

#### WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

The Chicago White Sox have won four of their last five games and five of seven as they conclude a six-game trip this afternoon in Oakland ... left-hander Chris Sale takes the mound for the White Sox, who are in a three-way tie for first place in the American League Central.

Following today's game, the Sox return to Chicago for a sevengame, eight-day homestand vs. Boston (4/26-29) and Cleveland (5/1-3).

The White Sox went 3-4 on their last homestand vs. Detroit (2-1) and Baltimore (1-3) and 3-2 on their season-opening trip to Texas (1-2) and Cleveland (2-0) from 4/6-11.

The schedule includes a pair of three-city trips and four visits to the west coast ... the Sox play the Cubs (twice), Houston, St. Louis, the Dodgers and Milwaukee during interleague play.

#### TODAY'S STORYLINES

The White Sox are off to their best 17-game start since 2008 when they also were 10-7.

Paul Konerko needs one home run for 400 in his career

Sox pitchers own a 2.58 ERA (31 ER/108.0 IP) in the last 12 games, allowing 79 hits with 110 strikeouts.

The White Sox have won six of their last seven road games.

#### LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

The White Sox were limited to four hits as their four-game winning streak and six-game streak on the road came to an end with a 2-0 loss at Oakland.

The A's broke a scoreless tie in the eighth inning on Kurt Suzuki's RBI double and Eric Sogard's RBI single ... pinch-hitter Adam Dunn struck out to end the game with a runner on third. Gavin Floyd took the loss despite allowing one run on two hits

over 7.1 IP ... reliever Matt Thornton (1 ER/0.2 IP) allowed his first run of the season.

Alex Rios went 0-3, ending his 11-game hitting streak.

#### PAULIE! PAULIE!

Paul Konerko is tied with Andres Galarraga and Al Kaline for 48th place all-time with 399 home runs ... Konerko is attempting to become the fourth player in White Sox history to hit a milestone homer of 400 or more (see box at right) ... he has hit 392 of his 399 homers in a Sox uniform.

#### ON THE TRIP

The White Sox are 4-1 on this six-game trip to Seattle (3-0) and Oakland (1-1), hitting .268 (45-168) with a 1.84 ERA (9 ER/44.0 IP) and 22-9 edge in runs scored.

Jake Peavy recorded his sixth career shutout and 10th career complete game in Monday's 4-0 victory over the A's ... Adam Dunn and Paul Konerko hit back-to-back home runs off Bartolo Colon in the fourth inning, the first time they have accomplished that feat as teammates.

The Sox opened the trip with a three-game sweep of the Mariners, highlighted by Philip Humber's perfect game on Saturday ... Adam Dunn hit a pair of homers on Friday.

#### **ROAD WARRIORS**

The White Sox have won six of their last seven road games to improve to 7-3 overall, their best start away from home since 2005 when they won 10 of their first 12 on their way to a franchise-best 52-29 record.

#### ARMS RACE

White Sox pitchers lead the American League in opponents average (.210), on-base percentage (.274), complete games (2) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.47), rank second in strikeouts (149), strikeouts per 9.0 IP (8.88) and third in ERA (2.92) and slugging percentage (.362).

The Sox have allowed three runs or less in 11 of their 17 games and one or no runs four times.

#### STARTING POINT

White Sox starting pitchers lead the American League in strikeouts (105), shutouts (2), complete games (2) and opponents average (.201) and rank third in ERA (3.09) and quality starts (11).

Sox starters own a 2.57 ERA (23 ER/80.2 IP) over the last 11 games, allowing 50 hits with 83 strikeouts.

#### **BULLPEN RELIEF**

The White Sox bullpen, which includes three rookies, ranks second in the American League in strikeouts per 9.0 IP (9.82) and fourth with a 2.45 ERA (11 ER/40.1 IP) ... the bullpen has allowed one run in 13.1 IP over its last six games

#### WHITE SOX VS. OAKLAND

The season series is even at one game apiece, with each team posting shutout victories ... the White Sox shutout on Monday was their first in Oakland since 4/25/05 (6-0).

■ The Sox are hitting .239 (16-67) with a 1.06 ERA (2 ER/17.0 IP) and have outscored Oakland, 4-2.

Chicago went 6-4 against the A's in 2011 to improve to 2-8-1 in the last 11 season matchups ... the Sox took two of three in Oakland on 5/13-15, their third series victory at The Coliseum in the last four seasons.

Chicago trails all time vs. Oakland, 268-288 ... the Sox are 138-136 at home (50-54 at U.S. Cellular Field) and 130-152 at The Coliseum.

#### SOX PUTTING UP A FIGHT AT THE COLISEUM

The White Sox have gone 9-7 in their last 16 games in Oakland, compared to 6-28 (.214) in their previous 34. A closer look at Chicago's numbers at the Coliseum

#### WINNING ON THE WEST COAST

The White Sox are 33-23 playing at Seattle (14-7), Los Angeles-AL (10-8) and Oakland (9-8) since 2008, including a 20-10 record since 2010 ... by contrast, the Sox were 24-64 (.273) on the road vs. those three teams from 2001-07.

Sox are 5-3 vs. the American League West in 2012 and 48-31 (.608) since 2010.

#### SLOW DOWN

White Sox catchers have thrown out 77.8 percent (7-9) of attempted basestealers, the best percentage in the major le . Tyler Flowers ers. while A.J. Pierz

Since the start of the 2003 season. White Sox pitchers lead the major leagues with 805 quality starts, six more than the Angels ... the Sox rank third in the American League with 11 quality starts in 2012.

#### **HUM-BELIEVABLE!**

Philip Humber threw the 21st perfect game in major-league history on Saturday, striking out nine batters in a 4-0 victory at Seattle ... Humber, who was claimed off waivers from Oakland on 1/18/11, joins Buehrle (7/23/09) and Charlie Robertson (4/30/22) as White Sox pitchers who have been perfect.

The White Sox and the Yankees are the only teams with three perfect games ... Chicago is tied with Boston for second all-time with 18 no-hitters, trailing only the Dodgers (20).

Humber has returned to Chicago to join his wife for the expectant birth of their first child.

#### **GRAB SOME BENCH**

White Sox pitchers rank second in the American League in strikeouts (149) and strikeouts per 9.0 IP (8.88) ... the Sox fanned eight or more batters in 11 straight games from 4/11-22.

Chicago recorded a franchise-record 1,220 strikeouts in 2011, eclipsing the mark of 1,149 set in 2010 ... Sox pitchers registered 10 or more strikeouts 41 times in 2011 (four with 15-plus), their most since at least 1919 and 10 more than their previous high set in 2010.

#### AT THE HELM

Robin Ventura was named the 39th manager in White Sox history on 10/6/11 ... he earned his first major-league victory on 4/7 at Texas.

Ventura batted .267 with 294 home runs and 1,182 RBI in 16 major-league seasons ... he won six Gold Gloves (1991-93, 1996, 1998-99) and was a two-time All-Star (1992 and 2002).

#### ON DECK: BOSTON RED SOX

The White Sox open a four-game series tomorrow night vs. Boston ... Philip Humber, who threw the 21st perfect game in major-league history in his last start on 4/21 at Seattle, starts the opener.

The White Sox went 4-2 in 2011 for their second straight series victory over the Red Sox ... the Sox have won 14 of their last 18 games against Boston, outscoring the Red Sox, 96-66 ... Chicago has won seven straight games at Fenway Park.

Was selected by the Sox in the first round (13th overall) in the June 2010 First-Year Player Draft and was the first member of the 2010 draft class to reach the majors.

#### LAST START

Earned the win in his third career start on 4/20 vs. Seattle

Allowed three runs on seven hits while striking out a career-high 11 batters and walking three over 6.1 IP 11 strikeouts were the most by a Sox pitcher since Edwin Jackson fanned 13 on 4/7/11 vs. Tampa Bay and the most by a Sox lefty since Mark Buehrle on 4/16/05 vs. Seattle (12).

Struck out at least one batter in every inning ... has now struck out at least one batter in every inning pitched in his past two starts (16 K/11.1 IP).

Left the game with the Sox leading, 6-2, after throwing 110 pitches (69 strikes).

#### SALE'S SWEET START

Allowed just one run on three hits over 6.2 IP to earn the victory in his first career start with the Sox on 4/9 at Cleveland ... did not allow an extra-base hit and set down 12 straight batters at one point (3rd-6th).

The most recent pitchers to make their first career start with the Sox and allow one run or less and work 6.0 IP or more.

■ Was 2-1 with a 4.18 ERA (13 ER/28.0 IP) and a team-leading 28 strikeouts over six starts.

■ Went 2-0 with a 1.80 ERA (2 ER/10.0 IP) and 13 strikeouts over his final two spring starts.

Issued just four walks in 28.0 IP and walked none in three of his six outings.

Tossed 6.0 scoreless IP on 3/19 vs. Cincinnati, allowing just two hits and striking out six.

#### 2011 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS

Went 2-2 with a 2.79 ERA (22 ER/71.0 IP), eight saves and 79 strikeouts last season.

Entered the season ranked by Baseball America as the No. 1 Prospect in the White Sox organization . also tabbed by the same publication as possessing the Best Fastball. Best Slider and Best Changeup among

Sox prospects. Ranked among American League relief leaders in IP (6th, 71.0 IP), strikeouts (6th, 79), strikeouts per 9.0

- IP (8th, 10.01) and inherited runners scored percent (8th, 18.4). Posted a 1.66 ERA (10 ER/54.1 IP) over his final 41 outings.
- Held right-handers to a .199 (27-136) average against and lefties to a .208 (25-120) mark. Posted a 2.04 ERA (8 ER/35.1 IP) vs. the American League Central.
- Threw 13.2 consecutive scoreless IP from 7/24-8/16. ■ Converted eight consecutive saves from from 4/9-9/27.

#### VS. THE AL WEST

■ Is 2-0 with a 3.93 ERA (8 ER/18.1 IP), two saves and 21 strikeouts in 14 appearances (one start) against the American League West ... opposing hitters are batting .268 (19-71).

Has made five appearances against Oakland, four vs. Texas, three against Seattle and two vs. Los Angeles-AL.

Earned the win in his last appearance against the AL West, tossing 6.1 IP and striking out a season-high 11 batters on 4/20/12 at Seattle.

#### VS. OAKLAND ATHLETICS

Will make his first career start vs. Oakland and sixth appearance overall ... is 1-0 with a 8.31 ERA (4 ER/4.1 IP), one hold, one save and five strikeouts lifetime.

Athletics hitters have gone 7-20 (.350).

Earned the hold in his last appearance against Oakland on 6/10/11 at U.S. Cellular Field ... allowed one earned run over 1.0 IP while striking out one.

Is 0-0 with a 0.00 ERA (1.1 IP), two strikeouts, two walks and one save in two career appearances at O.co Coliseum.

#### TOMORROW'S STARTER

RHP Philip Humber will make his third start of the 2012 season after tossing a perfect game his last time out against Seattle on 4/21 ... Humber threw the 21st perfect game in major-league history and the third in White Sox history on 4/21 at Seattle, striking out nine batters in a 4-0 victory over the Mariners ... threw 96 pitches (67 strikes) and went to a three-ball count just twice.

Made his second consecutive Opening Day roster with the White Sox.

Went 9-9 with a 3.75 ERA (68 ER/163.0 IP) and 116 strikeouts over 28 games (26 starts) in his first full major-league season in 2011.

Right-handers hit .203 (49-241), the sixth-lowest mark in the American League.

Was 8-5 with a 3.10 ERA (37 ER/107.1 IP) and a .218 (87-399) opponents average in the first half of the season

■ Is 1-1 with with a 5.84 ERA (8 ER/12.1 IP) in two career games against Boston (both starts) ... is 0-1 with a 7.71 ERA (4 ER/4.2 IP) in one game against the Red Sox at U.S. Cellular Field.

Took the loss in his last start on 7/30/11 vs. Boston, allowing four runs on nine hits over 4.2 IP and striking out four ... received a no decision in his last start at U.S. Cellular Field on 4/16/11, allowing one run on six hits over 5.1 IP and striking out seven.
