homestand against Boston (four games) and Cleveland (three games) tomorrow.
- Chris Sale** tossed a career-high 8.0 innings (previous: 6.2 ip, April 9, 2012 at Cleveland)...is 2-0 with a 2.57 ERA (6 er in 21.0 ip) in three starts on the road...is 1-0 with a 4.38 ERA (6 er in 12.1 ip) in six career games, one start, against Oakland.
- Addison Reed** has made nine straight scoreless appearances to start the season (7.1 ip)...the nine consecutive scoreless outings by a White Sox rookie reliever to start a season are tied for the third-longest streak since 1921...Sergio Santos ranks first with 12 straight to open 2010.
- Paul Konerko** (3 for 5) hit the 400th home run of his career in the ninth inning, the fourth player to hit milestone home run number 400 or more with Chicago (Thomas, 400, July 25, 2003; Thome, 500, Sept. 16, 2007; Jones, 400, July 11, 2010)...had three hits and now has 2,001 as a member of the White Sox (2,049 career hits)...is the fifth player to record 2,000 hits with the White Sox.
