## **OAKLAND NOTES**

• The Oakland Athletics are 18-14 over the past 32 games after starting the season 4-7...lead the season series with the Angels 5-2 and have won 11 of the last 15 meetings in the Coliseum...are 1-0 on this six-game homestand against Los Angeles (1-0) and New York (three games).

The A's had had two stolen bases, which snapped their season-high streak of five consecutive games without a stolen base...lead the American League with 40 stolen bases for the season.

Tommy Milone is 4-0 with a 0.60 ERA (2 er in 30.0 ip) in four starts at home compared to 2-3 with a 7.16 ERA (22 er in 27.2 ip) in five starts on the road...is 2-0 with a 2.25 ERA (3 er in 12.0 ip) in two starts against Los Angeles this season.

Ryan Cook has tossed 21.2 innings this season and has not allowed a run...since 1918, that is the longest season opening scoreless streak in Athletics history for players on the Opening Day roster (previous: 21.0 ip, Alex Kellner in 1953).

Josh Donaldson (1 for 4) is 5 for 15 (.333) over his past four games after going 4 for 49 (.082) in his first 14 games.

Josh Reddick (2 for 3) is batting .385 (10 for 26) in seven games against Los Angeles this year.

Seth Smith (1 for 2) is batting .298 (17 for 57) with 10 walks over his last 19 games after hitting .185 over his first 21 contests.

Kurt Suzuki (0 for 3) is 9 for 43 (.209) over his last 12 games after batting .333 over his previous nine contests.

## LOS ANGELES NOTES

The Los Angeles Angels have lost the past three games and four of the past five...are 10-10 in the month of May after going 8-15 in April...are 3-7 against the American League West...are 1-21 when scoring three runs or fewer and 17-4 when scoring four or more...are 1-3 on this 10game road trip to San Diego (1-2), Oakland (0-1) and Seattle (four games).

Jerome Williams allowed a season-high five walks (previous: 3, twice; last: April 26 at Tampa Bay)...had his four-game winning streak snapped...had a 3.07 ERA in six games, five starts over that span...is 3-2 with a 3.19 ERA (13 er in 36.2 ip) in six career starts against the A's.

Erick Aybar (1 for 3) is batting .359 (37 for 103) in Oakland since 2009, which ranks second in the majors over that span (Suzuki, SEA .373).

Alberto Callaspo (1 for 4) snapped a 0 for 10 streak with a single in the fourth inning...is batting .316 (6 for 19) against Oakland this year.

Albert Pujols (1 for 4) has hit safely in nine of his past 10 games (11 for 40, .275).

Mike Trout (1 for 4) is batting .414 (24 for 58) over his last 15 games.
